

## **VISIT MKE Announces** Dr. Eve M. Hall as **Chair of the Board** of Directors

Steve Baas to Continue as Vice Chair; Omar Shaikh Concludes Board Service after Five Years

VISIT Milwaukee announced yesterday that Dr. Eve M. Hall, president and chief executive officer of the Milwaukee Urban League, has been unanimously elected to serve as the next chair of the VISIT Milwaukee Board of Directors for a one-year term beginning yesterday, July 28.

Her appointment was announced yesterday during the organization's annual meeting at the Miller High Life Theatre, which was attended by more than 400 business leaders,




