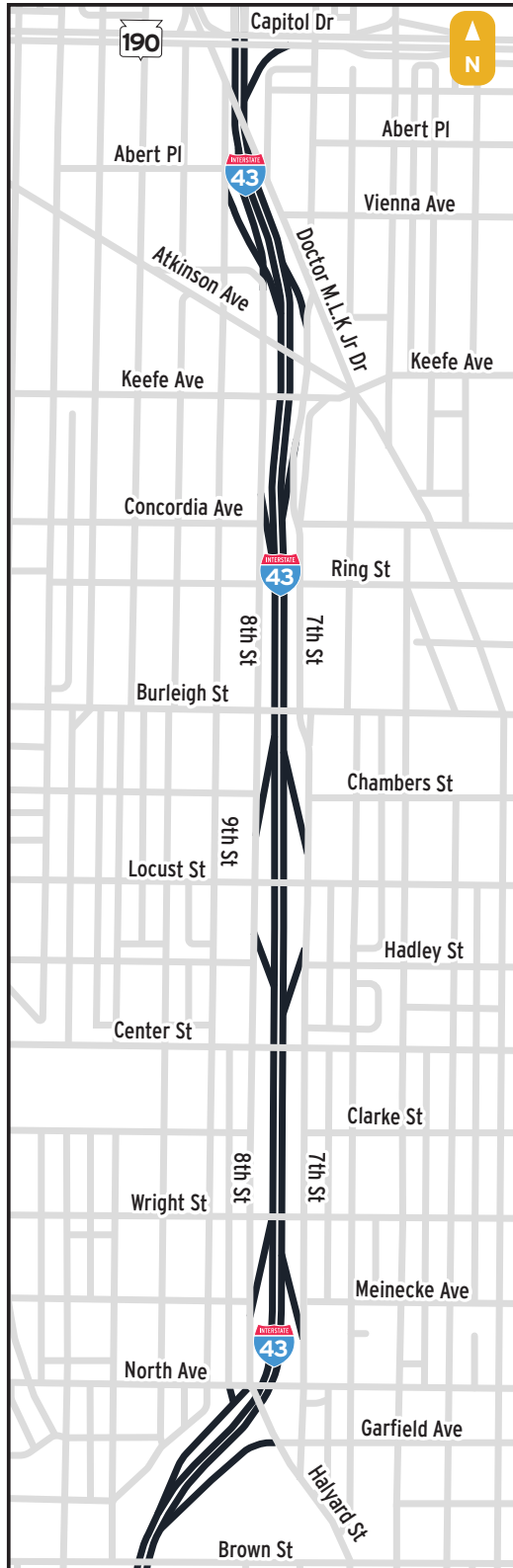


The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is scheduled to begin rehabilitation of I-43 between Brown Street and Capitol Drive, in Milwaukee County, in spring 2023, with scheduled completion in late 2024.



## PROJECT OVERVIEW

Pavement repair and rehabilitation of lanes, shoulders, and connecting ramps to I-43 between Brown Street and Capitol Drive. All roadway improvements will stay within the existing freeway right of way.

## WORK TO BE COMPLETED

Rehabilitation of the following bridges along the corridor:

- Brown Street
- Wright Street
- Locust Street
- Burleigh Street

This project also includes:

- Median reconstruction and drainage improvements along the project
- Lighting, signal, and ramp improvements
- Construction of auxiliary lanes between interchange entrance and exit ramps
- Intersection improvements at 7th & 8th streets and Burleigh Street; and 7th & 8th streets and Locust Street

## WHAT TO EXPECT IN 2023

- Overnight lane and ramp closures
- Long-term lane and ramp closures
- Long-term local street closures are scheduled to take place during bridge work
