GRAMMY NOMINEE GODWIN LOUIS BRINGS PRAISE WITH PSALMS AND PROVERBS

New album on Blue Room Records will be available worldwide August 23

NEW YORK — Grammy-nominated saxophonist Godwin Louis explores the universality and joy of sacred music in his sophomore release, *Psalms and Proverbs*. The album is being released internationally by Blue Room Music on August 23.

Louis draws on religious musical traditions around the world, including his Haitian roots, Haiti being where European, African and Native traditions converged to create the roots of jazz. The disc includes gospel and liturgical music from West African Ewe and Beninois sources as well as 16th-century French composer Claude Goudimel (for a beautiful sax-trumpet duet), the Scottish-Anglican hymn “Abide with Me,” and compositions he wrote in collaboration with several ministers, including his late father, the Rev. Marcel Louis — *Psalms 23 Part II (I Shall Fear No Evil)*” and “*Psalms 23 Part III (Surely Goodness and Mercy)*”.

Born into a musical family in Harlem of Haitian heritage, Louis was raised in Bridgeport, Connecticut, and Port-au-Prince, Haiti. Maturing on the scene in New Orleans, Boston, New York and beyond, Louis is a composer-arranger-virtuoso soloist who got his start on saxophone at age nine. A Thelonious Monk

Institute of Jazz Saxophone competition finalist, a 2024 Grammy nominee (for arrangements on singer Cécile McLorin Salvant's *Mélusine*), and a Berklee College of Music woodwinds professor, he is a man of devoutly lyrical imagination, as richly demonstrated in *Psalms and Proverbs*.

With a sax sound as robust, focused and fluid as the finest of his reeds (think Cannonball Adderley, Paquito D’Rivera and Donald Harrison), Louis leads an extraordinary ensemble through a program varied by its themes and formats, including spoken word, chants and choral passages; deft instrumental interplay and stirring African American and Afro-Caribbean rhythms. He takes full advantage of post-bop jazz freedoms, also embracing gospel music tropes, son montuno style, bolero and calypso flourishes (for instance on the track “*Collective Bovaryism*”).

As he proved in 2019 with his audacious two-CD debut album *Global*, Louis has a humanist and internationalist perspective, informed by the African diaspora and expressed in his embrace of jazz in its totality — broadly defined — and his service to it as an international ambassador. He’s toured Africa (and is the namesake of a rooftop jazz club in Togo), Europe and China, and also returned to nourish his roots in his Caribbean homeland as founder of the Experience Ayiti, a nonprofit multidisciplinary arts organization offering musical education to and developing leadership skills among Haitian youth.

Core members of Louis’s Global band return for *Psalms and Proverbs*, including brassman Billy Buss, pianist Axel Tosca, organist Johnny Mercier, drummer Obed Calvaire, percussionist Markus Schwartz, bassist Hogyu Hwang and vocalist Melissa Stylianou. Trinidad-born trumpet star Etienne Charles partners with Louis in the front-line on the opening “*Showers of Blessings/Kplolanyuiade*” and “*Pelo Malo*.”

Psalms and Proverbs is also a showcase for vocal-focused tracks featuring the talents of acclaimed world stars. Louis has enlisted both Xiomara Laugart, known as the “Voice of Cuba,” and two-time Grammy Award-nominated artist Lea Lórien. Both appear on “*Pelo Malo (Bad Hair)*,” an uncompromising, at first troubled but ultimately affirming resolution of the complex conversation about hair texture

that has plagued generations of Afro-Latino and other Black communities. Louis introduces Lècokpon, a bright Benin artist, and on several tracks Stylianou, a singer-songwriter with five albums as a leader and member of the vocal trio Duchess, harmonizes with Haitian American songstress Pauline Jean (who steps out dramatically on “*Psalms 6*”).

“Whether in Africa or the Americas, the hymn and the playing of music are central to worship and praise in any number of religious traditions,” said Louis. “This album explores that nexus and carries on the tradition of sacred music and its influence on jazz — the music steeped in the sounds of West Africa, the Caribbean, the United States and Europe — in what I hope are new and exciting ways for audiences.”

Psalms and Proverbs is produced by Louis, Calvaire and Chan Jung.

In the fast-paced world of online dating, honesty can be a scarce commodity. From shaving off a few years to using AI for a digital nip and tuck or even fabricating relationship statuses, singles are running a gauntlet of deception in their quest for true love.

This phenomenon reaches a fever pitch in competitive urban jungles such as New York City and Los Angeles, where the pressure to present oneself as the epitome of perfection can lead to widespread dishonesty.

DatingAdvice.com recently conducted a comprehensive nationwide survey of 3,000 singles to uncover the truth about dating profiles across America.

Their goal was to identify the locations where dating profiles are most and least honest, shedding light on the unique challenges singles encounter in today's digital age, especially as AI tools become increasingly sophisticated.

Respondents were asked to rate, on a scale of 1-10 (with 10 being the paragon of truthfulness), how honest their matches had been about factors including age, job, and real-life appearance.

Wisconsin singles were given a score of 4.2/10, which was below the national average of 5.1.

The survey uncovered significant regional disparities. For example, singles in South Dakota reported the highest levels of honesty with their matches, giving them a commendable 7.5/10.

On the other end of the spectrum is New York, where honesty plum-

meted to a dismal 3.4/10. It seems the city that never sleeps is also the city that rarely tells the whole truth.

DatingAdvice.com dug deeper, asking respondents to pinpoint the areas where they felt most deceived. The results were enlightening, if not a bit disheartening:

Relationship status: 32%
Age: 30%
Real-life appearance: 22%
Interests/hobbies: 6%
Education level: 4%
Location: 4%
Job: 2%

It appears nearly one-third of singles are playing fast and loose with their relationship status. So, the next time someone claims they're "recently single," you might want to

probe deeper.

Almost 1 in 3 singles suspect their matches have used AI to enhance their physical appearance. A whopping 89% are convinced that AI has made the dating scene more dishonest than ever. It's not just about looking good, either.

Some are using AI to craft the perfect bio, proving that even charm can be digitally manufactured.

When it comes to profile pics, singles are surprisingly firm. Fifty-seven percent won't tolerate images older than a year. However, 30% are more lenient, accepting photos taken within the last two years. Only a mere 2% are okay with pictures that are up to five years old.

The survey also revealed a prevailing belief (52%) that big cities are breeding grounds for dishonesty compared to smaller towns. Perhaps urban life's anonymity encourages a more polished, less truthful portrayal.

"While technology has provided new ways for singles to connect, it has also introduced new challenges in discerning truth from deception.

As AI tools continue to evolve, the importance of fostering genuine connections and maintaining honesty in online dating becomes ever more critical.

Singles navigating this landscape must remain vigilant and discerning, presenting their authentic selves while seeking partners who do the same", says Amber Brooks, Chief Editor at DatingAdvice.com.

What is Kamala Harris' race and identity? 'DEI' attacks show what Black women face in politics

It's a criticism we've seen before in politics, steeped in the complexities of identity politics and concerns about lineage in America.

For some, the term "Black"

only equates to African American or a generational Black American, descended from ancestors who survived chattel slavery.

However, "Black" has also been used as a racial and cultural umbrella term, embracing all Black people who live in the United States, including those whose parents immigrated from other countries.

Here are the facts about VP

Kamala Harris and what she's experiencing as she becomes the Democratic party's presumptive presidential nominee: Harris is literally being called a "DEI hire" at the most inconvenient time by Republicans such as Congressman Tim Burchett (R-TN) and Rep. Harriet Hageman (R-WY), who said VP Harris was "intellectually, just really kind of the bottom of the barrel."

No matter the VP's accomplishments as a college and law school graduate, district attor-

ney, attorney general and former senator, suddenly, her extensive accolades mean nothing, and she's only a "DEI" recipient.

Having your intelligence questioned by people with half your resume is an experience many Black people can relate to.

Simply put, these racist and sexist attacks on VP Harris are obviously because she's a Black woman.

In this conversation, only the

facts matter. VP Kamala Harris is the product of a Jamaican father and Indian mother who connected during the civil rights movement and started a family in Oakland, Calif. — she comes from two different ethnicities and cultures.

Through her father, she is a woman of African descent; she looks like many multi-ethnic or multiracial Black women we've celebrated and seen before. In a segregated American past,

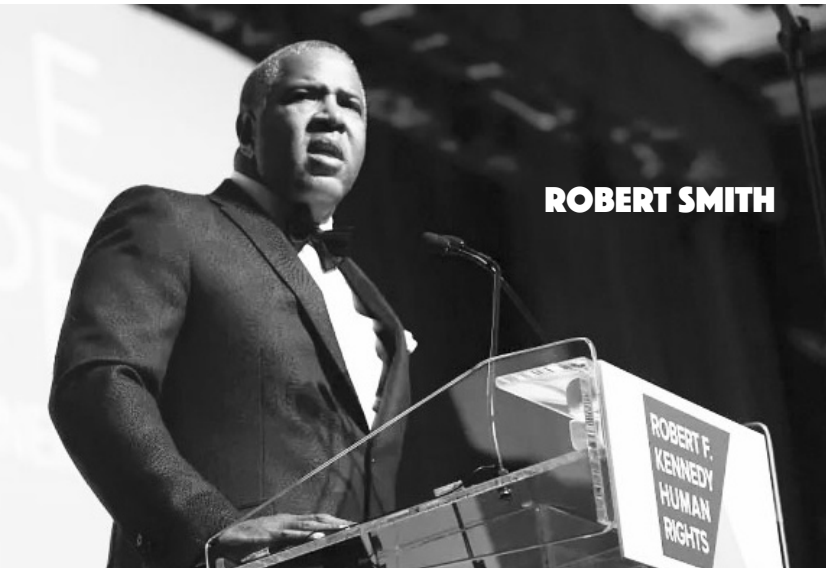

MENTORS ARE CRITICAL TO GETTING AHEAD!

LET MULTIBILLIONAIRE ROBERT SMITH TELL YOU HOW HE FOUND HIS MENTORS

Editor’s note: The following article is an op-ed, and the views expressed are the author’s own.

One of the most important things you can learn from multibillionaire Robert Smith is how to create mentors. Being mentored was critical to Smith’s ascent.

A mentor can help you learn real work skills that can help you rise.

When you learn how to inspire someone to mentor you, then you are learning how to learn.

The more you know, the

more unstoppable you are. There are few who are better to learn from than Smith.

Smith grew up as a talented engineer, but when he got to Goldman Sachs, he realized that the place to be was the mergers and acquisitions department, aka M&A.

That’s where Goldman advises major companies on how to purchase and absorb other companies.

That was the place to get really rich. But, Smith said, the skills to be in M&A are

not taught in business school so he had to figure out how to create a mentor who could help him.

So how did he learn how to excel in M&A?

Creating a mentor can be simple. Find people who are older and more experienced than you and are far ahead of you in your field.

Find a way to open up a relationship and then ask them questions that will give them a chance to share their brilliance.

Many older people love to share game with younger folks, especially when the younger person is shaping the moment as a one way conversation based on their respect for the knowledge of the older person.

When Smith needed to learn about M&A, he created a weekly mentorship program. Every Friday at lunchtime, a leader in the M&A program would come through and talk to the less experienced team members about the deals they had completed, teaching them how to do M&A.

Smith built a mentorship program that would allow experienced people to come by and get an ego boost from teaching their skills.

The program seemed magnanimous — it would surely help everyone at his level — but, of course, it was ultimately to help him grow.

By creating relationships and putting experienced

people in position to tell him what they knew, thus stroking their ego, he was able to learn how to function in M&A and become a very wealthy person.

Your destination may or may not be extreme wealth, but when you can speak to older people in your field in a tone of, hey, how would you deal with this challenge or how did you make that happen, you may find that they’re honored to teach you because from their perspective, they’re telling you how smart they are and everyone loves to lead that

Harris would not pass as white.

History flashback: this same critique was lobbed at Barack Obama in 2008 by some within the Black political establishment.

These critics said because Obama had a white American mother and Kenyan father, he wasn’t Black or Black enough.

While Obama may not have been a generational African American, meaning a descendant of chattel slavery in the U.S., every year of his presidency revealed the racism and resistance he faced as a racially Black man in America — and soon many critics of his race had to let it go. When Jeezy rapped, “My President is Black, my Lambo’s blue,” everyone sang along.

So let’s put it on the record — VP Harris is an AKA who graduated from the historically Black Howard University, identifies as a Black woman, along with being South Asian, and hasn’t shied away from embracing her race.

In a recent appearance at Essence Fest, Harris passionately recalled what she was told growing up amid a community of elders:

“I grew up in a community where it was an extended family of people who told all of us as children [that] we were young, gifted, and BLACK,” she reminisced.

There are three months to this election — and while you’ll see a lot of opinions floating around, which everyone is entitled to, the facts absolutely matter.

Kamala Harris has spoken on who she is. Whether we focus on still debating her Blackness or the policies she could enact as president to help the country, will totally be up to us.

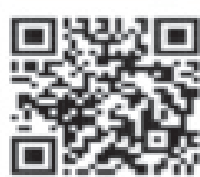
