COA ends contracts with MKE REC, leaving some after-school and summer programs in limbo

COA Youth and Family Centers has ended a 30-year partnership with Milwaukee Recreation that provided after-school programs, summer programming, access to overnight camps and family events through Community Learning Centers.

In February, the agency's staff members were notified that COA would terminate its contract at the end of the academic school year, forcing Milwaukee Recreation, also known as MKE REC, to look for new partnerships.

"This came as a surprise to us," said Leighton Cooper, MKE REC's recreation coordinator.

"But we are working to remedy the situation. We are always committed to ensuring young people have safe spaces to be."

Impacted schools include Auer

Avenue School, 2319 W. Auer Ave.; Oliver Wendell Holmes School, 2463 N. Buffum St.; Hopkins Lloyd Community School, 1503 W. Hopkins St.; Doerfler Public School, 3014 W

safe. "Right now, we're working to keep the program as is at three of the schools," he said. "The other two are more unique, so the goal is to create a

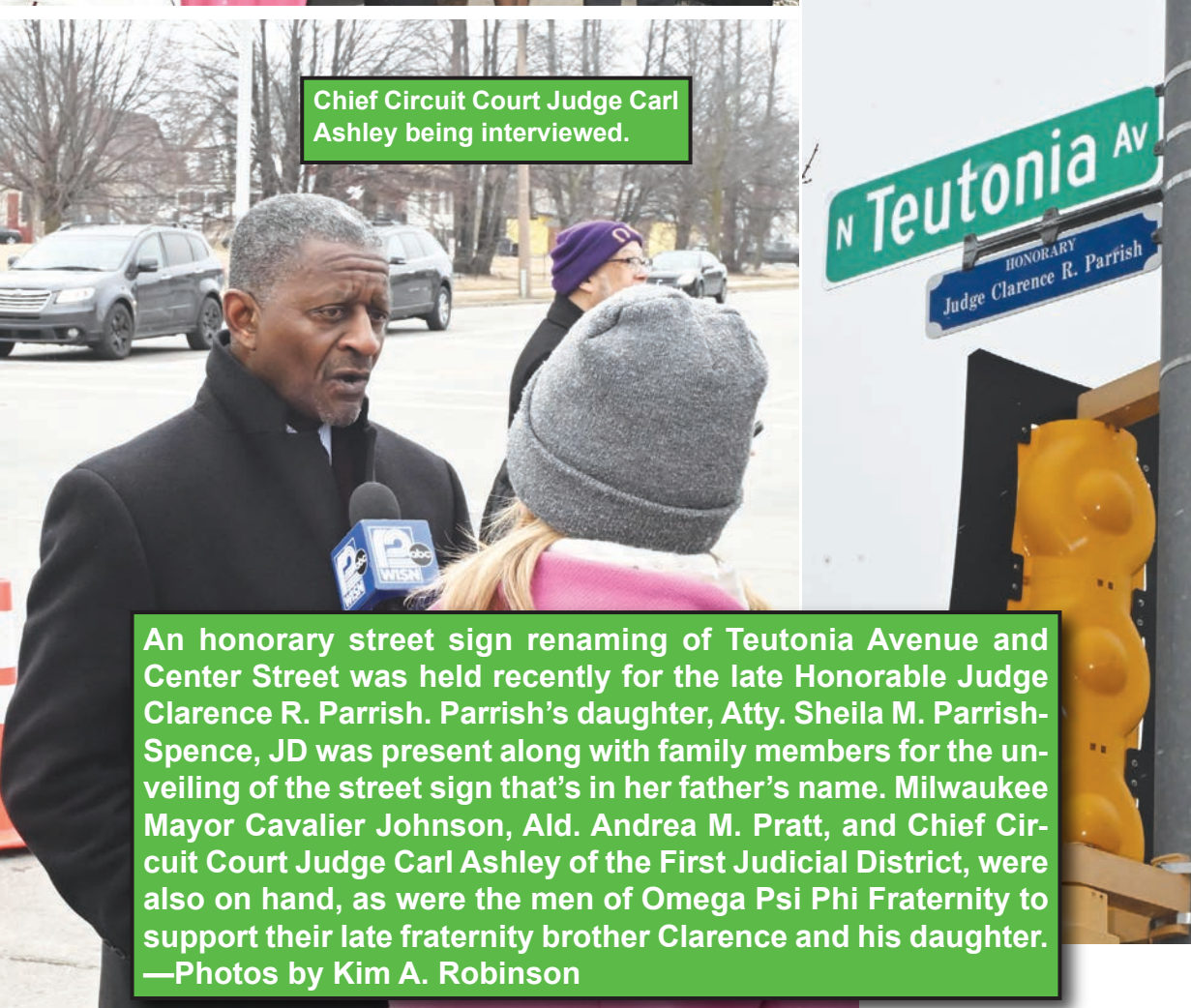

BLOODY SUNDAY AT 60: This Is Not a Celebration!

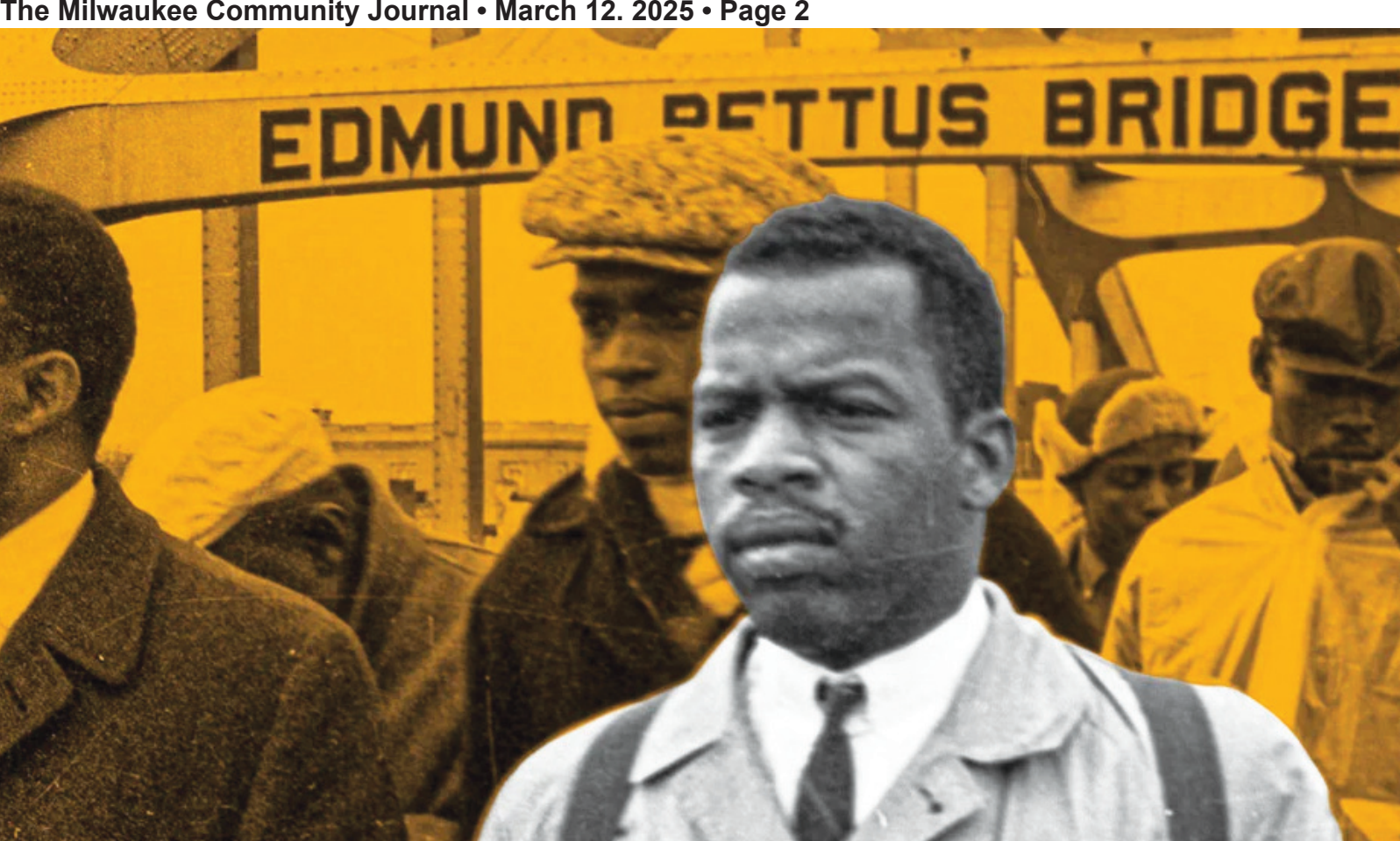
Beaten and left for dead. Skulls cracked by batons. Tear gassed. Seventeen people hospitalized.

That was the carnage sixty years ago, on the Edmund Pettus Bridge in Selma, Alabama, when Black people marched and bled for a right guaranteed by the Constitution: the right to vote. Some 600 civil rights advocates — including future congressman John Lewis, then just 25 years old — set out from Selma to Montgomery to demand the country honor that guarantee.

State troopers, local police, and white vigilantes met them with horrific violence instead. Images of the violence on that day, known

as Bloody Sunday, "made it plain and clear that hundreds, thousands, millions of people could not participate in the democratic process simply because of the color of their skin," Lewis said in 2018.

Visual proof of that brutal assault — the blood, the broken skulls, the tear gas — shocked the nation's conscience and catalyzed the passage of the Voting Rights Act just months later.

Now, civil rights activists and scholars warn that the 60th anniversary of Bloody Sunday arrives not as a celebration of voting rights but as a stark warning that the right, paid for in blood that day, is in peril.

"I think about the progress that has been made — and the threat," Rev. Al Sharpton said about the anniversary on MSNBC's Morning Joe on Friday.

"I marched across that bridge with the first Black president during the 50th anniversary," Sharpton said. "Now, in the 60th anniversary, we're facing a president that, in our judgment, is hostile to those rights."

History Made

A decade ago, President Barack Obama linked arms with Sharpton, John Lewis, now a veteran congressman, and other civil rights leaders to march across that bridge for the 50th anniversary of Bloody Sunday.

"Because of what they did, the doors of opportunity swung open not just for African Americans, but for every American," Obama said in a historic speech on that day.

It was an electric and emotional moment, a flicker of hope for many that the nation had finally turned a corner.

But Charles Blow, then-columnist for The New York Times, felt something else.

Instead of celebration, "there seemed to me something else in the air: a lingering — or gathering — sense of sadness," he wrote. "[A] frustration born out of perpetual incompleteness, an anger engendered by the threat of regression, a pessimism about a present and future riven by worsening racial understanding and interplay."

Now, 10 years later, America's experiencing what political analyst Bakari Sellers calls President Donald Trump's "attack on civil rights and this agenda rooted in racial division."

The Shelby County Decision and its Aftermath

Two years before Obama's speech, the Supreme Court delivered a devastating blow to the landmark Voting Rights Act of 1965 with its 2013 decision in Shelby County v. Holder.

In a 5-4 ruling, the court's conservative majority gutted the law's "pre-clearance" provision, which required states with histories of racial discrimination to get federal approval before changing voting laws. Chief Justice John Roberts justified the decision by claiming "things had

changed dramatically" since the VRA's passage five decades earlier.

The data tells a different story.

Research by Kevin T. Morris, a senior fellow and voting policy scholar with the Democracy program at the Brennan Center for Justice, and Michael G. Miller, a political science professor at Columbia University's Barnard College, reveals that the racial turnout gap in formerly covered jurisdictions has grown significantly.

"In the average county where Shelby County freed state and, especially, local voting administrators from federal oversight, the relative participation of nonwhite Americans has worsened," they wrote.

Since 2013, state legislatures in those bright-red states have stayed booked and busy enacting nearly 100 restrictive voting laws. In 2024 alone, at least 10 states enacted 19 laws restricting voting, and at least 317 bills that restricted voting were considered in 40 states," according to the Brennan Center.

The SAVE Act: A New Threat

No longer as obvious as poll taxes or literacy tests, attacks on voting rights are far more sophisticated, and come in the guise of "election integrity" despite little evidence of voter fraud.

They run the gamut: strict ID requirements that disproportionately affect Black and other minority voters; reduced early-voting periods; aggressive voting roll purges; gerrymandered districts that dilute Black voting strength; even prohibitions on providing water to voters waiting in long lines in the heat of the day.

In February, Republicans in Washington announced plans to fast-track the SAVE Act, a bill that would require specific citizenship documents — a birth certificate, passport, or a handful of other approved forms of identification — every time they register or re-register to vote.

The Brennan Center, however, estimates at least 21 million Americans — most of them poor and Black — don't possess that kind of "show your papers" documentation. In addition, the nonpartisan law and policy organization noted that because this documentation must be presented in person, the legislation "would obliterate or upend longstanding and popular methods of voter registration for all voters, including registration by mail, voter registration drives, online voter registration, and automatic voter registration."

"Our Cause Too"

"Never did I think that 60 years — 60 years after John was bludgeoned on a bridge — that the cause for which John Lewis and those foot soldiers marched would be our cause too," Democratic Rep. Terri Sewell, a Selma native, said on Wednesday when she reintroduced voting rights legislation named after the late congressman.

The bill, which has been reintroduced every Congress since Shelby v

Holder, is unlikely to pass in the current political climate, with Trump in the White House and Republicans in control of both houses of Congress. But Sewell and other advocates are undeterred.

"We know that the groundswell of public sentiment matters," Sewell said. "And we're appealing to the American public to continue to join with us in this fight for better protections for voting rights."

This weekend, Sewell will lead a commemorative march across the Edmund Pettus Bridge. Former Vice President Kamala Harris — who knows the consequences of voter suppression and restriction first-hand — posted on social media on Friday that "we march on."

It's "not easy, and we cannot do it alone," Harris wrote. But we must "recommit to our fight to safeguard the freedom to vote. Together, we must stand for democracy. Together, we must continue our fight for justice, equality, and opportunity for all."

Or, as Black Lives Matter wrote on X on Friday, "Every so-called win in this country came because Black people refused to back down, even when it cost us everything."

As John Lewis once wrote to his younger self: "You were beaten on that bridge. You were left bloody. You thought you were going to die. But you would make it. You would live to see your mother and father cast their first votes."

development and community development.

The termination of contracts is part of a series of changes at COA, including the pause of its teen program housed at its Goldin Center, 2320 W. Burleigh St.

In addition, COA leaders have paused programming at its overnight summer camp, Camp Helen Brachman, which has run every summer for over 100 years.

Amy Rowell, the executive director of COA, said the agency is prioritizing services at its primary locations at 909 E. Garfield Ave. and 2320 W. Burleigh St.

"We are shifting our focus to core and direct programming and building up the capacity of both of our primary locations, with a lot of my attention being given to reimagining and developing the full potential of Goldin," said Rowell, who assumed her position in February.

Cooper said the Childhood Learning Centers, or CLCs, run on five-year grants, adding that the ones COA operates are in year three.

He said because funding is available, it's just a matter of finding the right partners to run the centers.

"That's something we can find exciting in this situation," he said. "Getting to create those new partnerships with organizations interested in facilitating CLCs."

MKE REC will update its website with available summer programming by mid-April and keep impacted families updated as best as possible through connecting with school leadership.

'He will be missed deeply in my heart': People across the Milwaukee area remember Junior Bridgeman

People outside the basketball world who felt, touched by Junior Bridgeman, shared their stories of the Milwaukee legend while mourning his death.

"I remember meeting him at Wendy's and just the way that he is the owner of this restaurant but he's walking around saying hi to everybody," Victor Barnett, executive director and founder of Running Rebels, told TMJ4. "So on the court and off the court, he was a special person and something to have our young people look up to."

"My favorite thing about him was to see the joy that he had in life," Victor Gray, Bridgeman's Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity brother said.

Both men were devastated to learn that Bridgeman died on Tuesday after a medical emergency in Kentucky.

Like so many, Gray watched Bridgeman on the Bucks but got to know him after joining the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity's Milwaukee chapter Delta Chi Lambda in the late 1970s.

"You could've taken me off of the floor after they assigned him as my sponsor," Gray recalled. "My favorite was that first pledge session to see him there snickering at us, fumbling our words and stumbling over our bad memories and the joy that he had for the fraternity."

Gray said they grew close through the fraternity but lost touch over the years. He expressed regret that the two did not get to reconnect.

Gray admired the NBA star's kindness and humble attitude.

"The thing that he offered was his word. He put his word and his name out there for me. He didn't

have to," Gray stated.

"Junior Bridgeman is a perfect example of what we would want our young people to strive to be," Barnett said.

Barnett has spent decades working to empower Milwaukee's youth through activities such as basketball.

"He played hard, but some of the players that played with him were more known and recognized, but he was valuable to the team. I never saw a problem or attitude out of him like, 'Give me the ball or I want this.' He was a perfect teammate," Barnett explained.

Milwaukee Rep is one of many regional cities participating, offering free workshops across the city to prepare students in the selections and rehearsal of their monologue.

Thatcher Jacobs from Kettle Moraine High School was awarded First place for his performance of The Prophet by Idris Goodwin.

In Second place was Silver Anderson from Golda Meir High School who performed Same by Cheryl West, and runner up Olivia Cross-Luster

from Pius XI High School performed Daughter by Cheryl L. West.

DRIVING CHANGE! MILWAUKEE ENTREPRENEUR HONORS BLACK INNOVATORS IN THE AUTO INDUSTRY

Milwaukee business owner Natasha Broxton is breaking barriers in an industry where Black ownership is rare.

As the owner of Select Auto Parts and Sales, located at 2500 W Cornell Street in Milwaukee, she runs one of the only Black-owned auto parts recyclers in the nation.

Now, in honor of Black History Month, she's launching a new initiative

— Automotive in Black — to highlight the contributions of African Americans in the automotive world.

"They inspire me to keep going," Broxton said.

Through social media and in-store displays, Automotive in Black showcases Black innovators who have shaped the industry—from Garrett Morgan, the inventor of the

traffic light, to C.R. Patterson, the first Black automaker.

When asked why this history is important to share, Broxton didn't hesitate.

"It's not put out there. We know about MLK, we know about Rosa

Parks—but what about all these other contributions we've made to history that aren't broadcasted?" she said.

For Broxton, representation is just one reason this campaign matters.

Another? The challenges she faces as a Black woman in a male-dominated field.

"People doubt that I know what I'm doing—I face that a lot," she admitted. "And access to capital has always been a challenge."

Despite those obstacles, Broxton's family has spent 40 years building a successful business on Milwaukee's North Side.

Now, she hopes Automotive in Black will inspire others to push past barriers and redefine the industry.

"One of the inventors I learned about, Garrett Morgan, created the spotlight.

"One of the creators of the Ford Bronco was a Black man—like, who would know that?" she said.

But Broxton's mission doesn't

stop with Black History Month.

She plans to expand the campaign into mentorship programs and partnerships with schools, ensuring the next generation learns about these hidden pioneers.

"One of the reasons I'm doing this is because I know this knowledge—this education, this history—can inspire someone else. Our young people need to see this," Broxton said.

Let's go back in time to the early 20th century. The year was 1904. It was the third-ever Olympic Games—the first in the U.S.—and a man from Wisconsin made history.

But his story isn't one we are all familiar with—until the past few years, when he has finally been given the recognition he deserves.

That man is George Poage. He was the first African American to win a medal in the Olympics, earning bronze in the 200- and 400-meter hurdles at the 1904 Games in St. Louis.

"When we're thinking that we're less than 50 years out of slavery, for an African American to be able to compete against white people and win, that's an important contribution," Clayborn Benson, executive director of the Wisconsin Black Historical Society, said.

Poage was born in Missouri in 1880 but moved to La Crosse, Wisconsin, as a child. He was a standout student and athlete in high school. Then he went to the University of Wisconsin-Madison for college.

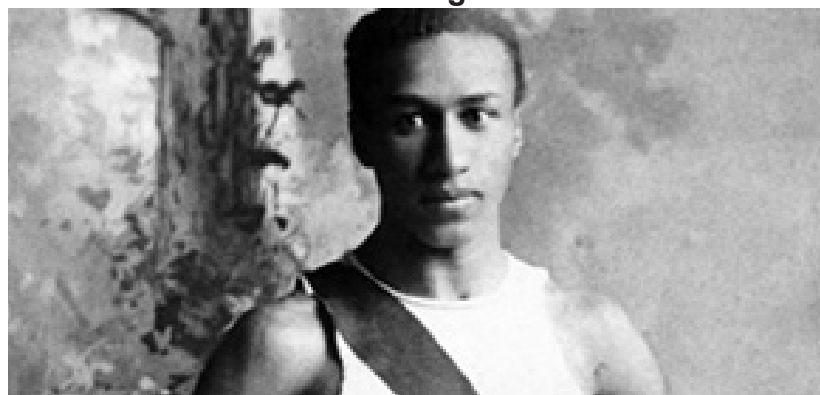
He was the first African American on the team and the first to win a Big Ten championship. He graduated in 1904. Shortly after, he competed in the St. Louis Olympics, where he won two medals. He was also sponsored by the Milwaukee Athletic Club.

"For an African American and for a citizen of Wisconsin, that's a big deal," Benson said.

But his story isn't well known. In the early 1900s, the Olympics had little fanfare. There were no media tours for the winners or even cash payouts for being on the podium. The era of lucrative sponsorships was still years away.

"All we've got are some very grainy, a few still—precious still—pictures of George, so I think the documentation of it all is challenging," Todd Pritchard, who is in charge of media and public relations at the Wisconsin Foundation and Alumni Association, said.

Pritchard discovered Poage around 2019 while researching famous University of Wisconsin-Madison alumni from all the counties in the state. He said Poage was never widely known and shied away from any potential fame.

"George didn't really make a big deal about it, right? Once he won those medals, he really decided to take a different path," he said.

That started to change in the 1990s. Poage was inducted into the Wisconsin Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 and given a plaque near other inductees by Panther Arena in Milwaukee.

"Even at that point, people didn't know a lot about his achievements," Pritchard said.

Until a few years ago. Recently, he has been the subject of a local documentary and multiple short biographies. In 2016, the city of La Crosse built a statue of him. Slowly, his story is being told more.

"I wish he was here today. I wish we could really celebrate him and really give him the kudos that he deserves," Pritchard said.

After the Olympics, he became a teacher and principal in St. Louis. Then he moved to Chicago to work as a postal clerk, where he lived the rest of his life in relative anonymity. He never married or had children. He was a private man holding onto a secret. He didn't come out himself, but a relative later revealed that George Poage was gay.

"So I think that in today's world, George Poage would be shocked and astonished by how far the world has come. But I think he would also be proud and more open to accepting himself and who he was," Michail Takach, chair of the Wisconsin LGBTQ History Project, said.

He wasn't looking for attention, especially given the social implications of the time between the 1910s and 1960s.

"So we have to understand that in George Poage's time, the world was very different. People could lose their jobs. They could be evicted. They could be banished by their families, their friends, everyone, simply for being who they were," Takach said.
