Early voting occurring now until March 30

Several voters casting their ballots early at the Capitol Drive Voting Center said the Supreme Court race was why this election was important for them to show up to.

Advocates say they recognize the challenges of getting voters to show up during a non-presidential election.

"Not many people know there's an election on April 1. Even with all the commercials and all the bickering between the candidates, they still don't know," said Rev. Gregory Lewis, executive director of Souls to the Polls.

Rev. Lewis is stressing the importance of this election. "If you are concerned about Medicare, Medicaid, Social Security, housing, education, jobs, veterans' rights, civil rights, voting rights or just being treated right...you ought to be ready and willing to vote every time there's an election," he said.

GOV. TONY EVERS, WISDOT ANNOUNCE \$6.3 MILLION IN TRANSPORTATION AIDS FOR SENIORS, INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES

Gov. Evers
 MADISON — Gov.

Tony Evers, together with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), today announced over \$6.3 million in funding to 58 agencies across the state through the Specialized Transit Program to improve local transportation services for seniors and individuals with disabilities.

The joint federal and state program provides grants to help with specialized transportation services such as mobility management, operating assistance, and vehicle purchases.

"We must continue our work to make sure Wisconsinites across our state can get from Point A to Point B safely, no matter where they live in Wisconsin.

Access to transportation is a key part of connecting the dots to make sure folks can get to where they need to go, whether it's work, medical appoint-

ments, or the grocery store, or accessing the critical services they need," said Gov. Evers.

"These investments will continue building upon our work to make sure Wisconsin's infrastructure can meet the demands of the 21st Century."

Approved Specialized Transit Program projects for 2025 include funding for 15 mobility management initiatives to help coordinate transportation services, increase capacity, and connect individuals with transportation services in their geographic area.

An additional 23 operating as-

istance grants will be funded to help organizations defray day-to-day costs of operating these programs. Many of the grant recipients serve smaller communities in rural areas.

A complete list of 5310 Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program Grants for 2025 is available here. The Approved Specialized Transit Program is administered by WisDOT via the Federal Transit Administration's Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program.

Thanks to the Biden-Harris Administration's Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, starting in 2023, WisDOT was provided with additional federal funds to support five years of administering the 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program to communities across the state.

"We are committed to building a safe and efficient transportation system that serves everyone," said WisDOT Secretary Kristina Boardman.

"This combination of federal and state funding will allow

 local agencies to broaden their reach, offer basic mobility services, and give more people access to community services.”
 According to the U.S. Department of Transportation 2022 National Household Travel Survey, 18.6 million Americans

aged five and older report having travel-limiting disabilities. Compared to those reporting no disabilities, those with travel-limiting disabilities were reported to be less likely to travel, be employed, or live in a household with a vehicle.

The report further states that individuals with travel-limiting disabilities often took fewer trips, citing health problems as the top-most reason for taking fewer trips, and lived in lower-income households. These individuals were re-

ported to compensate for their disabilities by asking others for rides, limiting travel to daytime, and using rideshare and other special transportation services. Under federal transportation law, the cities of Milwaukee, Madison, Appleton, and Green

Bay administer the federal 5310 program for their geographic areas. The cities coordinate with WisDOT to ensure continuity of the application and project selection process. WisDOT continues to administer the 5310 Program for the

rural and smaller urban areas of the state. Additional information on the Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program is available on the WisDOT Specialized Transit website.

City of Milwaukee Health Department and MPS Provide Updates on Lead Safety Efforts

The City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) and Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) continue to take critical steps to assess and address lead hazards in school buildings.

As part of these efforts, MHD and MPS are providing updates on recent lead screening clinic results, school inspections, and ongoing remediation efforts.

On Saturday, March 15, MHD, MPS, Children's Wisconsin, and Sixteenth Street Community Health Centers held a free lead screening clinic at Bradley Tech High School. A total of 249 children were screened for lead exposure.

To protect the privacy of children screened, specific data on cases below certain thresholds cannot be disclosed.

However, MHD can confirm that:

A very small number of children tested above the CDC's reference value of 3.5 µg/dL, and some of them do not attend MPS schools.

These cases were low enough that they did not require nursing case management from MHD.

91% of children screened were from the originally targeted schools (Golda Meir Lower Campus, Kagel, Maryland Avenue Montessori, Trowbridge, Starns Early Childhood Center, Fernwood, and LaFollette).

94% of children screened attend MPS schools.

Families who were unable to attend the screening clinic are encouraged to take advantage of additional free pop-up clinics in the coming weeks.

MHD is pleased to announce that Golda Meir Lower Campus and Maryland Avenue Montessori have both passed final clearance checks fol-

lowing thorough testing this week. Lead dust levels at these schools meet established safety standards, and no further remediation is required at this time.

To ensure continued safety, MPS will maintain enhanced cleaning protocols in these buildings.

Additionally, MHD and MPS are developing a rolling inspection schedule to assess schools across the district systematically.

More details on this effort will be shared as planning progresses.

The following schools remain temporarily closed while MPS continues remediation efforts:

- Starns Early Childhood Center
- Fernwood Montessori
- LaFollette School

MHD will conduct additional clearance checks at these schools, and updates will be provided to families as soon as reopening timelines are determined.

A Week's Worth of "WOW" at the Fiserv Forum!

Your Milwaukee Bucks win two out of three games against some of the league's best teams and players



If you're a NBA fan, not to mention a Milwaukee Bucks' fan, all you can do is say, "WOW!" The Bucks played three games in five days this past week after losing three games in a row the week before.

On Thursday, March 13, they beat the Los Angeles Lakers 126 to 106. Giannis had 24 points, 12 rebounds, and nine assists, Luka Doncic who was unstoppable had 45 points, 11 rebounds, with 29 of the points in the first half. LeBron James was out with a minor injury.

On Saturday, March 15, the Bucks beat the Indiana Pacers 126 to 119. Aaron Nesmith scored 30 PTs, Pascal Siakam 26 PTs, Wisconsin's own Tyrese Haliburton had 24 points and 15 assists. Damian Lillard had 25 points, 10 rebounds, and 8 assists.

The win gave the Bucks a 38-28 record, giving them a one game lead over Indiana Pacers in the race for the fourth playoff spot in the Eastern Conference.

The following night, March 16, the Bucks lost to the number one team in the Western Conference, the Oklahoma City Thunder, 121 to 105.

The Thunder's star player, Shai Gilgeous-Alexander ("SGA") scored 31 points and had eight assists. The Thunder had just come from Detroit where they beat the Pistons 113 to 107. In the game against OKC, Giannis had 21 points, 12 rebounds, and 10 assists.

As of this writing, the Bucks are on a five game West Coast swing, then come home to face the New York Knicks.

A fraternity of heartrending brotherhood and painful circumstance

I never met Christine Jacob before Monday. Nor had I ever engaged Heidi Gronke, Marion Schmidt or Rose and David Bongiovani.

We live miles apart, probably see the world through totally different prisms, and I can't say for sure if we share religions, political philosophies or even share similar values or mores.

But we do share an emotional bond; we're part of a unique fraternity. We are members of a heartrending brotherhood—a fellowship of painful circumstance.

Our collective tears fill a shared pool, one that swells with a new member every 13 minutes.

Each of us has lost a loved one through a tragic and avoidable auto accident. Five hundred and eighty seven Wisconsin families joined our fraternity last year.

Unfortunately, thousands will join our ranks in the coming years.

While the circumstances of our membership vary, the epilogues of our tales conclude on the same tearful note.

And the morbid song we sing is now being shared in a unique video released earlier this week.

Along with five other families, we are featured in a heart wrenching video produced by the Department of Transportation that serves as the cornerstone of new traffic safety campaign called 'Zero in Wisconsin—a vision we can all live with.'

The campaign features Wisconsin families from around the state who share not only the circumstances of auto accidents that took the lives of a loved one, but who also implore our neighbors to take the necessary—and generally simple steps to combat needless auto accidents.

We point fingers at the stupidity of driving under the influence, and the idiocy of driving without a seat belt. Our collective message is obviously too late for loved ones, and family members who have to live with the never ending pain of personal loss, but it's timely for the thousands who don't buckle-up, drove too fast under adverse conditions, or drank before sitting behind the wheel.

I hadn't seen the 20-minute video featuring the 10 families, or the related radio and television commercials before Monday when I participated in a press conference to announce the campaign.

Unexpectedly, the condensed version of the documentary shown to the media moments before my presentation was so powerful that I had to collect myself as I walked to the podium.

Listening to Mary Reinhart, the only survivor of an accident that killed her four closest friends, hit a nerve and sent shivers down my spine.

As did the words of Christine Jacobs, whose four-month-old son was killed in an accident, as she explained how the death of a child tugs at your soul for the rest of your life.

Gronke's realization that her sister, who was three months shy of high school graduation, will never feel the warmth of the sun, to raise a family or to hear laughter hit a cord, as did the presentation of Rose Bongiovani who acknowledged that 'every day she and her husband will have to live with the tragic consequences of their daughter's unnecessary death.

Obviously, I can relate.

My son, Malik, died on a foggy evening on March 17, less than two miles from his home. Ironically (or maybe by fate), it was his birthday, a morbid 'coincidence' that adds to the confusion and mystery that continues to plague my thoughts.

Malik held so much promise...all who knew him assumed he was destined for greatness. He was a product of the civil and human rights movement, having sat at the feet of some of our community's, and nation's foremost leaders. He was a talented writer, orator and educator, who the year before had been named the Teacher of the Year.

Juggling a teacher's vocation with work on his master's degree, mentoring and coaching, he was returning from a birthday celebration when his car struck a barrier on what turned out to be the foggiest evening in a decade on the corner of Fond du Lac and Locust Street.

He was less than two miles away from the home he shared with his step-sister and where his then-eight year old son was awaiting his return.

Malik wasn't wearing a seat belt, a factor that contributed to his senseless death.

I told the media that I shared some of the blame for his death because I never provided the example all children need to witness. As a child Malik rarely saw me buckling up. And he followed my example into adulthood. With tragic results.

Nearly one in four Wisconsinites follow our idiotic example. In the Black community, that number swells to nearly 50%.

I can't explain my decision, other than to say it was inconvenient, or uncool, or maybe just stupid.

But I can now attest to the tragic consequences of my stupidity, as can other members of the Zero in Wisconsin campaign. And that's why we agreed to participate in the campaign.

Simply put, we don't want others to join our fraternity--- to suffer the endless pain that comes from senselessly losing a loved one.

I spoke of that shared pain and our collective cry to fellow Wisconsinites

to be proactive in the campaign to reduce, if not eliminate vehicle fatalities at the press conference. I also used the opportunity to question the parenting skills and intelligence of Black Milwaukeeans who don't buckle-up, with a special emphasis on Black parents who don't employ seat belts or child restraints on their children.

Through my prism, the latter situation is nothing short of child abuse and neglect.

In Wisconsin, state law requires all drivers and passengers over the age of four to wear seatbelts. It is a 'primary enforcement law,' meaning police can pull you over for a seatbelt violation.

State law also requires children to be in a car seat until they reach the age of four and weigh 40 pounds, and in a booster seat until they reach age eight, and weigh more than 80 pounds, or more than four feet, nine inches tall.

Penalties run from \$175.30 if the child is less than four years of age and not in a car seat, \$150.10 (first offense) if the child is between ages four and eight. Second and third—or more—offenses carry fines of \$200.50 and \$263.50 respectively.

The first responsibility of parenting is to insure the safety of your child. And in this case, ignorance is no excuse.

Fifty-nine percent of drivers and passengers killed in car accidents were not wearing seat belts. That figure is needlessly higher in the Black community, where inconvenience and callousness share the driver's seat.

If an adult is dumb enough not to take a precaution it's one thing. But it is entirely a different matter when a parent fails to buckle-up their child. They should know better, and if they don't, society must protect the child.

I speak from experience, and I wish someone had hit me upside my head two decades ago.

Partly to atone for my stupidity, but also to spare others the burden I must now shoulder, I've asked Jason to develop legislation to include an enhancer in the seat belt statutes that would charge a neglectful parent with child neglect or abuse if they don't fulfill their parental obligation. I'm sure what I just wrote won't be met with unanimous applause in the Black community, but what else is new. It speaks volumes if my concern for someone's child is more impassioned than their own.

But before they get mad at me, access the video at ZeroInWisconsin.gov. Listen to the stories told by the 10 families who will spend the rest of our lives with regret, sadness, or in my case, guilt. If the video, statistics, or common sense isn't enough to persuade you to buckle-up, get a designated driver or a cab, or take precautions during bad weather, the zero in the campaign title apparently is an indication of your IQ. **Hotep.**

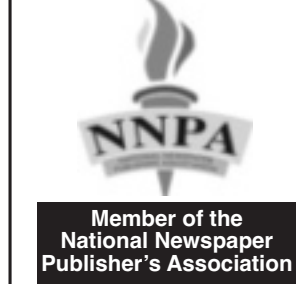
