LIBERTY AT STAKE

New documentary tells the little known story of Joshua Glover, a fugitive slave who was a catalyst for the Republican Party, the Civil War, and slavery's demise!

A mural at the entrance of Highway 94/41 downtown is rarely seen as the most defining image of a Civil War catalyst, but it indeed represents a defining moment in both history and 'his-story.'

The mural portrays a Black runaway slave---Joshua Glover---whose sojourn influenced a national movement to eradicate slavery and spread a philosophy of Christian reconciliation that forever changed America.

Unfortunately, few travelers know of the historical significance of Glover and how his escape from slavery set into motion events, including the creation of the Republican (abolitionist) Party, amendments to the U.S. Constitution, and an end to the brutalization of over four million 'prisoners of war' that changed the American landscape.

(Some will say the promises of freedom for African slaves were but a placebo, as full equality has yet to be achieved a century later.)

The author and director of a documentary on Glover (not his real name but one given to him by his 'owner') hopes to change that discrepancy.

Michael Jahr learned of the remarkable journey of Glover, who traveled over 400 miles from St. Louis to Racine to escape slavery only to be captured by slavers and his 'owner.'

A beaten and battered Glover was taken to the Milwaukee County jail, an action that prompted abolitionist Sherman Booth to write editorials encouraging Wisconsin citizens to get off the fence and take action.

Booth noted not only the cruelty inherent in Glover's beating but also the injustice of the Fugitive Slave Act and slavery in general.

The power of his words was considered rebellious (court documents called them 'traitorist'), leading to Booth's imprisonment. It also resulted in a call to arms for over 5,000 Wisconsin citizens who stormed the county jail.

When peaceful means were unsuccessful in freeing him, the citizens forcefully dismissed the jailers and freed him from his cage. They immediately arranged his travel on a steamer headed to Canada.

The unprecedented actions of the Wisconsin citizens were a remarkable story in itself, but it was only the tip of the iceberg

A little-known fact that I provided Jahr during a luncheon meeting with consultant Simona Johnson was that Wisconsin entertained a proposal to succeed from the Union over the Fugitive Slave Act, which was con-

considered an affront to human decency and basic Christian principles. The federal government mandate forced citizens on both sides of the fence to assist in the capture of runaway slaves or face imprisonment or worse.

Better known was the establishment of the Republican Party in nearby Ripon, Wisconsin. Conceived as an abolitionist political entity, the GOP's first candidate for president was Abraham Lincoln.

Interestingly, Glover is not a household name despite his role as a catalyst for the Civil War. In fact, since my meeting with Jahr, who is seeking donations to expand his 30-minute documentary into a full-length film, only two of the 10 Black folks I quizzed over the weekend knew of the Joshuas Glover story!

None knew of the Waukeha community's role in freeing him or that Waukesha was a hotbed of abolitionist activity. Indeed, did you know that the county's newspaper—the Freedman—represented the ideology of its citizens? That fact in itself is ironic, given that it is well known that Waukesha is today considered an ultra-conservative community where people with melanin are unwanted.

I have long wondered how a community with roots in liberation and freedom from slavery has made a 180-degree transition. The same question can be said of the Republican Party. Think of it, the 'Party of Lincoln' is today represented by Donald Trump, whose first executive order was to eliminate any reference to diversity, equity, and inclusion. His record

on race relations is totally opposite of Lincoln's. Trump's favorite president was Andrew Jackson, a known racist who took pride in exterminating Native Americans (giving them blankets laden with Small Pox) as they were forced from their homelands in the Southeast to Indian territory (now Oklahoma) between 1830 and 1850.

This removal of indigenous Americans was known as the 'Indian Removal Act of 1830, and became known as the 'Trail of Tears,' which Jackson—as president—supported. Jackson also led an army to stop the expansion of the Underground Railroad.

I found Jahr to be an interesting researcher and humanitarian. He has taken on the challenge of bringing the Joshua Glover story to light, both with the hope of including a significant chapter in the American history canon and, more so, to shed light on how this seemingly insignificant slave influenced American history.

In researching the Glover name for this article, I found a song rooted in his sojourn, college lectures, and political essays.

An interesting article on his 400-mile trek from St. Louis revealed a discipline few can identify with. Glover traveled about 15-20 miles a day, hiding or accepting sanctuary in Underground Railroad stops. He often went without food or water for days and was considered illiterate; his only map was God's Northern Star.

Little is known of the challenges he faced, but death was better than capture and return to the chains applied by his 'massa,' Benammi Garland, who traveled with federal bounty hunters to Racine, where they captured him.

Few of us can imagine the atrocities of slavery. The assaults, rapes, and brutalizations were beyond human imagination. It is said that Black Americans are a new breed based on the rapes of our ancestors. Less than 15% of Black Americans are considered 'pure.' I am 18% European. My wife is 24%. That reality is a DNA testimony to a rapist along our genealogical history.

Most 'Founding Fathers,' including Thomas Jefferson, were involved in those atrocities. The only reason why they were not considered rapists is because our ancestors were not regarded as human. They were chattel, like cows and sheep.

Jahr said he first learned of the Glover story when he came across a book by a college professor titled, 'The Rescue of Joshua Glover.' It moved him more than anything he had read about slavery and sent him on a path that had redefined his life.

"When I first heard about the events surrounding Joshua Glover, I knew it was a story that needed telling.

"As a history lover and lifelong

storyteller, I was struck by a real-life narrative that had it all: drama, conflict, heroics, villainy, fear, sacrifice ... and an unexpected twist.

"The protagonist was a true underdog, the antagonist a heartless scoundrel. It was an old-fashioned tale of good vs. evil, David vs. Goliath.

Jahr was totally engrossed by the book, which he called a "story of triumph and unity with Wisconsin ties."

Interestingly, the Glover story may serve as a bridge between Democrats and Republicans.

Jahr's documentary, narrated by Dr. Ken Harris, a radio talkshow host on 105 FM, 'The Truth', has been shown and endorsed by state Republicans, including former Governors Tommy Thompson and Scott Walker. It was also recently demonstrated for the Democratic Black Caucus Black History program in Madison.

It has left its audience in awe.

Jahr hopes to raise funds to expand his 30-minute documentary. This intriguing undertaking would raise awareness of a chapter of United States history some conservatives are trying to underplay,

and others are trying to promote as a consensus vehicle.

Equally important, it serves as a catalyst for a reexamination of how the Republican Party (and Waukesha) moved from liberalism to conservatism. It could redefine conservatism and routes to empowerment.

Jahr wants to find out what happened to Glover in Canada. I've written about the travels of the 'real' Uncle Tom, who faced discrimination and racism in Canada. Did Glover face similar obstacles? Did he have children? Did he influence the political climate? Equally significant, what happened to the GOP?

We'll only know if Jahr completes his documentary.

COUNTY EXECUTIVE CROWLEY PRAISES STATE OF WISCONSIN FOR SUPPORTING FUNDING FOR FUTURE HOME TO OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, MEDICAL EXAMINER

Milwaukee County Executive David Crowley is praising Governor Tony Evers and the State of Wisconsin for approving additional funding to complete the future home of the Milwaukee County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) and Medical Examiner's Office.

Last week, the Wisconsin State Building Commission approved funding for capital projects across the state, including for the Forensic Science and Protective Medicine Facility where, in addition to serving Milwaukee OEM and Medical Examiner's Office, the Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ) will relocate the Milwaukee Crime Lab to re-

place an outdated, overcrowded, and deficient facility.

The project creates synergy and advances forensic sciences into a modern, state-of-the-art facility.

In addition, the four-story facility will include the relocated Versiti Blood Research Institute, a current Milwaukee Regional Medical Center campus partner.

"I commend Governor Tony Evers and the Wisconsin State Building Commission for deploying additional investments to construct the future Forensic Science and Protective Medicine Facility and enhance public safety throughout Milwaukee County," said County Executive Crowley.

"The future Forensic Science and Protective Medicine Center will become a regional public safety asset that will strengthen medical and emergency management capabilities throughout Wisconsin and allow for more efficient, cost-effective responses to emergency situations.

I'm grateful for the public-private partnership that will generate a positive statewide impact through making this project a reality."

The Forensic Science and Protective Medicine Facility is being funded with \$99.5 million in state funds, approved in August 2022 by the Commission.

After multiple previous attempts to move this project forward failed, in September 2022, Governor Evers announced an additional \$20

million grant for Milwaukee County to assist in the construction of the facility.

This additional investment ensured the project could meet the threshold needed to begin construction and prevented the project from once again being stalled.

County Executive Crowley and Governor Evers participated in a groundbreaking event for the facility in November 2023.

"Whether it's working to preserve and protect Wisconsin's proud tradition of conservation that has defined our state for generations, upholding our commitment to support systems that address crime and keep kids, families, and communities safe, or investing in the higher education institutions that are key to the future economic growth and prosperity of our state, all of the projects approved by the Commission today get at the heart of many of our key priorities as a state," said Governor Evers.

"I am glad that my fellow bipartisan commissioners and I could find common ground in approving these funds so these important projects can move forward in communities across our state."
