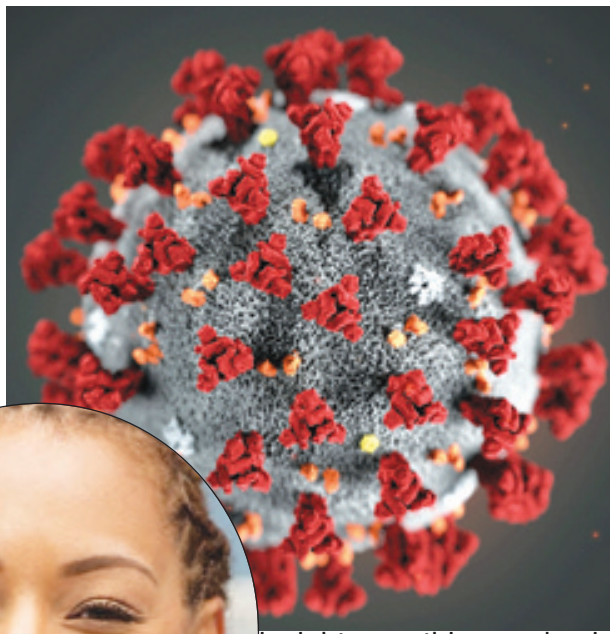

CORONAVIRUS IS A HEALTH AND ECONOMIC ISSUE FOR BLACK PEOPLE, DOCTOR SAYS

Dr. Cwanza Pinckney gives her insights on the pandemic and how it relates to the Black community in an exclusive interview with theGrio.com

Dr. Pinckney

It's been said more than once that when White America gets a cold, Black folks catch pneumonia.

The coronavirus which has not shown any mercy — crashing the stock market, shuttering the sports and entertainment world and shutting down cities — but Black people know from history that its effects will be felt the worse in their community.

Dr. Cwanza Pinckney, nationally recognized board-certified emergency physician, gave her

insights on this pandemic and how it relates to the Black community in an exclusive interview with theGrio. For starters, it's more than just the flu.

COVID-19 is an infectious strain of the large part of viruses that cause the common cold and other more serious illnesses such as Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS-CoV). It's spread through coughing and sneezing.

"I walk around in the flu every day without any concern or you know issue besides standard precautions, especially those in the medical field. We're used to encountering infectious diseases on a daily basis multiple times a day. That doesn't get us concerned," Pinckney said.

"Where we're starting to see the concern is, you know, especially since we had sort of a late response to this, that people can be exposed without being aware through droplets. People can transmit this virus to high-risk populations such as older people or those with lung problems without even knowing it."

At the moment, there are currently not enough resources or tests available to treat

City of Milwaukee Health Department Adjusted Services • Updated March 17

The City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) is taking measures at each of our health centers to increase social distancing and prevent community spread of Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).

These measures include increasing the frequency of cleanings and reducing the number of chairs in waiting rooms. For the safety of the community and our staff, some services have been temporarily suspended or reduced.

Community Healthcare Access Program
All outreach and in person enrollment has been suspended until further notice.

Communicable Diseases Program
The Communicable Disease Program is prioritizing its response to COVID-19.

Consumer Environmental Health Program
Staff are responding to foodborne illness complaints and conducting pre-inspections for new establishments.

Direct Assistance to Dads Project

Nursing case management services are being provided remotely. Cases will continue to be monitored.

Immunization Clinic

Clinics have been closed until further notice.

Newborn Screening

Services are being provided on a case by case basis.

Milwaukee Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness Program

Services are suspended until further notice. Clients with immediate needs are receiving ongoing case management services.

Parents and Nurturing and Caring for Their Children

Home visits have been suspended until further notice. Staff are working remotely and will be available by phone. Referrals are still being accepted.

Public Health Laboratory

There are no service reductions at this time.

Safe Sleep Clinics

All clinics and trainings have been suspended until further notice.

Sexual and Reproductive Health Clinic

STI screening, emergency contraception, and condom distribution only. Treatment of confirmed positive results by appointment. No same day treatment.

Strong Baby Program

All in-person training and technical support have been suspended until further notice. Staff will be available remotely to provide technical support.

TB Clinic

Minimal changes to services, but clients may see a delay in scheduling appointments.

Violence Prevention

Services are being maintained, with minimal disruption. Staff are working remotely and will be available by phone.

Vital Records (Birth and Death Certificates)

No changes to services at this time.

Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program

WIC clinics are open to provide services but no more than 10 individuals can be at the clinic. Some benefits can be provided remotely.

those who may be infected. And yes, that includes Black folks. Pinckney has received calls from friends who thought those with melanin were immune.

The NBA and other sports leagues suspending their seasons or canceling games may have driven the message home.

“That was a wakeup call because there’s no NBA game. So, ESPN was dry last night. We were talking about golf last night. I think that really hit Black folks to say, hey, this is not a joke,” she said.

“I wish it wasn’t like that, but it is what it is. I will accept anything that draws energy and attention to people understanding the severity of this disease.”

We are all at risk but patient zero is Tyler Perry’s iconic fictional character Madea, Pinckney says.

“Smoked all her life and worked, you know. I mean, she’s at a really high risk for catching the life-threatening symptoms of COVID-19.”

Access, Care and Economics

Dr. Pinckney advised people to keep using hand sanitizers and practice good hygiene. She also stressed self-quarantine to prevent the spread of this malady that is stressing the resources of hospitals.

Currently, there are not enough beds, ventilators, and tests to be administered to those that need it.

The disease is also daunting to those who do not know if their medical needs will even be recognized and met.

“As it pertains to Black people in the United States, we know that we’ve had a higher level of racial disparity in health care since the beginning of time, since we’ve entered this country,” she said. “And I’m not believing that that’s gonna be any different. It’s already hard to get a test now if you’re in an underserved community.”

The cost will also be a barrier. Many are impacted by poverty, lower wages and having jobs that are dependent on factors such as tips and maintenance of buildings that are being closed. Coronavirus is a matter of health and economics.

“If we look across the spectrum, we definitely have jobs that tend to be self-limiting, meaning if they’re not critical they can be eliminated and

this can be devastating economically to many people.

“And for a lot of single working mothers who now are forced to deal with their children who are going to be at home, are going to be making tough decisions,” Pinckney said.

“And for those people who depend on their job for their livelihood, there’s going to be a hesitation to go get tested.

“Number one, because their fear of not wanting to test positive so that they can work, so they can sustain their family.”

Hysteria

Coronavirus will get much worse before it gets better.

“It’s going to manifest. I think the next, you know, probably four weeks is going to be a good indication of, you know, how quickly we’re going to see this in terms of its severity,” Pinckney said.

“And that’s why I think everyone [needs] to take the precautions that they are. But, yeah, I definitely believe that it has the potential to get much worse.”

Pinckney understood the frustrations of isolation but she is also taking her own advice. The good doctor also moonlights as a self-taught master mixologist DJ but is now going straight home after her shift in the ER ends.

“I think that for me and many other health professionals who would never ask people to do things out of just fear and terror. It is out of love for people, out of a true desire to help people. Well, we don’t want to see this spread,” she said.

“I also DJ on the side. I was supposed to be at South by Southwest next week. I ain’t going. You know, it just is what it is, you know, and it sucks. But we just have to do it. I think it’s our social responsibility to do it.”

As medical professionals respond to that challenge, Pinckney does not want anyone to despair. Black folks have been joking and laughing through their pain as a coping mechanism since the beginning of time, through slavery and now #DatRona.

That’s the kind of TLC Pinckney wants as doctors work to respond to health care needs. She is a believer in mindfulness. Stress, she said, can cause inflammation of the immune system.

“You got to keep your peace.

Beyond all things, because hysteria and panic will not help diagnose, treat or, you know, increase your likelihood to do well,” she said.

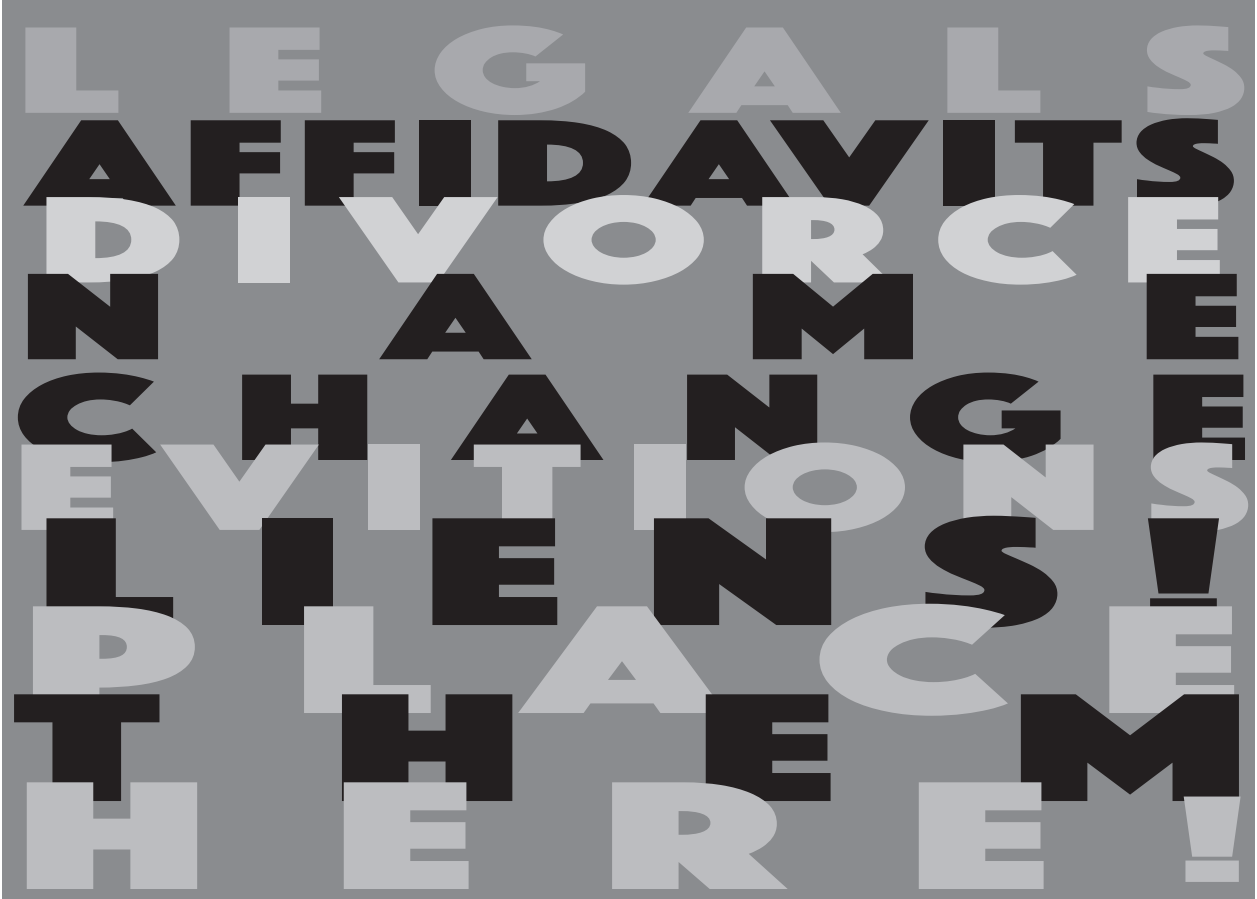
