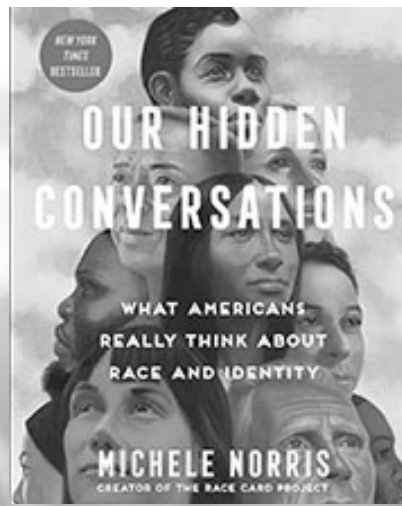

13 BOOKS THAT WILL REMIND YOU OF YOUR POWER THIS JUNETEENTH!

On June 19, 1865, the last enslaved people in the United States obtained their freedom. Now, over 150 years later, oppression continues to threaten Black people in this country.

As institutions like the Supreme Court rule against affirmative action and diversity, equity and inclusion initiatives like the Fearless Fund and the looming threat of Project 2025 increase this election year, it's easy for Black people who have historically been marginalized and overlooked by the sys-

tem to feel powerless, frustrated and, in the worst cases, hopeless.

While Juneteenth's recognition as a federal holiday grants most people a break in the middle of the week this year, it is also a reminder of how resilient Black people have been and continue to be. So in the midst of all the Juneteenth festivities, day parties and cookouts, consider using literature to pregame Freedom Day because as Roxane Gay penned in "Bad Feminist":
