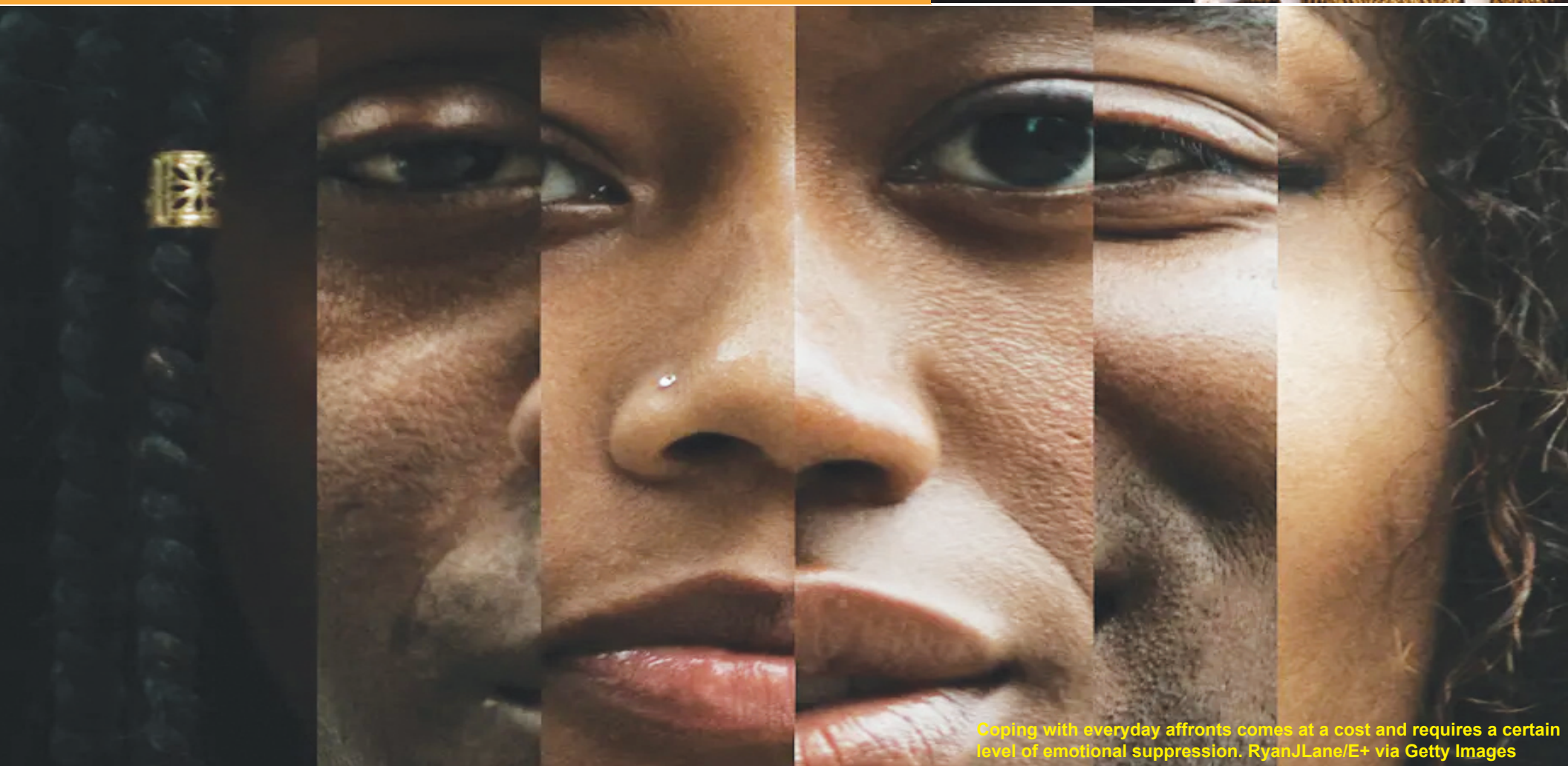

Racism produces subtle brain changes that lead to increased disease risk in Black populations

The U.S. is in the midst of a racial reckoning. The COVID-19 pandemic, which took a particularly heavy toll on Black communities, turned a harsh spotlight on long-standing health disparities that the public could no longer overlook.

Although the health disparities for Black communities have been well known to researchers for decades, the pandemic put real names and faces to these numbers.

Compared with white people, Black people are at much greater risk for developing a range of health problems, including heart disease, diabetes and dementia.

For example, Black people are twice as likely as white people to develop Alzheimer's disease.

A vast and growing body of research shows that racism contributes to systems that promote health inequities.

Most recently, our team has also learned that racism directly contributes to these inequities on a neurobiological level.

We are clinical neuroscientists who study the multifaceted ways in which racism affects how our brains develop and function.

We use brain imaging to study how trauma such as sexual assault or racial discrimination can cause stress that leads to mental health

disorders like depression and post-traumatic stress disorder, or PTSD.

We have studied trauma in the context of a study known as the Grady Trauma Project, which has been running for nearly 20 years. This study is largely focused on the trauma and stress of Black people in the metropolitan Atlanta, Georgia, community.

How discrimination alters the brain

Racial discrimination is commonly experi-

enced through subtle indignities: a woman clutching her purse as a Black man walks by on the sidewalk, a shopkeeper keeping close watch on a Black woman shopping in a clothing store, a comment about a Black employee being a “diversity hire.”

These slights are often referred to as micro-aggressions.

Decades of research has shown that the everyday burden of these race-related threats, slights and exclusions in day-to-day life translates into a real increase in disease risk.

But researchers are only beginning to understand how these forms of discrimination affect a person’s biology and overall health.

Our team’s research shows that the everyday burden of racism affects the function and structure of the brain. In turn, these changes play a major role in risk for health problems.

For instance, our studies show that racial discrimination increases the activity of brain regions, such as the prefrontal cortex, that are involved in regulating emotions.

This increased activity in prefrontal brain regions occurs because responding to these types of affronts requires high-effort coping strategies, such as suppressing emotions.

People who have experienced more racial discrimination also show more activation in brain

regions that enable them to inhibit and suppress anger, shock or sadness so that they can curate a socially acceptable response.

A cost for overcompensating

Despite the fact that high-energy coping allows people to manage a constant barrage of threats, this comes at a cost.

The more brain energy you use to suppress, control or manage your feelings, the more energy you take away from the rest of the body.

Over time, and without prolonged periods of rest, relief and restoration, this can contribute to other problems, a process that public health researcher Arline Geronimus termed "weathering."

Having these brain regions in continual overdrive is linked with accelerated biological aging, which can create vulnerability for health problems and early death.

In our research, we have found that this weathering process is evident in the gradual degradation of brain structure, particularly in the heavily myelinated axons of the brain, known as "white matter," which serve as the brain's information highways.

Myelin is a protective sheath around nerve fibers that allows for improved communication between brain cells. Similar to highways for vehicles, without sufficient maintenance of the myelin, degradation will occur.

Erosion in these brain pathways can affect self-regulation, making a person more vulnerable to developing unhealthy coping strategies

for stress, such as emotional eating or substance use. These behaviors, in turn, can increase one's risk for a wide variety of health problems.

These racism-related changes in the brain, and their direct effects on coping, may help to explain why Black people are twice as likely to develop brain health problems such as Alzheimer's disease compared with white

people.

Recognizing racial gaslighting

In our view, what makes racism particularly insidious and pernicious to the health of Black people is the societal invalidation that accompanies it. This makes racial trauma effectively invisible. Racism, whether it originates from people or from institutional systems, is often rationalized, excused or dismissed.

Such invalidation leads those who experience

racism to second-guess themselves: "Am I just being too sensitive?" People who have the temerity to report racist events are often ridiculed or met with skepticism. This extends to academic spheres as well.

This continual questioning and doubting of the circumstances around racist experiences, or racial gaslighting, may be part of what depletes the brain of its resources, causing the weathering that ultimately increases vulnerability to brain health problems.

Interrupting this cycle requires that people learn to identify their biases toward people of color and people in marginalized groups more generally, and to understand how those biases may lead to discriminatory words and behavior.

We believe that by finding their blind spots, people can see ways in which their actions and behaviors could be viewed as hurtful, exclusionary or offensive. Through recognition of these experiences as racist, people can become allies rather than skeptics.

Institutions can help to create a culture of healing, validation and support for people of color. A validating, supportive institutional culture may help people of color normalize their reactions to these stressors, in addition to the connection – and restoration – they may find within their communities.

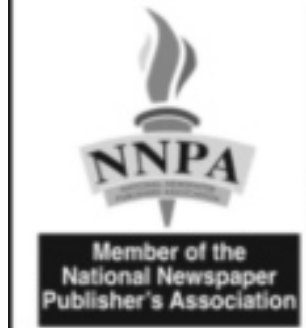

LOUISIANA SLAVE PLANTATION AND HOME OF THE 1811 REVOLT NOW OWNED BY TWO BLACK WOMEN

For the first time in history, two Black women are owners of the land where their ancestors were once enslaved.

Co-founders of the Descendants Project, Dr. Joy Banner and her sister Jo Banner (pictured above), are now the proud owners of the Woodland Plantation in LaPlace, Louisiana – the first time the plantation has been under Black ownership in 231 years.

While other grounds have been renovated to host events such as weddings, the nonprofit feels the historic land can be preserved for better use.

In February 2024, the Banners announced that they plan on using the property for educational purposes, including archeology, museum studies, heritage, and tourism. “This is an extremely important historic site to this legacy of resistance,” Joy said.

“We believe that preservation of these sites are more important than ever because of the attacks on Black history in our education system in particular. Sites like these will have to be the ones telling these

stories.”
The land itself has an incredible story to tell. Woodland is the place where slaves escaped a LaPlace plantation and marched along the Mississippi River toward New Orleans in the 1811 Revolt, also known as the largest slave revolt

in American history. Jo says the nonprofit plans to use Woodland to tell the story of the revolt “in a way that hasn’t been told.”
“We want to tell the full story, the true story, and

who better to tell this story than the descendants of the people who were enslaved at the plantation.

The goal is to tell the story in an honorable way that doesn’t retraumatize Black visitors and makes them feel safe.”

Working to eliminate the repercussions of slavery that still exist, the group’s mission has moved from protecting the burial grounds of the enslaved to opposing river parish industrialization projects like the Wallace grain elevator. The preservation of Woodland is a great addition to those efforts.

“Throughout St. John the Baptist Parish, important sites like this one were in danger of being

erased,” Joy said.

The Banner sisters want the land to be a genealogical resource for “Black people to have access to their history.”

On top of working with descendants of enslaved people from the plantation, the site is expected to feature an exhibit dedicated to jazz trombonist Edward “Kid” Ory.

Ory was born on the plantation grounds and was the inspiration behind the recent use of a dual-purpose museum highlighting the 1811 uprising and his life.


The Banner sisters hope to open the grounds by the summer of 2024, as ticket prices and other details are still being worked out.

Trailblazing ballerina Misty Copeland continues to be a voice for Black and brown ballerinas. The professional dancer recently got candid about being the sole Black dancer gracing studio spaces and stages throughout her career.

During a March 21 episode of Who's Talking to Chris Wallace?

Copeland, who spent the first decade of her professional career as the only Black woman with the American Ballet Theatre, said, "There were times that I was not cast in certain roles because I would stand out too much and kind of ruin the aesthetic, especially if it was a performance that was being filmed."

She specifically recalled how she stood out among the other dancers, especially when everyone was pretty much wearing pink-toned tights.

Her groundbreaking portrayal as American Ballet Theatre's first Black "Odette/Odile" in Swan Lake carried immense weight after she landed the lead role in 2014.

"I think about this kind of generational trauma for Black dancers that comes with that role," Copeland said.

Being cast in that role accumulated mixed opinions as the swans were typically white for many decades and "not a role that can be played by a Black or brown woman."

The ballerina shared that she worried about the appeal of her "artistic excellence" and how it could affect the role ever being given to another Black dancer at the company.

"That was something that weighed on me leading up to that first performance," she admitted.

Copeland, who has also been referred to as the "Jackie Robinson of ballet," feels she has brought herself to roles like in Swan Lake and made them her own.

However, her fame in the industry was still met with pressures. "They make you lighten your skin," she said.

"I had serious conversations with the artistic

staff of ABT and our hair and makeup department."

Those conversations questioned why the common "matte" look had to equate to "white."

The notable dancer has established several initiatives to evolve the conversation and move the ballet world forward in its diversity efforts.

In 2023, Copeland launched her "MakeA-Pointe" petition in an effort

to encourage Apple and the Unicode Consortium to expand its skin tone options for the pointe shoe emoji.

The campaign aimed to ensure the art of ballet celebrated every dancer's "story and shade." She

also founded her "Be Bold" initiative in 2022 for Black and Latino students hosted at the Boys and Girls Clubs in New York City, an after-school dance program that provides ballet and music training, health education,

tutoring, and mentorship.

She recognized that progress goes beyond being "the first" and acknowledged that other Black women have also accomplished incredible things in the industry.
