

ANNOUNCES PLANS TO BUILD **AN ULTRAMODERN GYM AND CLASS SPACE**

Victory Christian Academy (VCA); a Milwaukeebased provider of K-12 education tolow-income families in the greater Milwaukee area emphasizing academic excellence, multiculturalism, character development and continuous learning; has announced its plans to build a new 30,000 square-foot ultramodern gymnasium and new class space at 2840 S. 10th Street.

The project will include expanded technology centers, new cafeteria facilities and the re-design of a parking lot for the new space. Construction could start as early as September 2022. VCA is planning for all of its K - 12 grades to start using the new building in time for next year's school year, or starting in August 2023.

VCA will be adding the 12th grade and will provide K-12 education for the first time for the community in August 2023. VCA is working with Milwaukee-based Abacus Architects, and has unveiled the initial internal and external renderings of its new gymnasium and class space. T&R Investments, LLC is the project developer.

VCA was founded in 1999 by Vyon Rogers to provide exemplary education to low-income families in the greater Milwaukee area emphasizing academic excellence, multiculturalism, character development and continuous learning.

VCA uses professional coaching and mentorship strategies that

Racist 'Replacement' Rhetoric is Deadly and **Republicans Must** Stop Using It

The young man who murdered 10 people in Buffalo, New York on May 14, was out to kill Black people. He chose a grocery store because he wanted to leave the local Black community in fear of going about their daily lives.

These evil actions were motivated by a racist ideology known as the Great Replacement Theory. That should cause some serious reflection among Republicans who are trying to build power with their own versions of racist "replacement" rhetoric.

Replacement rhetoric is meant to tap into a very old fear: that the survival and dominance of white Ameri-



cans is threatened by others — whether by the freedom and empowerment of Black people or immigration by people of color.

Frederick Douglass, one of the great Americans of all time, de-

support its students, and provide the tools needed to become highly equipped for the world they live in. Many of VCA's alumni are catalysts for positive change in Milwaukee.Currently, VCA provides classes and activities for its students out of two separate buildings at 6021 W Lincoln Avenue, West Allis, WI 53219 and 2840 S 10th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53215. VCA is currently exceeding its capacity and is continuing

The new project will provide the additional capacity VCA needs, allow it to combine both of its campuses, and provide quality athletic facilities for its students and for a community in need. The new gymnasium marks the first time VCA students will have access to this type of facility in the 23 years of the existence of the school. This new building will allow VCA to gather all of its approximately 250 students on one campus when needed.

VCA plans to use the new building to provide athletics, physical education classes, afterschool activities, and as an auditorium for large school events, etc. VCA will also establish a hydroponics center in the new building, which will provide training and new jobs for students, as well as allow the school to provide a farmers market to the community.

In addition, the new ultramodern gymnasium will be qualified to host AAU Basketball Tournaments. Currently there is an extremely low supply in Milwaukee

of quality facilities such as this one for the major tournaments that come each

"At Victory Christian Academy, we endeavor to develop leaders and entrepreneurs in Milwaukee and its neighboring communities," said D.L. Rogers, Victory Christian Academy board president. "We are expanding our collaborative partnerships with neighborhood organizations and local businesses to help shape our students as pacesetters for impacting their communities.

We believe this should intrinsically happen on an organic, grassroots level where our students model family values through academic excellence."

VCA has secured an initial loan but there are currently no grants supporting the project. Because of supply chain issues, VCA was recently informed that the total estimated costs for the project will be an additional estimated \$1.5 million. VCA is in the process of securing these additional funds.

In addition, VCA also has plans to remodel its' existing building at 2840 S 10th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53215. These plans involve improving the learning environment by removing the walls of two kindergarten rooms on the first floor to increase the square footage for teaching, including bathrooms in each of these rooms and on the second floor, removing coatrooms to increase the space for classrooms and build cabinets for the classrooms. There are also plans to resurface the parking lot, etc.

nounced that ideology shortly after the end of the Civil War.

Born into slavery, Douglass became a great anti-slavery speaker and organizer. He gave a series of important anti-slavery speeches in Buffalo, near where he lived in Rochester, and where a statue of him in his hometown has been repeatedly vandalized.

In 1869, this Black Republican gave a speech called "Our Composite Nation."

He promoted a vision of a country that welcomed and was strengthened by diversity. And he denounced fears that were being stirred up against Chinese immigrants. He said that the idea that "the Caucasian race may not be able to hold their own" against immigrants "does not seem entitled to much respect."

Truth.

Replacement ideology is still not worthy of respect. It is toxic. And it promotes violence.

The man arrested for the killings in Buffalo reportedly claimed that he picked up his anti-Semitic and racist beliefs from some of the unsavory corners of the internet. He decided to kill Black people in Buffalo. Others who have been twisted by the same racist ideas chose to kill Latinos in El Paso, Jews in Pittsburgh, Muslims in Christchurch, New Zea-

Unfortunately, millions of Americans are hearing variations of the replacement rhetoric from irresponsible politicians and cable TV personalities. They falsely claim that Democrats want "open borders" so they can replace American voters with what Tucker Carlson called "more obedient voters from the Third World."

Carlson has used that kind of rhetoric more than 400 times on his highly rated show. And this year at least half a dozen Republican Senate candidates have been running their

reelection campaigns on the idea.

It seems that the Republican Party, the party of Abraham Lincoln, is acting more like the old Democratic Party did after the Civil War. It is becoming a party defined by its willingness to use the ideology of violent white supremacists to try to stir up voters and win elections.

This is playing with fire. And if it continues, we will all get burned, again and again.

There is a more honorable path for the Republican Party. I believe national Republicans should go to Buffalo. They should reflect on the killings that were motivated by racist ideas. They should reflect on the legacy of Frederick Douglass. And they should consider the life of a more recent Republican, the late Jack Kemp.

Kemp had been a quarterback for the Buffalo Bills. Then he became a Republican congressman representing western New York. And he ran for president as both a Republican and a card-carrying member of the NAACP. "I can't help but care about the rights of the people I used to shower with," Kemp said.

We urgently need more of our national leaders to embrace Douglass's broad vision of a strong and diverse America, and Jack Kemp's recognition of our shared humanity. And we need more people, both politicians and regular folks, to have the courage to consistently call out bigotry when we hear it and to hold accountable those who spread it.


