New York Republican Congresswoman Elise Stefanik and Ohio GOP hopeful JD Vance recently have been outspoken in supporting ‘replacement theory.’

Stefanik used the concept in her 2021 campaign ads saying, ‘radical Democrats are planning their most aggressive move yet: a permanent election insurrection.’

Vance, a Donald Trump-endorsed candidate, recently ratcheted up the rhetoric.

‘You’re talking about a shift in the democratic makeup of this country that would mean we never win, meaning Republicans would never win a national election in this country ever

“WE are the ONES We’ve been WAITING For!”

To overcome the crisis of gun violence and poverty, Black Milwaukee MUST control its own dollars and community institutions!

As you know by now, 10 Black Buffalo natives were shot and killed by a racist, conspiracy-touting White supremacist at a grocery store located in that city’s Black community.

The act is rightfully being called a ‘hate crime.’

You could say the shooting here in the ‘Brew City’ that occurred on May 13 was a ‘self-hate’ crime. Seventeen people were shot in multiple shootings that day (Friday the 13th no less) in and around the downtown area known as ‘The Deer District’—a large outdoor courtyard surrounded by bars and restaurants.

Thousands of fans were watching on a large screen TV their hometown Bucks lose to the Boston Celtics at the Fiserv Forum just next door, forcing a game seven in ‘Beantown’ (which the Celtics won that Sunday, by-the-way, sending the Bucks home for the season).

Those who perpetrated the heinous act were males—five of them—presumably African American, ranging in age between 20 and 30 (the MPD reportedly arrested six additional men in connection to the ‘Deer District’ shootings).

Fortunately, there were no deaths reported from the incident.

again,” he claimed at a campaign event last month.
Vance’s defeated opponent, Josh Mandel, also ran on “replacement theory.”
“This is about changing the face of America, figuratively and literally,”

Mandel stated in a published interview.
“They are trying to change our culture, change our demographics and change our electorate. This is all about power,” he said.
So far, the only Republican politician of note to call out the racist rhetoric is Wyoming Congresswoman Liz Cheney.
“The House GOP leadership has enabled white nationalism, white suprem-

acy, and anti-semitism,” Cheney wrote on Twitter. “History has taught us that what begins with words ends in far worse. @GOP leaders must renounce and reject these views and those who hold them.”
Meanwhile, among the victims in the Buffalo shooting was a former police officer, and 11 of the 13 killed or injured were Black.

told the Associated Press.
Loehr, 34, of Washington, wore a black T-shirt with an image of the late Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg’s “dissent” collar on it and a necklace that spelled out “vote.”
Kelley Robinson, executive director of the Planned Parenthood Action Fund, counted among the speakers at the National Mall.
She declared that abortion rights are under attack.
“We are here because these folks are trying to kick us out of the Constitution and take away a Constitutional right we’ve had for the last 50 years,” Robinson said.
“We are here to show them that we are the majority.”

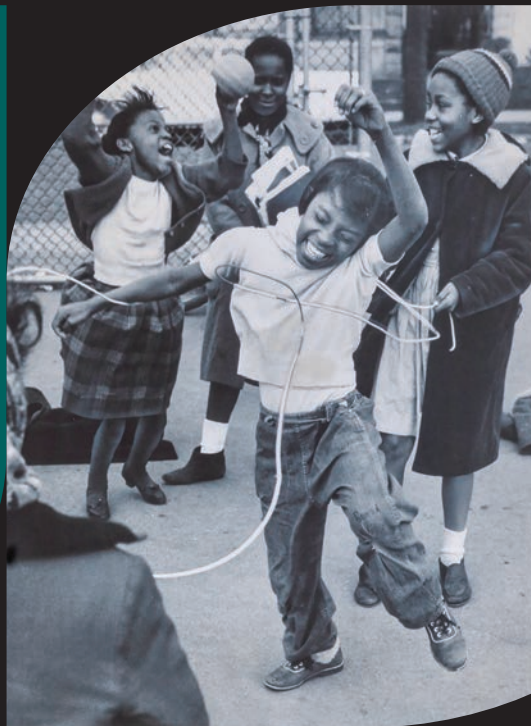

When our own people mistake the Ankh for a cross, we have a problem community!

Explaining the difference between a cross and an ankh to two young sisters at Walmart recently left me somewhat untinged.

Not that I was unwilling to elucidate, but because it again brought to mind the declarations posited in historian Carter G. Woodson's masterpiece, 'The Miseducation of the Negro.'

I guess I naively assumed our government-run school system had evolved from the racist curriculum of my youth—a tainted syllabus that portrayed us as 'happy-go-lucky African slaves.'

I naively thought there would be a few new consensus chapters added to their 'His-story' courses by now. That it now included that Abe Lincoln was actually a racist, the Emancipation Proclamation didn't free all of the slaves and was probably illegal, and Tarzan was not the king of the jungle.

I was essentially wrong on both counts.

Moreover, if recent conversations with local Black youth validate the new educational reality, my generation's hunger for knowledge didn't survive the 20th century.

Obviously, a large percentage of today's parents—or should I say parent (singular)—have succumbed to a new version of vassalage, one in which they believe they came not from Africa—the Motherland—but someplace called 'Niggerland' (excuse me, 'N-land').

I assume that monarchy is led by 'King Tom' and his queen, 'Jemima.'

In other words, the brainwashed blind can't lead the innocently ignorant, even with a braill map.

In fact, it's impossible to impress upon your children the richness of our collective culture if you view yourself using denigrating imagery—niggers (n-word) and bitches (b-word) versus the descendants of kings and queens.

Conversely, for local government school system teachers—75% of whom don't look like the Black majority—there is little incentive to empower their 'clients' with the power inherent in historical truth.

I'm not talking about our links to Kemet, which most of you don't know about either. I'm talking about our vast contributions to science, medicine, and math throughout the African diaspora. Of the great kingdoms of Kush, Ghana, and Nubia. Or the great empires of Egypt, Songhai, and Ethiopia.

We were inventors, physicians, and scientists when those who became enslavers and exploiters were living in caves.

But our ancestors closed their eyes for a moment, and before they realized it, the evil empires of Europe stole our land and replaced our God (Nyame) with a blond-haired, blue-eyed illusion.

We were no longer Nyame's firstborn but servants of a racist doctrine that put those of little melanin superior to all 'Hue-mans.'

Long before the condescending statement of former HUD Secretary Ben Carson that slavery was beneficial because it introduced our (supposedly) uncivilized and morally bankrupt African ancestors to 'White Christianity,' the government school system posited we willingly boarded the slave vessel HMS Jesus (a real ship) and threw away our return tickets after being convinced America was the home of the free, where all men were equal.

Naw. That mistake cost us millions of lives.

I'm quite sure many in and outside the community felt the curfew imposed by Mayor Cavalier Johnson for the entire weekend was appropriate, believing the shootings have to stop and calling on the 'thugs' to put down the guns.

But the problem of gangs and shootings such as the one that occurred last weekend here, runs deeper than calling for a halt to the madness and establishing a curfew, or calls to “put down the guns!”

Long-time community elder, ‘Paramount Chief,’ and Black community booster Reuben Harpole has a saying: “We are the ones we’ve been waiting for!”

In other words, if we want to deal with and end the spiral of gun violence our community is in, WE are the ones who have to deal with the crisis ourselves, as a Black community.

Milwaukee's Black community must take control of its institutions of education, small business development, housing and how we interact with each other as Black people (the church must play a role as well, but must do more than be open on Sunday and Wednesday night for bible study).

As the late local historian and educator Taki Raton would often say: We (Black people) must ‘debrief’ each other in order to deal successfully with our mental state as a people (which is at the crux of the crisis of gun violence), which is born out of a history of slavery, Jim Crow and lynchings (both physical and mental), red-lining, segregation, discrimination, and ‘gentlemen’s agreements’ that continue—in some shape, form or fashion—today (all of which have been exacerbated by COVID-19).

Just saying ‘stop’ and locking up the bad actors isn’t enough. Quite frankly, it’s the wrong position/action to take and use if we are to turn our situation—as a people—around.

Black Milwaukee must be at the forefront of creating an initiative that harnesses all the ‘assets’ (businesses, private/independent schools; and cultural institutions like Wisconsin’s Black Historical Society and America’s Black Holocaust Museum) that still exists in our community and moves them in a direction far different than the city’s mainstream institutions of government and business believe may work or haven’t considered either out of ignorance or fear of losing control and dollars in and from our community.

Make no mistake. Our problems and who will ‘solve’ those problems is all about the money and who controls the money.

I believe Black Milwaukee and its remaining institutions must be in control of the money and where it

should go to have the most impact if we are to solve our community’s problems.

I envision Black Milwaukee having its on United Way. This...our... United Way would gather the hundreds-of-billions (some believe trillions) of disposable income our community generates (fast/junk food, cigarettes, clothing, alcohol, entertainment, and yes drugs (mostly marijuana) and put it into a ‘fund’ and divided in the community by a board of old and new business owners/entrepreneurs, community residents, and activists in the form of ‘no-interest’ loans and grants.

These ‘no-interest’ loans and grants would go to individuals to buy homes, or to current homeowners to perform much needed repairs or rehab their properties.

The dollars would also go to fledgling entrepreneurs or those who want to be entrepreneurs to start their own businesses; buying up abandoned storefronts and turning them into individual oasis of commerce.

Established businesses could use the money to expand their businesses and update them with the latest in business technology.

Educators—veterans and new—who have dreams of opening their own schools and teaching not only the ‘three R’s,’ but reviving long-lost courses as home economics and the trades, while experiencing the freedom of imparting on their young charges ‘Our Story’ without interference from ‘anti-history’ (Black history to be exact) ‘Critical Race Theory’ zealots.

It will take discipline and integrity on the part of the board’s members to ‘do the right thing’ in flipping the ‘culture of poverty and violence’ common in the predominantly Black zip codes of this city.
