## STATE AARP FRUSTRATED BUT OPTIMISTIC THAT BUDGET PROPOSALS HELPING THOSE 50-PLUS WILL BE ADDRESSED BY SEPARATE LEGISLATION THIS FALL

MADISON, WI – AARP Wisconsin today voiced its disappointment that many provisions included in the governor's original biennial budget proposal to help Wisconsinites age 50-plus are not part of the 2021-23 budget that he signed into law yesterday.

However, AARP Wisconsin State Director Sam Wilson said he is confident that some of these provisions will be revived and passed as separate legislation this fall or funded by the governor through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). "Governor Evers didn't have the authority to add some critical items back

into the budget that would have helped many vulnerable Wisconsinites as they age.

But his veto of some rainy day transfers means there is some general purpose revenue available to correct these oversights in the fall session," Wilson said.

AARP Wisconsin was supportive of several of the governor's original budget proposals that unfortunately were removed by the Joint Finance Committee and not included in the budget bill passed by the state Assembly and Senate.

They included provisions that would have provided more support for Wiscon-

sin's nearly 600,000 unpaid family caregivers, help for those who are struggling to afford their prescription medications, and new options for workers across the state to save for their retirement.

"We were also hopeful that more would be done to expand affordable, accessible, reliable high-speed internet service to all parts of Wisconsin, including many underserved rural areas. This is no longer a luxury

for folks of all ages – it's a necessity," Wilson said.

Wilson said thousands of Wisconsinites made it clear during the Joint Finance Committee's state budget public hearings this year that all of these issues are extremely important to them.

He is still optimistic that much can be done going forward, either by using funding made available through the ARPA, or as separate bills that AARP

will support in the fall session.

"We have great faith that our state lawmakers can work together in a bipartisan manner to pass legislation this fall that truly reflects the critical wants and needs of our most vulnerable citizens.

In order to achieve this, however, we ask them once again to put politics aside and act in the best interest of all Wisconsinites," Wilson said.

# Summer Pet Safety Tips

Some pet safety tips to prevent heatstroke are to avoid exercising your pet on days when the temperature or humidity is high and keep plenty of water on hand when you and your pup go out.

When you exercise your furry friend this summer, make sure you have lots of water and take a lot of cool down breaks.

Plan your exercise sessions for the early morning or in the

evening to avoid the heat of the day.

### 3. Make Sure Your Pet has More than Enough Water

One of the main ways dogs cool down is by drinking cool water. Be sure to bring plenty of water for your days at the park. Keep their water dish full at home as well. Keep a collapsible water bowl in your car or truck so you can share your water with your pet if you get stuck in traffic.

### 4. Take Time to Cool Down Your Pet on Hot Days and After Exercise

Fans are not the best way to cool down pets. Since dogs mostly sweat through their paws, you'll want to take them somewhere where they can walk through or swim in some water.

Sprinklers and hoses are fun and work great. You can also feed your pet frozen, pet-friendly treats. Most dogs love frozen nuggets of peanut butter.

After exercise, take your furry friend to a cool, air-conditioned, or shaded area. Sprinkle and splash cool water on their paws or feet.

Fill up a hollow Kong toy with water and treats and freeze it to give them a treat to cool down with. Cats usually prefer air conditioning to getting wet, but you can put some ice cubes in their water dish to help keep them cool.

On your days on the trail or in the park, you may want to bring a picnic cooler filled with ice to put in your pet's water or to rub on their tummy to keep them cool. This is one of those pet safety tips that will allow you and your pet to have a blast all day long.

### 5. Use Sunscreen to Protect Your Pet from Sunburn

Yes, pets can get sunburned, too. Find a sunscreen made for babies or pets and apply it to their back, nose, the skin around their lips, the tips of their ears, their tummy, and their inner thighs.

Sun can reflect off water and sand to burn your four-legged friend's underside, so don't neglect those areas. Summer pet safety tips like this one gets overlooked a lot, but can save your pet from a painful burn.

### 6. Protect Your Pet Against Bugs

We're not the only ones who start to get more active in the summer. Bugs like ticks, fleas, mosquitoes, and flies are at their peak in the hot months. Ask your vet about what type of bug prevention you should use for your pet.

### 7. Keep Your Pet Away From Hot Pavement

Pavement can quickly get hot enough to fry an egg on summer days. Protect your pet's paws by avoiding pavement that's in the sun.

Even on mild summer days of 77°F, pavement in the sun can reach temps of up to 125°. When temperatures get up past 80°, pavement in direct sunlight can cause burns on your feet, and your dog or cats pads are more sensitive than human feet are.

### 8. Secure Your Pet

Walking your dog or cat is a great way for both you and your best friend to get some much needed exercise. Be sure to check your state's leash laws, as they can vary. Look for a dog leash that is long enough to let you retain control.

Most cat leashes are retractable to allow your kitty to roam. If you're going to be walking your dog at night make sure that you carry a flashlight and wear bright clothes so you can be seen more easily. You can also get a collar light for your pet that will make him or her easy to spot!

During barbecues, picnics, and bonfires, make sure you keep your pet tied up to keep them from eating something that will make them sick and from getting burned.

Summer poses additional threats for mold to impact your home and health, according to international mold expert, Michael Rubino, President of All American Restoration and author of *The Mold Medic: An Expert's Guide on Mold Removal*.

Rubino stressed three ways to protect yourself against mold this summer:

**Check your house plants.**  
"Water is essential for a plant's

Leaky pots are a common place for mold to grow and could be detrimental to the home.

**Pro tip:** have a basin underneath the pot to catch any potential water spills."

**Clean your car.** Mold can be found in cars, and especially can grow during the summer when wet beach towels or iced coffees, etc. are left.

**Don't open the windows of your house when the air conditioning is on.** "It may seem innocent or convenient to leave doors or windows open and let fresh air in, but when you do so, you're also letting excess heat and humidity into your chilly home.

And whenever there's a big

temperature differential like this, excess moisture builds.

It could encourage the growth of allergenic species of mold, commonly known as aspergillus or cladosporium, which are still environmental irritants and can be dangerous in large quantities."

Rubino has made it his life's work to challenge archaic industry practices and introduce a more holistic approach, shifting the mold remediation industry away from a "construction project" and to crucial health-based conversation.


