putback with 1.6 seconds left.




"I knew if he missed it, that was my rebound," Prosper said, in an interview following the game.

Charles R. Rogers, PhD, was recently appointed the inaugural associate director of Community Outreach & Engagement at the Medical College of Wisconsin Cancer Center, cancer scholar endowed chair, and associate professor

at MCW's Institute for Health and Equity.

He is joining the Cancer Center from the University of Utah School of Medicine and Huntsman Cancer Institute.

He brings a wealth of expertise in areas including health education and behavior, community-engaged research, public health administration and policy, and cancer-related health disparities.

Q&A WITH DR. CHARLES R. ROGERS

What excites you most about the leadership position?

The opportunity to make a difference. Cancer does not discriminate and when it sides with social determinants of health, members of underrepresented and socially vulnerable groups often suffer the most.

This position will permit me to lead our Cancer Center in being notoriously known for rigorously utilizing community-engaged approaches to abolish cancer

inequalities in our catchment area and across the state of Wisconsin.

"We must reframe our attitudes to focus on finding the opportunity that lies in the middle of every struggle. If opportunity doesn"t knock, our teams will partner with the community to build a door."

You've founded other initiatives and organizations focused on addressing cancer inequities. What motivates you to close the gap?

I agree with Aneurin Bevan [reference to late, Welsh Minister of Health] that 'the purpose of getting power is to be able to give it away.' It's very important for me to use the power I have—resulting from my training and expertise—to look out for the 'underdog' intentionally and strategically from a justice-guided perspective.

For instance, African American men have died from colorectal cancer (CRC) at the highest rates of any racial/ethnic group in the U.S. for more than 25 years, and CRC is estimated to become the leading cause of cancer-related deaths for those ages 20-49 by 2030.

I founded the Colorectal Cancer Equity Foundation in March 2021 to remove obstacles to CRC equity among these underrepresented populations.

How does your prior research and leadership experience lend itself to the work ahead of us to address persisting challenges in Milwaukee and Wisconsin?

For more than 18 years, I have been a productive contributor to health disparities-focused inquiry through peer-reviewed publications, community dialogue, National Public Radio interviews, and TV appearances, among several other efforts.

These opportunities have permitted me to study, partner with, and/or be a vociferous advocate for various underserved and socially vulnerable groups including communitydwelling older adult, African American, homeless, Somali, adolescent and young adult, Hispanic, rural, Indigenous, and sexual minority populations.

Considering my leadership and expertise, married to the proficiencies of the other rock stars that Cancer Center Director Dr. Gustavo Leone has brought to the governance table, I am confident our efforts to tackle tenacious challenges in Milwaukee/Wisconsin will be monumental – simply because Together, Everyone Achieves More.

Anything we should know about you personally? My wife, Dr. Tiana N. Rogers, is my secret weapon who helps me remain grounded, holistically healthy, and focused on eradicating health and cancer disparities in this lifetime. I'm a sneakerhead, foodie, hodophile, and ice cream connoisseur whose socks always match my tie.

Notice of Spring Primary and Special Aldermanic Primary and Sample Ballot February 21, 2023

OFFICE OF THE MILWAUKEE COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION

TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE:

Notice is hereby given of a spring primary and special aldermanic primary election to be held in the City of Milwaukee on February 21, 2023, at which the officers named below shall be nominated. The names of the candidates for each office, whose nominations have been certified to or filed in this office, are given under the title of the office, each in its proper column, in the sample ballot below.

Information to Voters

Upon entering the polling place and before being permitted to vote, a voter shall:

- · state their name and address
- show an acceptable form of photo identification*
- sign the poll book**

*If a voter does not have acceptable photo identification, the voter may obtain a free photo ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.

**If the voter is unable to sign the poll book due to disability, a poll worker may write the word "exempt."

If a voter is not registered to vote, they may register to vote at the polling place serving their residence if the voter provides proof of residence.

Where ballots are distributed to voters, the initials of two inspectors must appear on the ballot.

Upon being permitted to vote, the voter shall enter a voting booth or go to a machine and cast their ballot. The vote should not be cast in any manner other than specified here. Sample ballots or other materials to assist the voter in marking their ballot may be taken into the booth and copied. The sample ballot shall not be shown to anyone so as to reveal how the ballot is marked.

A voter who is a parent or guardian may be accompanied by the voter's minor child or minor ward.

An election official may inform the voter of the proper manner for casting a vote but the official may not advise or indicate a particular voting choice.

Assistance for Voting

A voter may select an individual to assist in casting their vote if the voter declares to the presiding official that they are unable to read, have difficulty reading, writing, or understanding English, or that due to disability are unable to cast their ballot. The selected individual rendering assistance may not be the voter's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of a labor organization which represents the voter.

Where Optical Scan Voting is Used

The voter shall fill in the oval next to the name of the candidate of their choice for each office for which he or she intends to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall write in the name of the person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote and fill in the oval next to the write-in line.

When using an *electronic ballot marking device ("ExpressVote")* to mark an **optical scan ballot**, the voter shall touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select the name

of the candidate of his or her choice for each office for which he or she intends to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall type in the name of the person of his or her choice in the space provided for a write-in vote.

After Voting the Ballot

After an official **optical scan ballot** is marked, it may be inserted in the security sleeve, so the marks do not show. The voter shall insert the ballot in the voting device and discard the sleeve or deliver the ballot to an inspector for deposit. The voter shall leave the polling place promptly.

Spoiling Ballots

If a voter spoils an **optical scan** ballot, they shall return it to an election official who shall issue another ballot in its place, but not more than three ballots shall be issued to any one voter. If the ballot has not been initialed by two inspectors or is defective in any other way, the voter shall return it to the election official, who shall issue a proper ballot in its place.

The following is a sample of the official ballot:

Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 24, 316 and portions of wards 8, 23 and 25 will have the same contests as shown on the sample ballot included with this notice.

Wards 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 57, 58, 59, 60 and portions of wards 23, 45, and 56 will have the following special aldermanic contest on their ballot rather than the contest shown on the sample ballot:





The reason you may feel like you're earning less for longer hours compared to your parents is because it's likely the case.

Average hourly wages, adjusted for inflation, have declined since the 1970s, while the average number of hours worked has increased.

As a result, American workers are facing underpayment, overwork, and stress. One of the reasons for this is the decrease in overtime pay.

A new study by Bisnar Chase has revealed that the average Wisconsin employee in the private sector worked approximately 2.4 hours of unpaid overtime per week over 2022 (the national

average was 2.1 hours of unpaid overtime). When this figure is applied to the number of exempt workers in The Badger State (and based on the median wage), and then annualized, it transpires that Wisconsin workers are collectively owed \$4,081,777,113 in

backpay.

Overtime pay may not be a familiar term to many younger generations, but in the past, it was a staple for middle-class workers. Nowadays, a significant portion of employees work over 40 hours a week without receiving any overtime compensation. Despite laws that protect the right to overtime pay, those earning above \$35k per year are often misclassified into exempt positions that do not qualify for overtime. This creates a large pool of free labor for employers to exploit, leading to increased profits, declining real wages, and a widening income

When broken down by state, it is Marylanders who are working the most for free. The average worker in The Old Line state estimates that they worked 3.5 hours in unpaid overtime per week in 2022. This means they are collectively owed \$4.4 billion by their employers. In contrast, workers in South Dakota 'only worked' 0.3 hours in overtime, resulting in a collective overtime debt of \$79 million.
