5 points from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Letter from the Birmingham Jail!

In April 1963, Dr. King Jr. wrote a letter from the Birmingham jail as a response to eight white clergymen who criticized his participation in nonviolent protests against segregation in Birmingham, Alabama. He defended civil disobedience, confronted the inadequacies of moderate white allies, and critiqued the systemic racism embedded in society.

Here are the key points.

1. Just vs. Unjust Laws: He distinguished between just laws, which align with moral and divine laws, and unjust laws, which degrade human dignity. He argued that individuals have a moral obligation to disobey unjust laws nonviolently.

2. The "Fierce Urgency of Now": He rejected the argument that civil rights activism should wait, emphasizing that "justice too long delayed is justice denied." He critiques white moderates prioritizing order over justice and believing in gradualism rather than immediate action.

3. Nonviolent Direct Action: He defended peaceful protests as a way to create constructive tension that forces communities to confront injustice and engage in meaningful dialogue.

4. Criticism of the Church: He expressed disappointment in the church's lack of leadership and complicity in sustaining segregation, calling for moral courage from religious leaders.

5. Hope and Persistence: Despite the opposition, he reaffirmed his hope in justice and equality, rooted in his faith and belief in humanity's capacity for change.

Relevance to Combating Racism Today

Dr. King's arguments remain profoundly relevant. His insights can provide guidance in combating racism today.

1. Moral Responsibility to Act: Like King's call to resist unjust laws, we must take proactive steps to dismantle systems of oppression, recognizing their moral responsibility to challenge inequity.

2. Rejection of Gradualism: King's urgency underscored the need to avoid complacency or deferral of action. Addressing racism requires immediate, sustained efforts, rather than waiting for "a more convenient season."

3. Accountability for Allies: King's critique of moderates highlighted the danger of performative allyship. Today, genuine allies must confront their privileges and actively support systemic change, moving beyond neutrality or superficial gestures.

4. Nonviolent Advocacy: The strategy of nonviolent direct action remains a powerful tool for creating societal awareness and demanding accountability. Peaceful protests, education campaigns, and legislative advocacy are critical in challenging structural racism.

5. Centering Hope and Unity: King's belief in humanity's potential for change inspires perseverance. We can draw on his vision to build coalitions across racial, economic, and political divides.

In One Twitter Thread, Nikole Hannah-Jones Just Owned Every White Conservative Who Tries To Whitewash MLK!

White conservatives don't wait for MLK Day to start trotting out their little white-washed version of the civil rights icon, but they really ramp up the white nonsense on the holiday. By Zack Linly, courtesy of NewsOne

For years now, perhaps even decades, white America has engaged in a tradition reserved for the day we celebrate the legacy of Rev. Martin Luther King Jr., in which they lie on his name and what he stood for to placate fragile white feelings.

Every year, on the third Monday of January, the melanin-Jim-Crowed show off the boundlessness of their caucosity and take a man who was hated and opposed by the strong majority of white Americans until the day he was murdered by one of

them and water him down to make him as palatable for white consumption as humanly possible.

They isolate a single passage from a single MLK speech, completely remove the words "will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character" from the excerpt's context and suddenly MLK goes from a pro-Black radical to a Caucasian-adaptable posthumous "Black friend" for the whites to invoke at will.

Don't get me wrong—white conservatives don't wait for the holiday to start trotting out their little whitewashed version of the civil rights icon, but they really

ramp up the white nonsense on MLK Day.

For example, here's Texas Gov. Greg Abbott praising King and his "I Have a Dream" speech as if his state didn't pass an anti-Critical Race Theory law dropping requirements for educators to give lessons on MLK's teachings.

You signed a bill this year that eliminated requirements for schools to teach about Martin Luther King Jr.

Here's a question: Why wouldn't white conservatives want to make sure MLK's views, speeches and writings were taught thoroughly if King is such a shining example of how Americans ought to think and behave? Why are conservative groups seeking to ban books that he's written from school libraries if he's to serve as one of the few Black civil rights leaders recognized with the white American stamp of approval?

I'm guessing that some in the war against CRT have discovered that if you dig deep enough into the words of MLK, you'll find that what he actually stood for is exactly what white conservatives wrongly believe CRT is—an indictment of white racism at the individual level and white people as a whole.

Fortunately, Black scholars, academics and negroes who know things have begun their own tradition of using MLK's own words to prove right-wingers don't know what TF they're talking about.

Educator, journalist and activist Nikole Hannah-Jones enters the chat.

On Monday, Hannah-Jones tweeted about being invited to an event to give an MLK Day speech and about how "a small number of members of the group hosting me wrote and then leaked emails opposing my giving this speech, as it dishonored Dr. King for me to do so," calling her a "discredited activist" who is "unworthy of such association with King"

Now, we all know what that was about—white people are still

salty about Hannah-Jones' Pulitzer Prize-winning work *The 1619 Project*, which continues to succeed in spite of their objection. When they call her a "discredited activist," they're referring to the number of conservative historians who have called her work ahistorical propaganda while ignoring all of the accredited historians who contributed to the project and have praised it.

Hannah-Jones said she gave a speech anyway, but she had a surprise for her audience—she decided to pass King's words as her own before revealing the true author and proving how white people-friendly MLK wasn't.

So, I scrapped my original speech and spent the entire first half of it reading excerpts from a bunch of Dr. King's speeches, but without telling anyone that I was doing so, leading the audience to think King's words were mine. And, whew, chile, it was AMAZING.

Think of how often those people have praised MLK's legacy when the truth is, between CRT and MLK, only the latter set of initials belongs to an unabashed judge of the whites.

I left them with this: People who oppose today what he stood for back then do not get to be the arbiters of his legacy. The real Dr. King cannot be commodified, homogenized, and white-washed and whatever side you stand on TODAY is the side you would have been back then.

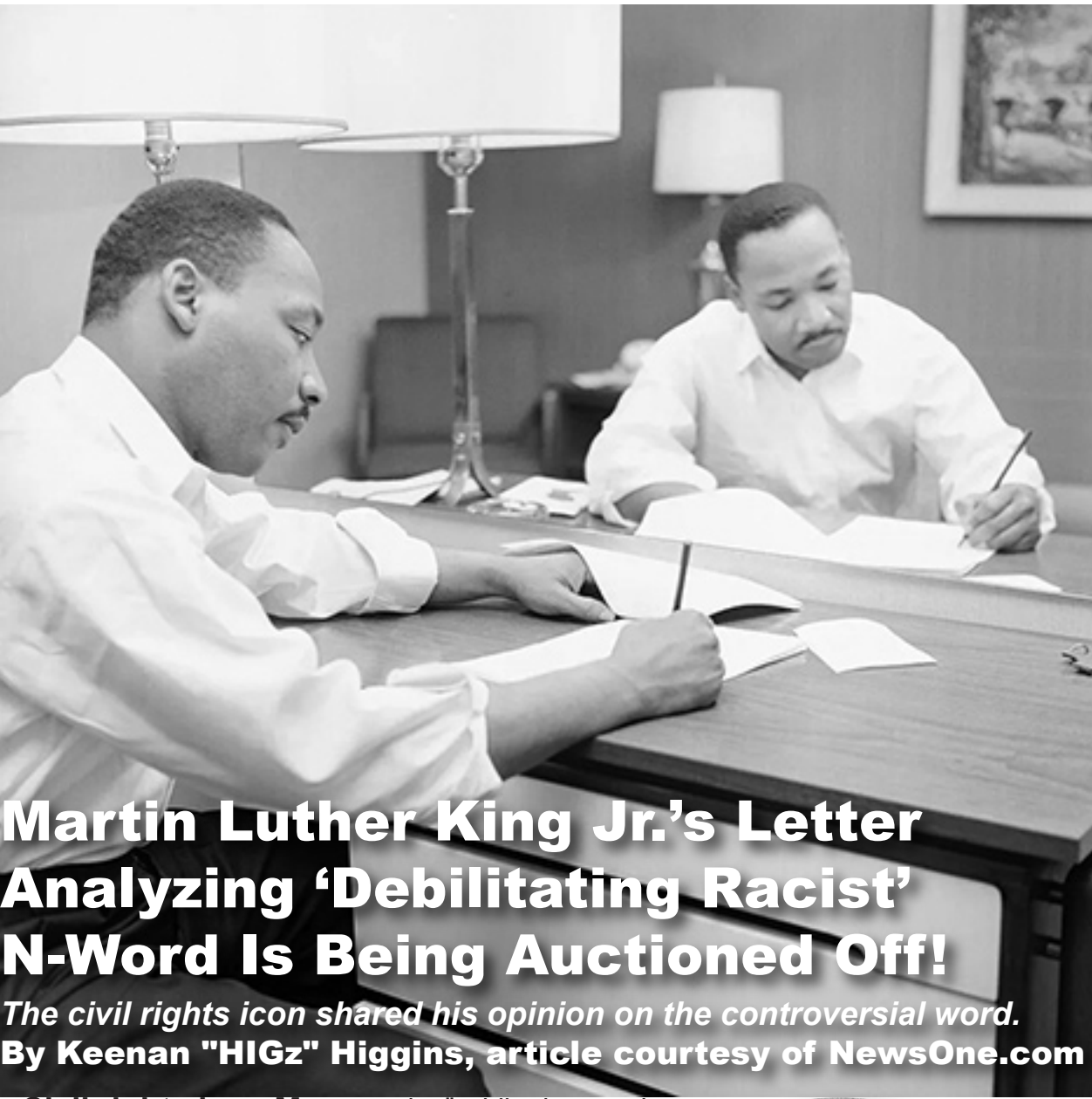

Martin Luther King Jr.'s Letter Analyzing 'Debilitating Racist' N-Word Is Being Auctioned Off!

Civil rights icon Martin Luther King Jr. will forever be remembered as one of the most prominent voices in our fight for equality as Black Americans during the social unrest of the '50s and '60s.

His ministry covered far-reaching topics, be it non-violent activism or even Native American rights, but one of his core objectives was to educate the people on how to respect ourselves.

The N-Word has been one of the most debated subjects in our community, from who gets to use it all the way to if we as Black people should be adopting it as a "term of endearment" at all.

The late great MLK Jr. had an opinion on the topic as expected. The letter is currently up for auction online.

The letter in question (seen above) is addressed to William A. Bennett in Haddonfield, New Jersey. Writing from his historic Southern Christian Leadership Conference headquarters on Auburn Avenue in Atlanta, just three days after his 37th birthday on January 18, 1966, MLK Jr. gave an insightful take on the N-word in addition to the term "dark skinned."

He says the latter reflects "both our great heritage and our devotion to a brand of Americanism of the highest

order," while denouncing the former epithet as a word that "carries with it a meaning deeply rooted in the debilitating racist caste ordering of our society's slavery epoch and segregation era."

Read it in full below:

Dear Mr. Bennett: I appreciate the meaningful points raised in your letter to me concerning racial appellations. The words "dark skinned American" constitute a vivid depiction of both citizenship and race just as you point out. I agree wholeheartedly with you that the import of that term is in salient contrast with the connotation attached to the word "nigger". The word "nigger" carries with it a meaning deeply rooted in the debilitating racist caste ordering of our society's slavery epoch and segregation era.

"The words 'dark skinned American' constitute a vivid depiction of both citizenship and race just as you point out.

"I agree wholeheartedly with you that the import of that term is in salient contrast with the connotation attached to the word 'nigger.' The word 'nigger' carries with it a meaning deeply rooted in the debilitating racist caste ordering of our society's slavery epoch and segregation era.

The term, 'dark skinned American,' often finds its way into my speeches and writings and, encouragingly, I notice it, too, in the usage of so many others.

"The use of that and similar appellations reflect both our great heritage and our devotion to a brand of Americanism of the highest order.

Sincerely yours, Martin Luther King, Jr.

Howard University's Debate Team: Upholding Dr. Martin Luther King's Legacy

Howard University's Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Forensics Society exemplifies the institution's enduring commitment to excellence in debate and public discourse.

Established in 1973 by Dr. Laura A. Fleet within the Department of Communication and Culture, the society honors Dr. King's legacy of eloquence and advocacy for social justice.

Professor Angela D. Minor, Esq., stands as a pivotal figure in Howard University's commitment to fostering excellence in communication and legal studies. Serving as the Assistant Chair and Associate Professor in the Department of Communication Studies, she brings a wealth of experience and dedication to her roles.

The society's roots trace back to the early 1940s, reflecting Howard's longstanding dedication to forensics. Over the decades, it has evolved into a dynamic program that prepares students for leadership roles. Participating in speech, debate, and mock trial competitions all over.

Notably, Howard is among the few HBCUs that actively compete in intercollegiate forensic events. Highlighting its unique position in promoting Black intellectualism and discourse.

Debate Format and Leadership

HU's debate team primarily engages in parliamentary debate, a format inspired by the discussions of the British House of Commons.

Notable Engagements

In October 2019, the team participated in the Connecticut NAACP's 10th annual "Great Debate" alongside Harvard University. Held during the Connecticut NAACP's 54th Annual State Convention. The event attracted nearly 10,000 attendees, including students from seventh through 12th grades.

The debate addressed pressing issues such as the impeachment of Donald J. Trump and the partnership between Roc Nation and the NFL. This exhibition highlighted the team's ability to engage thoughtfully with contemporary topics, fostering critical thinking among both participants and audiences.

In February 2023, the society revived the "Real HU Debate," a traditional face-off between Howard and Hampton University. This event, held at Howard's Cramton Auditorium with an audience.

Tackling conversations on issues including the inclusion of African American studies in K-12 education and immigrants' access to health-care services. Such debates not only showcase the team but also serve as platforms for discussing matters central to the Black community and the nation at large.

Continuing Dr. King's Legacy

The Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Forensics Society continues to be a vital component of Howard University's mission to develop leaders who are articulate, informed, and committed to social justice. Through rigorous training and engagement with critical issues, the society empowers students to carry forward Dr. King's legacy of using dialogue as a powerful tool for change.
