

Milwaukee Congresswoman Gwen **Moore reviews the legislative** accomplishments of 2022!

Dear friend, I hope you are well and staying warm. I wanted to share a recap with you all of what the 117th Congress accomplished.

From lowering the cost of prescription drugs to historic investments in clean energy to delivering relief to our communities, Democrats worked to address our most pressing needs.

Inflation Reduction Act

- Cap the price monthly out-of-pocket costs for insulin at \$35 for Medicare beneficiaries, starting in 2023.
- Out-of-pocket drug costs for Medicare beneficiaries will also be capped at \$2,000 for part-D drugs.
- Incentives to purchase energy-efficient appliances, which can save families \$350 a year on energy bills,

including:

- * A tax credit to install solar panels can save families \$300 a year on energy
- * A tax credit to purchase electric vehicles can save families nearly \$1,000.
- Extend cost-saving American Rescue Plan (ARP) tax credits for three years, so you can continue saving money on your

health care through the ACA market.

- Help build a fairer tax system and improve access to taxpayer assistance by enhancing IRS funding.
- · Make historic investments in clean energy, providing good-paying manufacturing jobs.
- Help ensure the wealthy pay their fair share, including a 15 percent corporate minimum tax on large and profitable companies.

American Rescue Plan

- Provide \$1400 survival checks to millions of Americans.

- Fought food insecurity by increasing SNAP benefits by 15 percent to reach households in need.
- Help homeowners and renters stay housed by providing relief in the form of emergency assistance and the Homeowner Assistance Fund.
- Extend COVID-19 unemployment benefits.
 - Supply \$160 billion to

create a national vaccination program, robust testing, and a strong public health workforce.

- Provide \$130 billion to help schools safely reopen, along with resources to address learning loss and help support students' wellbeing.
- Deliver \$360 billion in relief to state, local, and tribal governments.
- Uplift small businesses facing loss of revenue due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

CHIPS and Science Act

- · Increase American production of semiconductors and support in research (\$57.2 billion), innovation, workforce development. and manufacturing (\$39 billion) to make America globally competitive while investing in American manufacturing.
- Expand STEM job opportunities and secures \$10 billion to support tech hubs across the country.
- Support diversity in STEM, including new initiatives for Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and other minority-serving institutions through the National Science Foundation (NSF).
- Create new investments in STEM education for K-12, community colleges,

Bipartisan Infrastructure Law

- Provide \$55 billion for clean water infrastructure. including \$15 billion specifically to remove lead pipes nationwide.
- Provided funding to Increase access to highspeed internet, so no community gets left behind.
- Provide funding to fix our crumbling roads and bridges, with Wisconsin, estimated to receive \$5.2 billion for road improvements and \$225 million for bridge enhancements.

 Successfully included provisions in the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) reauthorization that called for a study of the impact of intimate partner violence on maternal health.

 Including a proposal in the VAWA to increase tribal sovereignty, allowing tribal police to have jurisdiction over more crimes.

My provision, which I worked with my colleague Rep. Lucy McBath on, to the SECURE 2.0 Act became law that would allow domestic violence victims to withdraw funding from their retirement accounts without penalty if they are fleeing from an abuser.

hat was in addition to the over \$5 million I secured for local projects in the FY 2022 funding process.

Water Resources Development Act: My provision was included in the Water Resources Development Act of 2022 authorizing a project in Milwaukee to use green infrastructure to help reduce the volume of water entering our sewers during storm events, and contributing to sewer overflows into nearby waterbodies.

This bill became law on December 29, 2022.

I also championed community projects (formerly called earmarks), which will directly benefit Wisconsin's 4th District residents. Take

Your DNA carries a record of generations past


You get half of your DNA from your biological mother. The other half is from your biological father. Because of this, your DNA can tell you about your genetic ancestors

What you can learn

Your genetic ancestry tells you where your recent ancestors likely lived. This is based on your DNA. same region shared patterns of DNA. As they migrated and blended with others from different geographic

People often wonder if genetic ancestry and ethnicity are the same thing. They aren't. Genetic ancestry is about where on the globe your relatives came from. Ethnicity means a group of people who share things like language, religious beliefs, or culture. People of the same ethnicity often share the same genetic ancestry. But this isn't always the case.

It's also important to remember that your identity is about more than just DNA. Your story includes family stories passed down from generation to generation. Historical records can also help. Together with your DNA, this information can be used to help build your family tree and to tell the story of how your family has shaped who you are.




How we get these results and why your participation matters

Department of Justice Initiative Fights Redlining in Cyberspace and the Real World

Former Facebook and City National Bank agree to new operating terms, and investments By Charlene Crowell

As 2023 begins, a key anti-financial discrimination initiative is expanding million-dollar penalties and the kinds of businesses found to violate fair lending laws. The Combatting Redlining Initiative that since 2021 has combined resources and efforts of the Department of Justice (DOJ), Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) and the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) is now holding a social media giant as well as another bank accountable for violations of fair credit and lending laws.

A January 9 settlement with Meta Platforms - formerly Facebook, Inc. - marks the first time that a social media platform will be subject to court oversight for its advertising targeting and delivery system.

As the world's largest social media platform, the enforcement action will affect its 264 million users in the United States and Canada, as well as 10 million advertisers that in the third quarter of 2022 generated \$27.71 billion in revenues.

According to settlement terms, Meta's new system will measure algorithmic discrimination that violates the Fair Housing Act. Meta will be subject to federal court oversight monitoring and regular reviews through June 26, 2026 to determine whether all terms of the settlement are honored.

Guidehouse, Inc., an independent third-party reviewer will verify Meta's adherence to settlement metrics. Meta must provide this monitor with regular compliance reports and any necessary information.

"Federal monitoring of Meta should send a strong signal to other tech companies that they too will be held accountable for failing to address algorithmic discrimination that runs afoul of our civil rights laws," said Assistant Attorney General Kristen Clarke of the Justice's Civil Rights Division.

The Justice Department also continues to move against lenders who allow discrimination in their lending practices.

On January 12, Los Angelesbased City National Bank, with 58 California locations as well as branches in nine other states and the District of Columbia, reached a \$31 million settlement with DOJ's Redlining Initiative, the largest such agreement in DOJ's history.

According to DOJ, from 2017 until at least 2020, City National failed to provide mortgage lending in Los Angeles County's majority Black and Latino neighborhoods.

Further, during more than 20 years when the bank either opened or acquired 11 additional branches, only one was located in a majority-minority neighborhood.

And unlike branches located in majority white areas, City National did not assign any employee at that one branch to generate mortgage lending.


