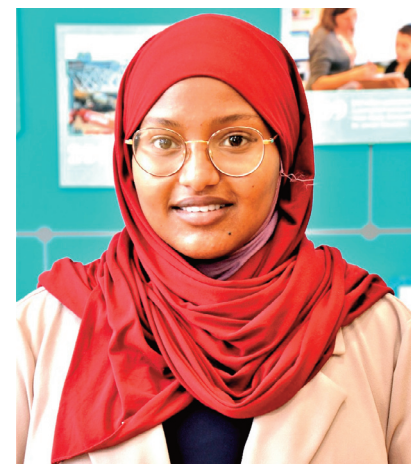

Outdoor Pool & Splash Pad Season to Begin Early June

Milwaukee County Parks' summer pool season will begin in June with the opening of five splash pads, nine wading pools and four outdoor pools: Schulz Aquatic Center at Lincoln Park, Sheridan Park Pool, Wilson Park Pool and McCarty Park Pool. Full details of pool hours and fees will be available at www.MKEswim.com.

Milwaukee County Parks has also partnered with Milwaukee Recreation to offer lifeguard prep, open swim and lap swim times, at six Milwaukee Recreation sites: Marshall High School, Vincent High School, MKE High School of the Arts, North Division High School, Hamilton High School and Washington High School. (Opportunities may change depending on staff fluctuation leading into summer.)

After six months of efforts to recruit lifeguards, which

included raising hourly wages and adding summer bonuses, the trend, unfortunately, remained the same as around the US - a decline in the number of applicants for lifeguard positions.

This season only 60 lifeguards have been hired, far short of the 200 needed.

"Challenges hiring lifeguards have been seen by communities across the region and even the whole country.

So, unfortunately, many cities and towns are having to limit the aquatic facilities they're opening." Said Guy Smith, Executive Director of Milwaukee County Parks.

"While we're only able to open a limited number of facilities this summer, we've worked closely with our partners, including Milwaukee Recreation and the City of Milwaukee, to ensure that equitable access to pools will still be available across the entire county "

One final chance to become a Milwaukee County Parks lifeguard has been added too.

The express session, ideal for strong swimmers, will take place Monday May 23 to Thursday May 26 from 5:00 p.m. - 7:30 p.m. each night, at Pulaski Indoor Pool. Applicants will need to take part in the training sessions each day, and pass a test on Saturday May 28 at 8 a.m.

The hourly rate for lifeguards for the 2022 season

to between \$16.14-\$22 depending on position and associated certifications.

Due to ongoing staffing and funding challenges, all other pools and water parks will remain closed this summer.

No lifeguards will be posted at Bradford Beach again this summer, and the beach at McKinley Park will remain closed while the safety study on dangerous rip currents continues.


