

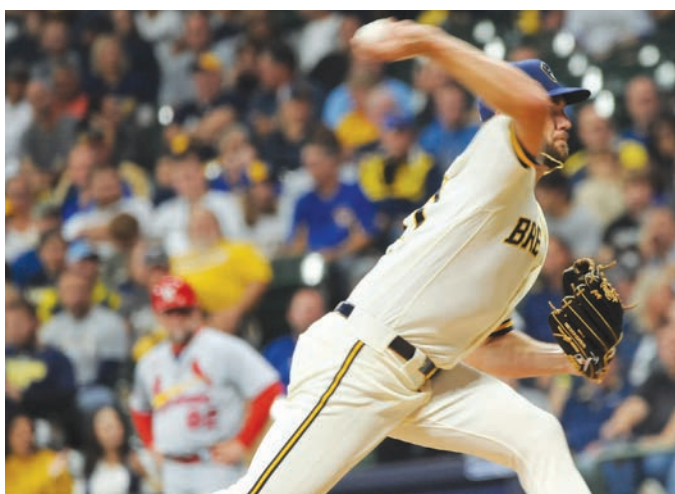

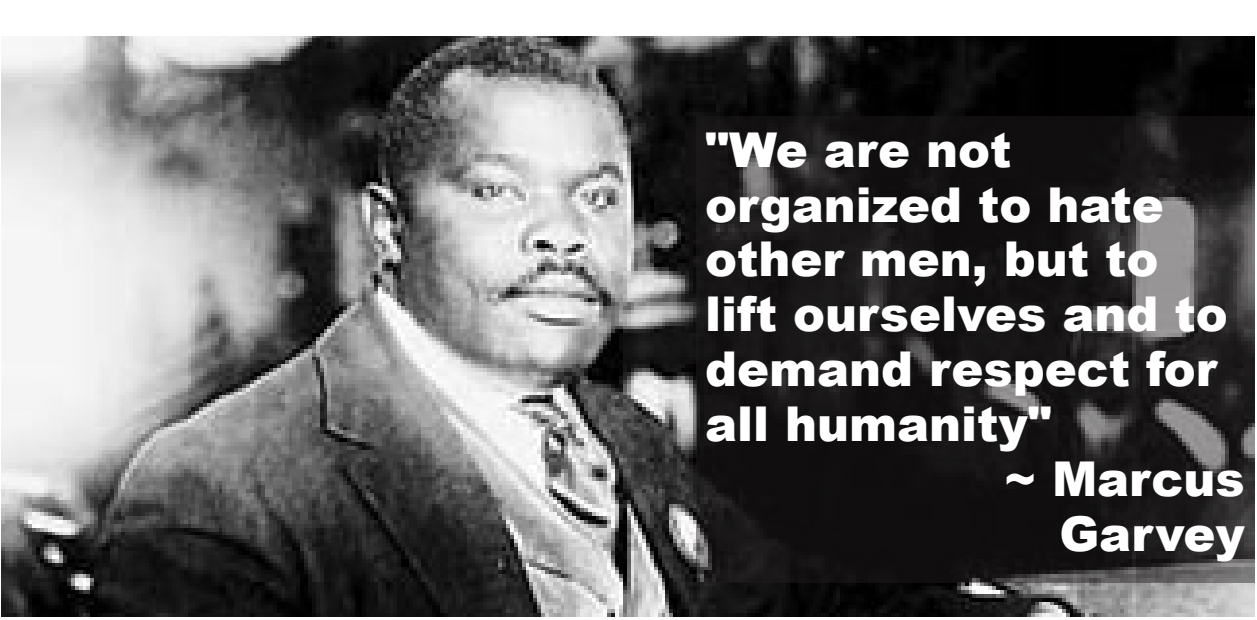

# 30th Street Industrial Corridor Corp to hold tour of newly rehabilitated historic homes!

On Saturday, October 14, 2023 the 30th Street Industrial Corridor Corp (30IC) invites you to celebrate with us, as we host a tour of newly rehabilitated historic homes in the Garden Homes neighborhood.

The event will take place in Garden Homes Park, 2600 W. Atkinson Avenue, from 10:30am-Noon.

The Garden Homes neighborhood was built from 1921-1923 by Mayor Daniel Hoan.

It was America’s first municipally sponsored public housing cooperative.

The 93 original homes were added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1990, and the Wisconsin Historic register in 2013.

Beginning during the foreclosure crisis of 2008, nearly 20 of these homes were abandoned, 11 of which were acquired by the City of Milwaukee.

These homes were left standing in grave disrepair for over a dozen years, as historic restoration requirements further complicated a market challenged with low property values.

Garden Homes has always been an asset rich community.

However, while doing great work, many community stakeholders did not work collaboratively.

Under the leadership of Executive Director Cheryl Blue, on September 10, 2016, 30IC hosted a meeting to bring neighborhood partners together.

The purpose was to forge deeper relationships and to plan for a brighter future.

It was the first time that the Pastors of New Hope Baptist, Garden Homes Lutheran, Crossing Jordan, Alpha & Omega, and All Saints Catholic Churches, residents, the Garden Homes Neighborhood Association, Coalition for Hope, Uniting Garden Homes, Clean Wisconsin, NWSCDC, and others were all in a room together!

That meeting kicked off a

process, facilitated by Garden Homes native and 30IC Board Vice President, Pastor Chris

For the entire year of 2017, over 200 residents and representatives from 50 entities (businesses, CBOs, MPD, elected officials, etc.) engaged in a process to create a neighborhood plan.

On December 12, 2017 at Dr. Howard Fuller Academy, the Garden Homes Neighborhood Plan was ratified and released.

One area of focus for the Plan is housing. In 2019, working with then Alderman Ashanti Hamilton, 30IC was able to acquire 11 historic homes, and 19 additional city owned properties, in order to submit an application to WHEDA for low income tax credits.

In 2020 the tax credits we were awarded. However, due to complications of the C-19 pandemic, the housing deal nearly died.

However, with great patience and tenacity, BID #37

Board Chairman Ted Matkom (Gorman), and our partners at Cinnaire Solutions

were able to save the deal, which finally closed during the summer of 2022.

Partners in this deal include WHEDA, City of Milwaukee,

Cinnaire Solutions, IFF, and the Federal Home Loan Bank. Special thanks to 30IC board members Willie Smith (NWSCDC), Maria Watts and Que El-Amin; and Department of City Development team members Amy Turim

and Maria Prioletta.

After seven long years of hard work and dedication, these homes will all be completed by the end of 2023.
