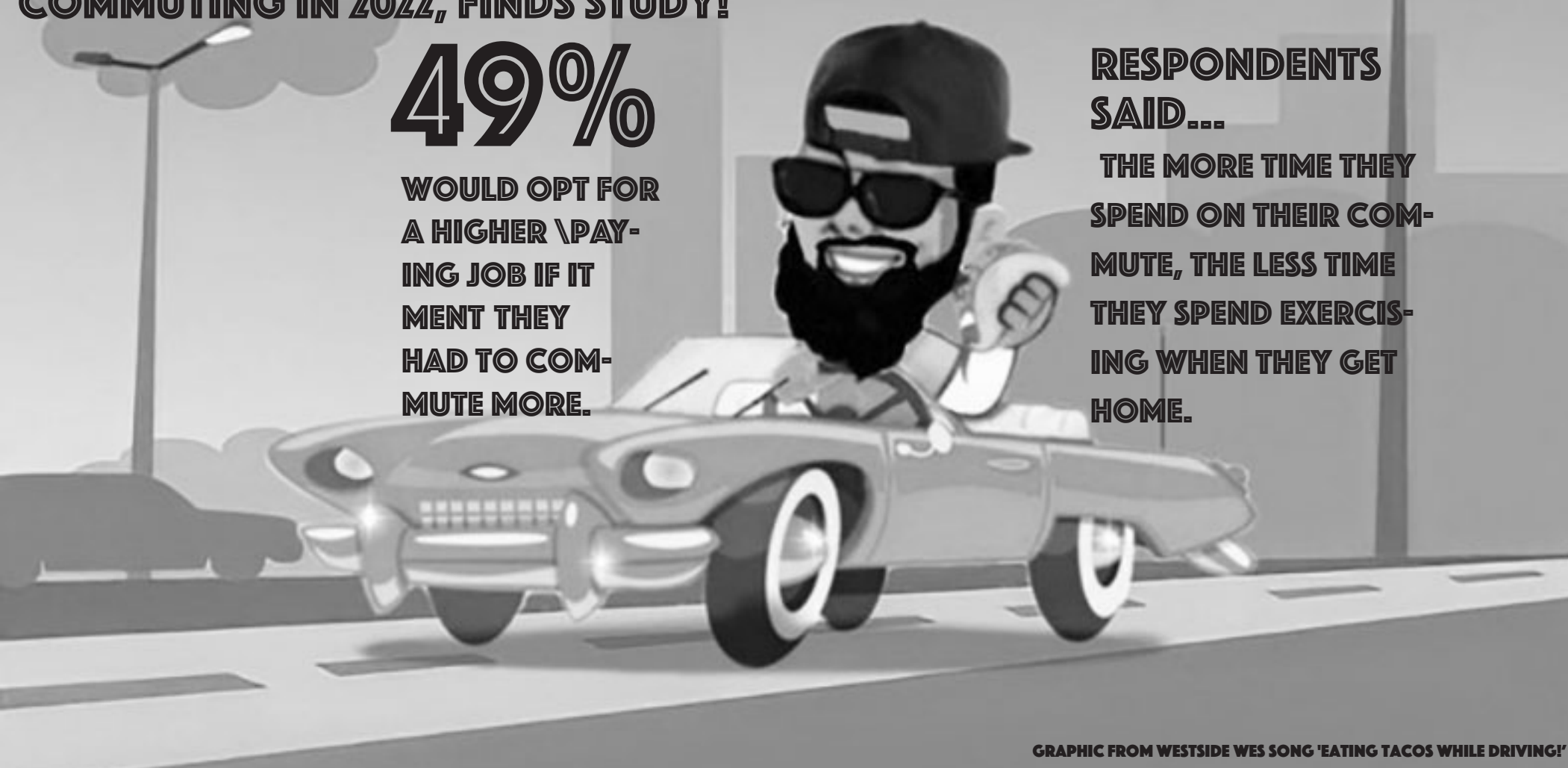

The average Wisconsin commuter consumed over 198k calories while driving in 2022\*, according to a study commissioned by Gunther Mazda.

This is 763 calories alone per commute, or one half of the daily recommended intake. In fact, a study found that 85 million Americans admit to eating fast food every day. Now that the world has been getting back to normal, more and more employees are returning to the office - and that means the return of the era of

the long commute. But it's all too easy to try and break up a long, boring journey with a distraction - such as food. A person's likelihood of becoming obese increases by 6% for every hour spent commuting, as well as an increased risk of high blood pressure. Long commute times are linked to factors like insufficient physical activity, and poor sleep habits.

Broken down by state, Gunther Mazda found that Nevadans consumed the most calories on their commute this year - a substantial 287k. On the other hand, those in Maine, with perhaps shorter distances to travel, consumed the least - just 65k in 2022. On a national scale, the average driver consumed 199,997 calories this past year.

The study also found the following:

While commuting, drivers say they normally consume chips (32%) - presumably they're easy to access with one hand, while keeping the other on the steering wheel. This was followed by burgers (30%), fries (24%), burritos (6%), chocolate (4%), tacos (2%) and ice cream (2%).

75% of commuters say that the more time they spend on their commute, the less time they spend exercising when they get home. And despite the potential health detriments, 49% would opt for a higher paying job if it mean they had to commute more.

While there is not a law against eating or drinking in your car per se, it can certainly be a recipe for disaster. Taking your eyes off the road while grabbing the chips from your bag, or unwrapping a burger at the wheel does count as distracted driving. If a police officer believes that you are distracted at the wheel, then you can face penalties or fines. In fact, a recent study found that 18% of all crashes are caused by distracted driving.

Some foods or drinks may be trickier to consumer than others. Coffee for example could be a risky beverage while driving. You might think that the barista put the lid on properly, but if it slips while turning, you could end up with boiling hot coffee on your lap while at the wheel. Another important factor to

consider when eating and driving is that most people feel very sleepy after eating. This is because after a meal your body experiences a drop in blood sugar. After eating sweets or refined carbohydrates, you experience increased levels of insulin, but after a while your blood sugar crashes which results in lethargy, fatigue, cravings and brain fog. As a driver it is important to constantly remain alert and present when driving. Pronounced lethargy from eating could result in a lack of concentration and focus when driving which could result in fatal accidents.

'Spending a lot of time in the car can clearly encourage unhealthy habits,' says Joseph Gunther IV at GuntherMazda.com. 'As more and more of us return to pre-pandemic levels of commuting, perhaps now would be a good time to re-set and change eating habits, so we feel healthier generally and more alert behind the wheel.'

# KWANZAA 101: How to observe this annual family and community holiday

Kwanzaa is a yearlong celebration that focuses on seven life principles called Nguzo Saba.

Kwanzaa was created by Dr. Maulana Karenga , a professor of Black Studies, in 1966 during the time of profound social change for African Americans, Karenga's vision of a celebration that would honor the values of African cultures and inspire African Americans who were working for/towards progress.

The celebration honors African culture in the diaspora is observed from December 26 to January 1.

Each of the seven days observed for Kwanzaa is a mark of distinction of a different life principle. The Nguzo Saba, are principles that are believed to be the foundation of building resilient, prolific families and communities on the continent of Africa as well as in the Diaspora.

The Nguzo Saba (The Seven Principles of Kwanzaa) comes from the native language Swahili of the Bantu people in East Africa. During the observed time of Kwanzaa, celebrants greet each other using the Swahili greeting;Habari gani,meaning-What's the news? The principles of Kwanzaa (Nguzo Saba) form the answers.

**Nguzo Saba: The Principles of Kwanzaa**  
Umoja (oo-MOH-ja)  
Meaning: unity  
Action: building a community that holds together  
Kujichagulia (koo-jee-cha-goo-LEE-yah)  
Meaning: self-determination  
Action: speaking for yourself and making choices that

benefit the community  
**Ujima** (oo-JEE-mah)  
Meaning: collective work and responsibility  
Action: helping others within the community  
**Ujamaa** (oo-JAH-ma)  
Meaning: cooperative economics  
Action: supporting businesses that care about the community  
**Nia** (nee-AH)  
Meaning: a sense of purpose  
Action: setting goals that benefit the community  
**Kuumba** (koo-OOM-bah)  
Meaning: creativity  
Action: making the community better and more beautiful

**Imani** (ee-MAH-nee)  
Meaning: faith.  
Action: believing that a better world can be created for communities now and in the future

Also, during this time of observed celebration it is encouraged to display seven symbols to join the community of people of color together. We adorn our homes with red, black, and green as well as African-style textiles and art. Not forgetting to add the Seven Symbols of Kwanzaa:

**The Seven Symbols of Kwanzaa:**  
**kikombe cha umoja**  
Meaning: the unity cup  
Action: Celebrants drink from this cup in honor of their African ancestors.  
**kinara**  
Meaning: the candleholder, which holds seven candles  
Action: It said to symbolize stalks of corn that branch off to form new stalks, much as the human family is created.  
**mazao**  
Meaning: fruits, nuts, and vegetables  
Action: These remind celebrants of the harvest fruits that

nourished the people of Africa.  
**mishumaa saba**  
Meaning: the seven candles that represent the seven principles  
Action: A different candle is lit each day. Three candles on the left are green; three on the right are red; and in the middle is a black candle.  
**mkeka**  
Meaning: mat

Action: The symbols of Kwanzaa are arranged on the mkeka, which may be made of straw or African cloth.  
It symbolizes the foundation upon which communities are built.  
**vibunzi** (plural, muhindi)  
Meaning: ear of corn  
Action: Traditionally, one ear of corn is placed on the mkeka for each child present.

**zawadi**  
Meaning: gifts  
Action: Traditionally, educational and cultural gifts are given to children on January 1.

**The last day of Kwanzaa: The Great Fest:**

December 31, is the day of Kuumba (Creativity). It is also the day that

families/communities gather for the great feast of karamu. During this time, karamu enjoys traditional African dishes as well as those featuring ingredients our ancestors brought to the United States, such as sesame seeds (benne), peanuts (ground-nuts), sweet potatoes, collard greens, and spicy sauces.

Kwanzaa is a true celebration of culture that is observed during the last seven days (December 26-January 1) of the year, with hope that our communities intertwine the Nguzo Saba (The Seven Principles) into the fabric of their lives.

Knowing that without the foundation of unity, being committed to self-determination, understanding that with collective work and responsibility brings forth cooperative economics, therein as a movement we can gain our purpose, explore our creativity, all while standing together in faith throughout the next 365 days of the year.

# Tina Turner's son Ronnie Turner dies at 62: 'This is a tragedy,' wife says

**Ronnie Turner, whose father was Tina's ex-husband Ike Turner, was a musician like his parents**

Ronnie Turner, the son of legendary singer Tina Turner, died at 62.

Ronnie's wife, French singer

Afida Turner, confirmed her husband's death in an Instagram post in which she called him "a true angel" and her "best friend."

"I did my best to the end this time. I couldn't save you. I love you for... 17 years. This is really, really bad and I'm so angry," she wrote in the caption of the post.

"This is a tragedy, you with your brother Craig and your father Ike Turner and Aline rest in paradise .... So unfair," she continued.

Afida, who married Ronnie in 2007, was referring to the death of her older brother Craig, who committed suicide in 2018. Ronnie's father, Ike Turner, died in 2007, while his

aunt, Tina's sister Alline Bullock, died in 2010.

A Los Angeles Police Department spokesperson confirmed that officers responded to Turner's address in Encino, California at 9:40 a.m. for a death investigation involving a man.

The spokesman could not confirm the man's identity.

TMZ, which first reported the news, said the 911 caller said Ronnie was having trouble breathing and eventually stopped breathing. Despite CPR attempts by bystanders, paramedics pronounced him dead at the scene.

Tina, 83, welcomed Ronnie with her then-husband Ike in 1960. He joined his older brother Craig, whom Tina had at age 18 with saxophonist Raymond Hill, although Ike later adopted Craig.

The singer renounced her U.S. citizenship in 2013 and has lived in Europe with her husband, German record executive Erwin Bach, since 1995.

Ronnie was an accomplished musician like his parents and played in a band called Manufactured Funk. He also had a small role in his mother's 1993 biopic "What's Love Got to Do with It."

## 'The View' fans call for Whoopi Goldberg's firing for being 'crazy and rude'

Fans of the hit morning talk show "The View" are demanding Whoopi Goldberg's firing for going "crazy" while on air.

Many of the show's fans have called on producers to shake up the cast after the popular show faced a series of recent gaffes.

On Friday, Whoopi, 66, took part in the panel and spoke about parenting when she used the word 'a \*\*', leaving fans shocked.

Goldberg said, "Sometimes you have to be an idiot to be a parent."

The actress and comedian's language did not go down well with fans, as they took to Twitter to share their views.

One wrote, "Whoopi and Sunny [Hostin]'s foul language was too much today."

Another posted, "Someone needs to start stopping Whoopi. I have a feeling someone will someday not let her assert herself, which will make Whoopi go completely insane, honestly."

She's gotten exponentially worse this season, so I hope her next contract negotiation is time to leave or work fewer days.

A third said, "... I have no idea what ABC thinks is going on here. They take several women with no real credibility and let them talk day in and day out and are surprised that someone says something stupid one day."

'Totally agree with Whoopi. Shut down any opinion she disagrees with,' a fourth said while a fifth hammered her as, "So out of touch [with reality]."

Other fans were not impressed after the hosts used profanity while discussing gun control.

Some viewers "had to turn off the show" because they couldn't tolerate the unnecessary language. Some others had children at home during their summer vacation months who can easily overhear the television broadcast.

Earlier this year, Sharon Osbourne accused ABC of not removing Whoopi Goldberg from "The View" even after minimizing the Holocaust, because according to her, "no one gives a fuck" about Jews.

Osbourne, 68, expressed concerns about a double standard when in March 2021 she was fired from CBS's rival show "The Talk" after defending British newscaster Piers Morgan's criticism of Meghan Markle, despite Goldberg keeping her job after February comments that "the Holocaust was not a race issue."

When The Times asked about the double standard, she said: "I'll tell you why, because it's the Jews, and nobody gives a f\*\*k."

Osbourne, whose music producer father, Don Arden, was Jewish, added that he likes Goldberg and was pointing out the hypocrisy of show business, rather than personally attacking the "Ghost" star.

The drama with Osbourne began when Morgan left the British chat show "Good Morning Britain" on March 9, 2021 after saying he did not believe Markle was suicidal in the wake of an interview with Oprah Winfrey.

When asked to comment on her remarks on "The Talk" the following day, Osbourne said that while she disagreed with Morgan, she supported his right to express his own view.

Her co-star Sheryl Underwood, who is black, responded forcefully and accused Osbourne of minimizing Morgan's comments and giving "validation" to her "racist" views.

Osbourne was later permanently suspended from her role on the show and resigned. In October, Osbourne revealed that CBS made Underwood take an anger management class because she "had three complaints about her from different producers about the way she treated them."
