# Why is it so hard to say sorry as an adult?

**Editor's note:** The following article is an op-ed, and the views expressed are the author's own.

I live in a house with several children, which means that over the course of any day, there might be cries, yells, accusations, fights, etc. What that also means is that the words, "I'm sorry" are uttered frequently.

We've taught our kids (as most parents have I'd imagine) that saying "I'm sorry" is usually the solution for doing something wrong, and if you are the wronged party, being told "I'm sorry" should end the situation.

We also try to explain to them, so that they may understand for future interactions, why they did wrong and why it is important to apologize and mean it.

As it turns out (at least in my experience), for most kids, an apology really is the end all be all of non-physical (and sometimes even physical) clashes. Something goes awry, an apology happens and then they all get back to the activity at hand. All parties understand the assignment.

In fact, "I'm sorry" on one end often comes with an "It's OK" on the other. Can it be that it was all so simple then?

Kids might not always mean it, but they know it's what you have to do and thus they do it because it becomes a habit.

Plus, it ensures the parents don't get involved or only get involved minimally and everybody gets to go about their day. It's



about ... peace.

To be clear, I'm including myself in this mix, as well. While I always try to do

better, I've definitely felt myself struggling at times to apologize when I know I've done something wrong. I don't know if it's because I'm worried about leverage or concerned that I'll look weak or maybe it's because I feel like an apology won't be ac-

cepted.

Or maybe because I want to mean it when I do apologize and that's not always where my heart is.

Just as often as I've had those feelings, I've witnessed it from other people. I've had somebody straight up tell me they

weren't going to apologize for doing me harm because they meant what they said.

The concern about the other side of the equation has gone entirely out the window. In interpersonal relationships especially, I've watched friendships tank because one side could not, or would not, acknowledge and then apologize for doing a thing that put the relationship at risk.

Romantic relationships definitely struggle with this. I've asked several people how often they either sincerely apologize to their spouse or vice versa, and more often than not, the apologies were so infrequent that they were able to remember specific instances. It shouldn't be so foreign to get an apology as an adult that you can actually remember when it happened, but I do think many of us find ourselves in that space.

Then again, most of us, as adults, find ourselves in a very defensive situation when told we're wrong.

We need to figure out why you think we're wrong before we can even acknowledge it just in case we're not wrong for why you think we're wrong. Grownups are wild.

Shoot, as a parent, I've found myself having to apologize to my kids for overreacting to things; I want them to know that my reaction wasn't about them and therefore I'm sorry and I won't do that again.

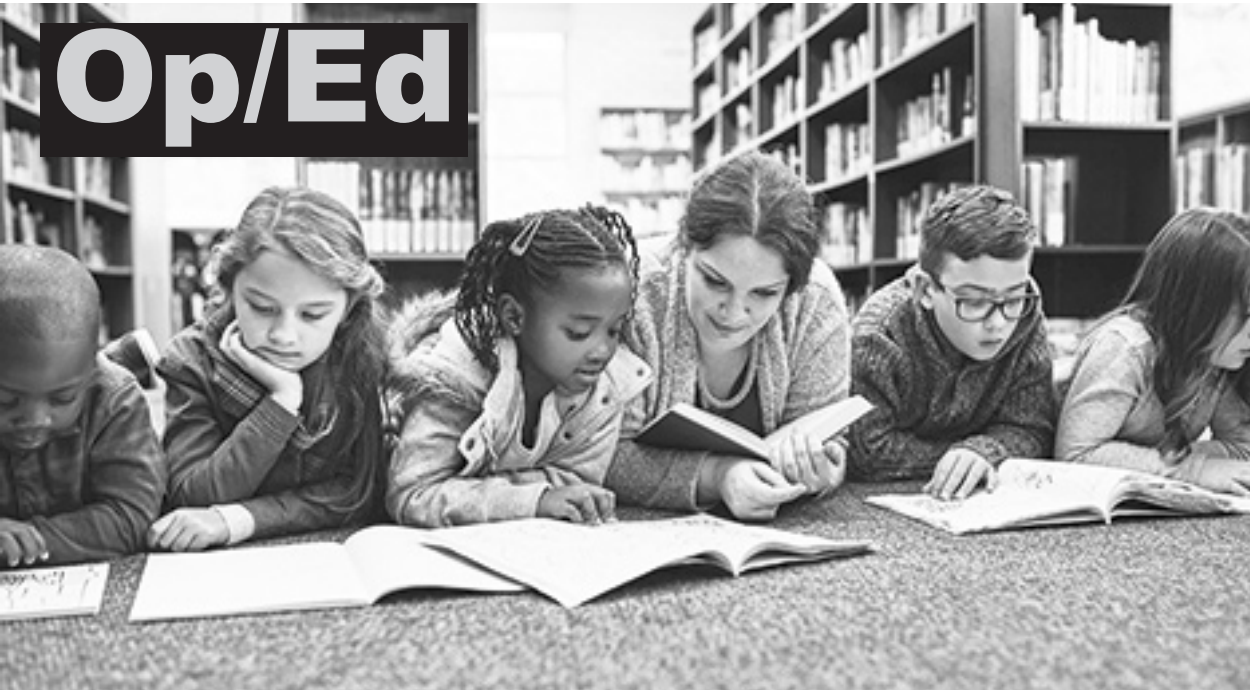
That should be easy — to apologize to a person you love more than life itself — but it always requires me to humble myself and then ask for forgiveness, which is hard to do, even when facing an 8- or 9-year-old.

And that's crazy to me.

## HEALTH GROUPS FILE SECOND LAWSUIT AGAINST THE US FDA

*While the Biden Administration Delays the Rule on Menthol, Death Toll Rises Daily*

WASHINGTON, DC – The African American Tobacco Control Leadership Council (AATCLC), Action on Smoking and Health (ASH), and the National Medical Association (NMA), represented by Christopher Leung of Leung Law PLLC, have filed a second lawsuit against the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for the agency’s inaction on issuing a final rule banning menthol cigarettes.

This lawsuit comes more than seven months after the FDA’s initial date for finalizing the new rule and follows the FDA’s 15-year delay in equitable policy-making.

“The relentless and racist tobacco industry targeting has killed too many members of the Black community,” said Carol McGruder, Co-Chair of the African American Tobacco Control Leadership Council.

“If Black lives truly matter, then we must end the sale of menthol cigarettes and do it now!”

The Plaintiffs’ first lawsuit was filed on June 17, 2020. Since then, approximately 39,789 Americans have died from menthol cigarettes.

The initial complaint sought to compel the FDA to act on its earlier conclusions that removing menthol cigarettes from the marketplace would benefit public health.

The lawsuit specifically asked the Court to compel the FDA’s determination on whether to add menthol to the list of prohibited characterizing flavors – a determination that the FDA delayed making for over 10 years.

The joint lawsuit followed the 2013 Citizen Petition from the Public Health Law Center which called on the FDA to prohibit the sale of

menthol cigarettes.

“We’re extremely disappointed to be forced to file this second lawsuit against the FDA in support of protecting Americans from menthol cigarettes,” said Laurent Huber, Executive Director of Action on Smoking and Health.

“The FDA’s own research confirms that a menthol ban would save lives; there is no scientific reason to delay finalizing this rule.”

In 2011, the FDA’s own scientific advisory committee concluded that the “Removal of menthol cigarettes from the marketplace would benefit public health in the United States.”

As a result of the Plaintiffs’ first lawsuit, the FDA made the landmark determination to add menthol to the list of banned characterizing flavors in cigarettes.

To begin that rulemaking process, the FDA issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to ban the sale of menthol cigarettes in the marketplace.

Given that success, the Plaintiffs voluntarily dismissed their initial lawsuit.

Today, three years later, the FDA has failed to take the final step to formally promulgate and publish the proposed rule.

After setting an initial date of August 2023 to issue this rule, the FDA has unreasonably and unlawfully delayed this life-saving rule.

“As African American physicians, we are deeply disturbed at the continuing delays in FDA’s finalizing of the ban on menthol cigarettes,” said Dr. Yolanda Lawson, President of the National Medical Association.

“Our patients, more than any other group, become disabled and die prematurely due to the continued

use of these cigarettes,” she said.

The Biden Administration has fallen for disinformation and fearmongering by the tobacco industry.

The industry is sowing doubt and confusion and taking advantage of real issues in our country and claiming that removing menthol will harm Black lives, when just the opposite is true.

We remain disheartened

to be forced to call on the Biden Administration to prioritize human life.

Attorney Christopher Leung stated, “FDA’s delay in issuing a final rule is harming public health.

As the FDA’s own analysis found, banning menthol cigarettes will reduce youth smoking, increase successful quit-attempts among current people who smoke, and save hundreds of thousands of lives – as

well as billions of dollars spent on treating smoking-related harms. It’s time for the FDA to act.”

Tobacco products kill when used as intended. Menthol cigarettes make initiation easier, addiction stronger, and quitting harder.

A ban on menthol cigarettes would save 6,000 Black lives every year.

**(continued from cover)** adult feel bigger and you can't just move on.

If you know you did wrong and thus must apologize, you also have to do better going forward and perhaps some of us aren't ready to do better.

Doing the work of being a better human isn't something we require from children; we want them to learn from their mistakes, but kids' mistakes usually have lower stakes.

Truth be told, I've seen grown-ups fail to apologize for even low-stakes mishaps. It's quite fascinating.

I'm sure there's some psychological component here that involves the development of the ego and all that comes with pride and self-interest, but I also wonder when kids who grow up just stop apologizing when so many have spent so much time learning how to use their words to atone for a mistake.

"Say sorry!" is such a part of a child's life that you'd think it would be a natural part of adulthood, yet, personal experience has taught me that's not the case.

I've worked hard to acknowledge when I do wrong (I've also worked hard on simply not doing wrong).

Perhaps that's the rub; apologizing as an adult is admitting you did something wrong even though you knew better.

Kids are learning on the go, and very impulsive. Adults are supposed to be better at impulse control. Again, it's all fascinating.

I don't know when this change happened.

Or why. How do we go from learning to apologize for things all of the time, understanding it fixes lots of problems to being hesitant and resistant to apolo-

gize ... knowing and understanding it can help fix (even if it's not THE fix for) a lot of problems?

Mind you, apologies don't really fix all grown-up problems, I know, but when two people are at odds and one person is at fault, an apology is an acknowledgment and can usually help move things in the right direction.
