Budgets are blueprints for an organization's priorities. In the state of Wisconsin our budget shows the people of the state what our leaders' value-and with the latest actions by the Republican-led Joint Finance Committee, I'd venture to say they don't value the people of this state very much
Last week, the twelve Republican members of the state's powerful budget-writing committee chose to eliminate nearly four hundred measures proposed by Governor Evers, which translates into more than $\$ 3$ billion in revenue sources.
Of the items ditched by Republicans were Medicaid expansion, full funding of four-year old kindergarten, ending the "dark store" loophole, legalization of medical marijuana, and a ban on vaping in schools.
This is odd, as some of these ideas were proposed in past sessions by Republican members of the legislature. What remain painfuily obvious is the obstinate

It's good for your credit score. Credit scores have a significant impact when qualifying for a mortgage. The better your credit core, the lower your mortgage interest rate is likely to be. Paying down debt shows lenders you'r able to cover your expenses.
It can free up savings in the future. The money you used to pay bills can now go directly into your savings account rather than paying
interest on other debts like credit cards. The bonus is you won't notice the difference in your budget because the money was going out anyway

Pop Staples had routinely turned down offers for the group to record R\&B music as he felt it was a conflict with his faith. Pervis witnessed friends such as Lou Rawls and Sam Cooke crossover and he kept nudging his father to expand the group's repertoire. The compromise was message music after they signed with Riverside Records in 1961. The family became fast friends with folk artists like Bob Dylan on the festival circuit. Pervis and Dylan were close. In Kot's book, Pervis recalled Dylan showing him the song, "A Hard Rain's Gonna Fall" at the President Hotel in 1962. He lobbied Pop Staples to let the family record it. He did and it was done as a duet between Mavis and Pervis for the 1966 LP, This Little Light of Mine (Epic Records). Although Mavis opened the song, Pervis led the bulk of it in a smooth, mellow, and command-
ing voice that was reminiscent of his father's but uniquely his own. Another ing voice that was reminiscent of his father's but uniquely his own. Another stand-out solo for Pervis was his lead on The Staple Singers' remake of Hank

While I am elated to see an emerging sense of cultura relevance and Black resistance today, there are few rep resentatives of the culture of poverty among them. And the myriad of negative social indicators-crime, unemployment, illiteracy-speaks to the other pandemic, one

thers.
A case could also be made that far too many Black mothers today have handicapped their children through their poor parenting habits, educational apathy, and disengagement from the family support mechanism Most alarmingly, they reject both the Africentric and spiritual models that enabled my generation to survive
and prosper amid a system of apartheid that continues to and prosper amid a system of apartheid that continues to plague us to a lesser degree
And because our leaders and laymen today are unwill ing to acknowledge this paradigm, a large segment of ou youth are trapped in poverty, handicapped by ignorance,
and void of mores and values that are the necessary corand void of mores and values that are the necessary co nerstones of a community
Trace the roots of our state's nation-leading Black in carceration rates, poverty, and dropout rates, and you'li find yourself at a nasty house with abused children. In other words, the culture of poverty,
It hurts my heart seeing children who know how lent rap song but can't spell their name, recite the alph bet, or identify basic colors before entering governmen schools.
Far too many generational egg donors get pregnant for he wrong reasons, don't have a religious, cultural, or even familial foundation to stand upon. And as a result their children suffer and generally slip through the cracks. Ask the average teacher today. Many are better mother than the biological ones. They have to deal with discipline, ignorance
ing my youth.
