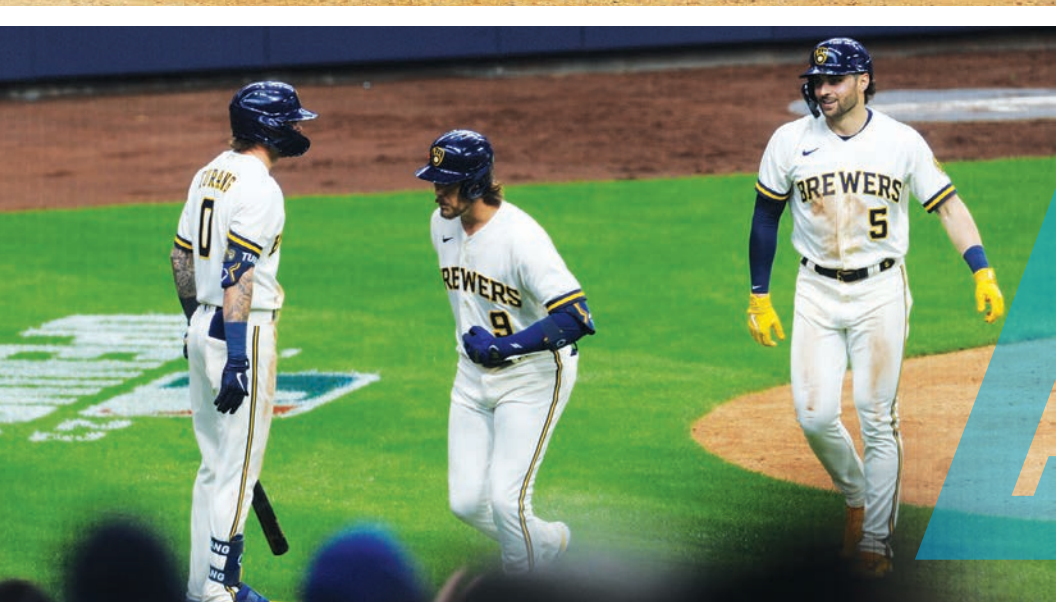

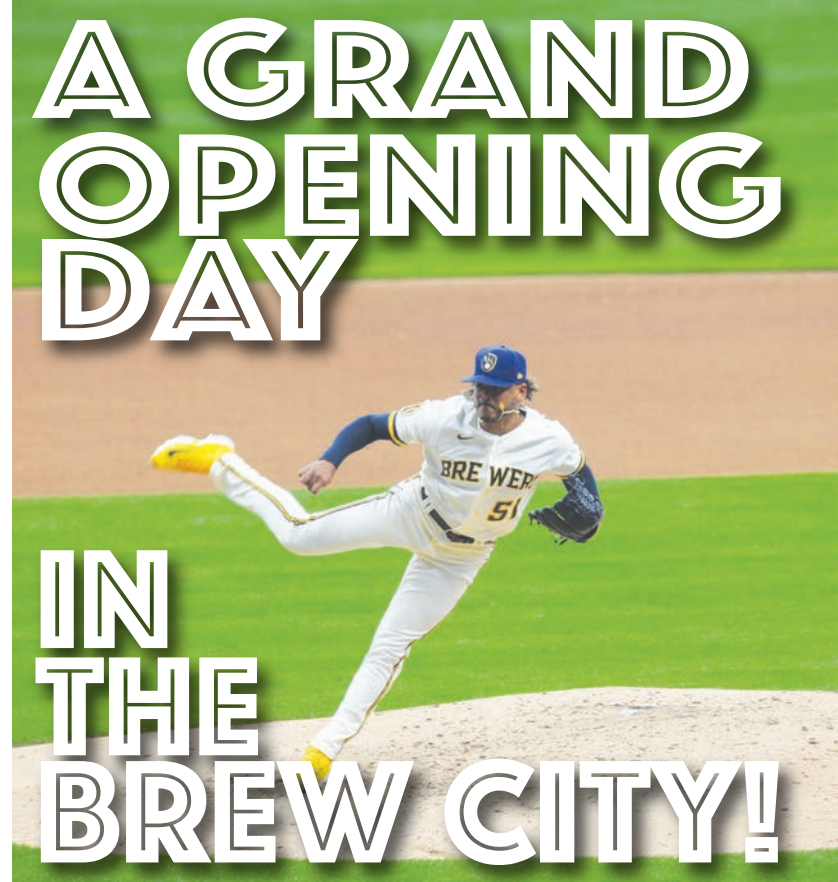

# HAPPY EASTER! HE IS RISEN!

Many of us wear the cross. It is a popular piece of jewelry for young and old. The cross has so many meanings. Catholics make the sign of the cross at the end of prayers as a symbol of Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. ..the Trinity.

Others wear the cross as a symbol of being Christian, a believer in Christ as Savior, Redeemer of the world. And artist often wear the cross as a sign of blessed by the best...in gold..it infers " I've made it and I thank God."

In the time of Jesus, the cross was a symbol of death, death on a cross made of wood; and typically placed in locations where many could witness an excruciating death. The death was often for heinous crimes of thievery, killing someone, betraying a brother or neighbors' wife.

In Jesus' case, he had done none of the acts that usually led to death on a cross! He was betrayed by his own disciple, Judas Iscariot, who had been paid to turn him over to the Romans because Roman Governor Pontus Pilate was jealous of the attention and devotion Jesus was being shown by new followers, of this man from Galilee.

In truth, all of the events had been described in the Book of Isaiah years before. The fulfillment of the prophecies that preceded Jesus' birth were being fulfilled according to the writings of Matthew, Mark, and John, divinely inspired and scrolled for posterity, as described before the birth of Christ.

Every denomination observes Easter differently. Jewish families began with the Passover on Wednesday night at sundown. It is tradition that Jewish families teach their young and reen-

force through the elders the night that the first born son and the first male sheep or goat were killed and only those who had taken it's blood and spread over the lentil of the door of the homes would be protected from the wrath of death. With roasted sheep or goat, Jewish families tell of their journey from slavery and the passover of death, honoring the mandate to protect the home and their families by teaching obedience and adherence to the Jewish law.

Tuesday night, Jehovah's Witnesses held their Memorial where they honor Christ as Jesus Lord, sent by Jehovah God to free us of our sins. In temples and via Zoom, they flocked to honor the Christ and His death on Calvary's cross for our sins.

In Protestant churches, over the past seven weeks, various pastors have given sermons about the last Seven words spoken by Jesus. And , various congregations have hosted luncheons and services to prepare worshippers to be informed and ready for the solemnity of the Cross Jesus had to bear.

Holy Week for Catholics begins tonight with the Maundy Thursday, The Lord's Supper. Jesus told his disciples to go to the house and ask if the Master can eat with His disciples in the Upper Room. The feast was prepared as it had been written and Jesus forewarned He would be gone soon. At the meal, He said "

This is my body, given up for you. Do this in remembrance of me. He followed with the chalice and said “ this is my blood, given up for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”.

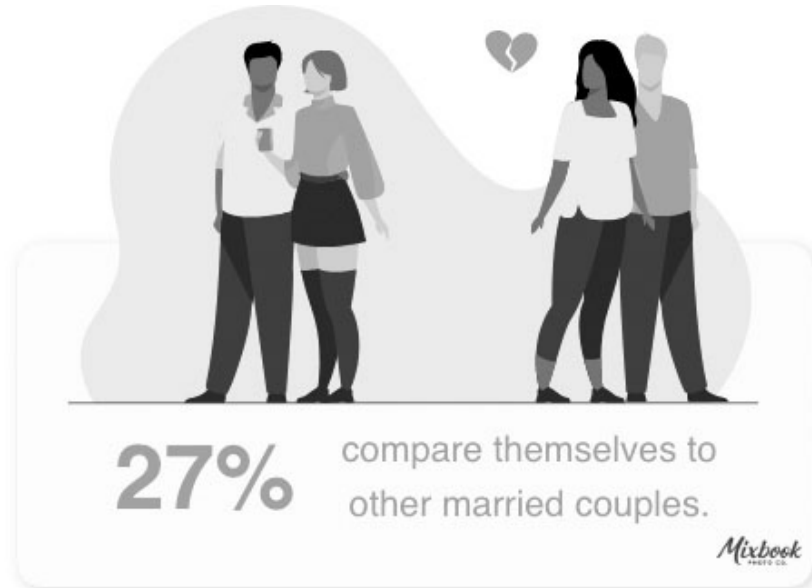

**Study reveals 1.7 million married Wisconsin couples are blissfully happy!**

Movies and fairytales tend to teach us that once those wedding bells have run, it's happily ever after for the couple.

However, it turns out that it's not just a fantasy - according to a survey commissioned by Mixbook and carried out by QuestionPro, 88% of married couples in Minnesota reported being blissfully happy in their relationships.

The photo books company studied Census data to identify the number of married people in each state, and then surveyed

3,000 married people, asking them how many were actually happy in their relationships.

This enabled them to provide an absolute number of happily married people in each state.

And it was found that 1,722,244 Wisconsinites (76% of married couples here), said they are indeed happily married!

And the best chance you have of a successful marriage, when the results were broken down by state, is in West Virginia - 90% of married couples here, or around 635,000 people, are still head over heels in love with their partner.

Things aren't as cheerful in North Dakota or Montana, where only 1 in 3 (142k in Montana, and 97k in North Dakota) said they are happily married.

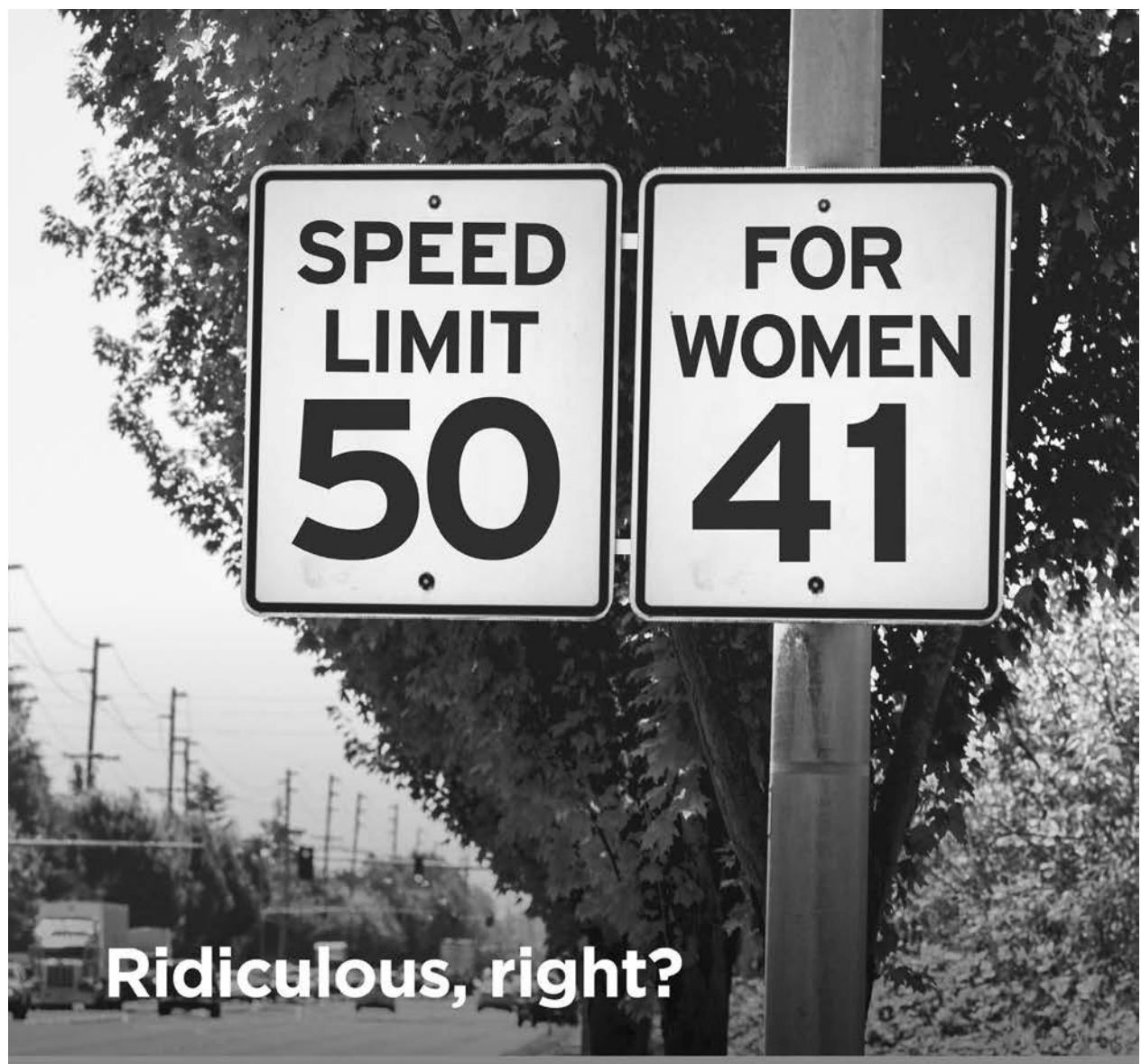

# MCTS BUS SERVICE IS AT RISK OF FACING MAJOR CUTS



## To Everyone Living and Working in Milwaukee County:

Great cities rely on great public transit. If you live or work in one of the 19 municipalities that make up Milwaukee County, I hope you'll help us save transit.

The Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) is facing a crisis whose ripple effects would touch the entire community. MCTS is confronting a projected \$26.5 million budget shortfall in 2025 after relief funds provided during the COVID-19 pandemic run out. Despite our ongoing efforts to control costs (*which have us ranked second among our peer systems in cost-per-vehicle and third in cost-per-passenger*) we are hurtling toward a fiscal cliff.

**Without a sustainable funding solution, MCTS bus service will shrink by more than 20 percent which represents nearly one half of all routes in the system.**

Failing to invest in transit will have cascading, cross-sectoral ramifications for all of us—setting back the regional economy, exacerbating labor shortages, and impacting education and health outcomes. And the harm done by such drastic reductions would fall on those least able to absorb additional burdens.

Most large cities invest in their transit systems with sustainable funding, like a local sales tax, that is indexed to grow year over year. MCTS receives local funding through a combination of property taxes and a vehicle registration fee—both of which don't match the scale of the gap we face. Without a reliable source of local funding, the proposed transit funding cuts would cripple Milwaukee County. We need allies like you to help position MCTS for growth.
