## THOUSANDS OF BLACK WOMEN CALL FOR \$50K IN STUDENT DEBT CANCELLATION

FOR  
WOMEN  
ONLY!

**1,000 Women Strong** recently joined forces with the American Civil Liberties Union (ALCU) to support the cancellation of student debt, especially for Black women in a new campaign, titled "Cancel Student Debt: Build Black Women's Futures."

During this campaign, the organization will urge the Biden administration to cancel up to \$50,000 of student loan debt to help alleviate student loan debt especially for Black women.

"Canceling student debt will liberate Black women from the shackles of debt and onward to a future of generational wealth and economic freedom," Shayka Cherry-Donaldson, Executive Director of 1000 Women Strong.

During this campaign the goal is to collect more than 50,000 signatures from now until the end of August. In addition to the petition drive, 1000 Women's Strong Black Women's Organizing Directory program is introducing a new endeavor to create and develop a national Black Women's Organizing to showcase how Black women are organizing different efforts in their prospective communities to build Black thriving lives.

The goal is to have 10,000 individuals and groups sign up through the organizing di-

# PARENTAL PEACE!

Swamped Wisconsin parents happy for kids to spend more time online, reveals poll

**40%** of parents have changed their outlook towards spending more time online to a more positive one since the pandemic.

**MORE THAN HALF** admit lockdowns would have been harder without their kids having access to online games.

**55%** say they've bonded more with their children since the start of the pandemic.

Just like the rest of us, kids' screen time has skyrocketed since the pandemic; and while it's surely been a major win for young ones during lockdown, it's more likely that parents are benefitting more from the digital distraction...

While in pre-pandemic times, parents would often limit screentime and encourage their kids to spend more time outdoors, it appears spending time online, such as gaming, has brought with it invaluable breathing room for parents who continue to work from home, in which they attempt to do their jobs while running a household. In research studies, Black women carry the highest student loan debt of any racial or ethnic group. The average Black woman leaves college with at least \$34,000 in debt.


Canceling student debt can help solve those problems and close the racial wealth gap by more than 20 percent—securing financial stability and economic mobility for Black, Latinx, and other people of color who are disproportionately burdened by loans, while addressing the debt crisis for millions.

# State's parents happy their kids are spending more time online!

Solitaired.com ran a poll of 3,000 parents, revealing that parents in Wisconsin are allowing their kids to spend over 40% more time online now, as compared to before the pandemic.

When it comes to online gaming, almost half admit they've changed their attitudes towards it since the start of the pandemic, and are seeing it as a positive addition to their kids' lives, rather than something that's an unhealthy obsession. Of course, it's important to balance screen time with activities like exercise and getting outdoors. For many kids who have had to do these activities alone over the past year due to lockdowns, online gaming has often been their main social connection to the outside world.

When asked what benefits parents think are provided by online gaming, 9% agreed that it's a boost to their kids' reading skills. Another 9% agree that it's good for visual-spatial skills, 38% said it assists with problem-solving skills; provides social connections with similar interests (16%); boost to creativity (16%) and an optimistic 13% feel it could turn into a career. Perhaps they believe their kid could be the next PewDiePie, who has over 110 million subscribers on YouTube!

Over half of parents (56%) admit that lockdowns would have been harder without their kids having access to online games. But that aside, it's nice to hear that 55% of parents say they've bonded more with their children since the start of the pandemic. Indeed, through the course of history, parents have often struggled to relate to teenagers.

And spending more time with them over the past year, it would be assumed they would at the very least pick up some words and phrases on how they communicate with friends, particularly when it comes to online. Apparently not, according to the survey.

When quizzed on online slang and gaming lingo, they performed particularly poorly. Just 24% of Wisconsin parents were able to understand the meaning of words like 'Lit' [amazing, cool or exciting], 'Dope' [cool or awesome], 'Thirsty' [trying to get attention], 'Snatched' [looking good, perfect or fashionable] or 'Shook' [to be shocked or shaken up] - below the national average of 27%.

Solitaired.com has created an online quiz so that you can test your own familiarity with online gaming vocab.

'It's something that would have been totally unexpected in pre-pandemic times: parents now view online games in an overwhelmingly positive way' says says Neal Taparia from Solitaired.com.

'Rather than have to drag kids away from laptops and consoles, they now appear to recognize online gaming's overwhelmingly positive attributes.'


