## HOW DIGITAL SKILLS TRAINING

### can help end the cycles of addiction and incarceration!

At first glance, you likely wouldn't see Betty Hays as an outspoken advocate for some of the most overlooked populations in our nation. But you would be wrong.

She's actually a powerful agent of change for those facing addiction and other daunting struggles.

"When they come into the [recovery center], it might be their second or third time there, so they feel pretty beat down. They feel ostracized from everyone," said Hays.

"But, when they see someone not judging them, then they can actually believe that there's a possible future for them."

Hays is a Digital Literacy Trainer for the Connected Nation (CN)-led Digital Skills Training (DST) program.

She's one of several trainers who lead the free program, which is funded through a donation from AT&T, in communities across the country.

However, her approach is a little different than her counterparts who host the DST program inside places like city offices, community centers, churches, schools, and senior centers.

In addition to the typical locations, Hays spends much of her time in facilities like detention centers, recovery centers, and jails.

#### In recovery and in need of support

"I was in workforce development for almost 20 years in southeastern Kentucky," Hays explained. "My daughter, Ashley, worked in addiction recovery for five years, and she introduced me to the issue."

She has found those who sign up for the training at recovery centers are some of her most eager students.

"They are ready to change and willing to learn things," Hays said. "They seem to absorb the training like a sponge."

"They're excited and grateful because they're used to people looking away from them and saying 'no.' Even after treatment, it's really hard because everyone sees them as having a past."

The training is focused on essential digital skills. These include email and computer basics, internet safety (cybersecurity), creating a résumé, finding a job online,

and mobile phone basics — skills many of us take for granted.

"They're not learning these things organically like you or I because they're not part of the world as we know it," Hays said. "They haven't had a job or been around a computer."

Toronto based, Rob Deboer and Tony Grace released their first highly successful album in 1997 as Four80East. They have scored several Billboard top ten hits and continue to be a staple on contemporary jazz radio. Their stage show is a funky, jazzy, groovy party full of good vibes!

Plus, the winners of the Hometown All-Stars Showcase, a competition that highlights the best jazz acts in Milwaukee.

"Each year we aim to make the festival better, and I feel like we have done that again" said Carl Brown, chief executive officer of the Fresh Coast Jazz Festival. "This year's lineup features some of the legends of the genre and great shows from some of the most uniquely talented artists in music. It is a weekend of phenomenal music, awesome experiences and great fun!"

The 2025 Fresh Coast Jazz Festival also includes unique events such as "The Fresh Coast Cruise," a two-hour, lunch cruise with live jazz that allows attendees to explore Milwaukee's beautiful "fresh" coast while enjoying great food, cash bar and live jazz.

"The Paring," a wine tasting and concert event that this year pairs wines from the Napa Valley region with the music of the incredible Sade, is also returning.

The "Night Caps" are the festival's versions of the after-party, are free, and take place each night at the host hotel featuring a live jazz act each night along with food and bar service. The talent at each "Night Cap" usually consists of local jazz artists.

The festival also includes Q&A sessions with some of the jazz artists, held the Friday and Saturday mornings of the festival.

These Q&A events give area music students, music teachers and VIP patrons an opportunity to get up close and personal and ask questions of some of the world's top contemporary jazz artists.

In addition to bringing the best contemporary jazz to Milwaukee, the festival has had a significant philanthropic impact on the city.

"We have always been a party with a purpose," said Carl Brown. "The great music we bring to town is important but it's the philanthropic giving that feeds our souls and really makes Milwaukee a better place!"

Since its inception in 2019, the festival has:

- Supported college scholarships for 10 deserving area youth,
- Sent more than 75 disadvantaged kids to music camps,
- Provided hundreds of backpacks full of school supplies to Milwaukee area schools,
- Donated to financial literacy programs aimed at area youth,
- Provided 11 grants to support music programs at area schools,
- Donated to medical research initiatives aimed at mitigating the effects of chemotherapy and radiation treatment on childhood cancer patients,
- Partnered with the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music on an instrument donation drive that gets refurbished instruments to area kids that want to play but can't afford to purchase their own instruments,
- Produced two Concerts for The Kids at Children's

Wisconsin featuring some of the world-renowned artists playing the Fresh Coast Jazz Festival and provided hundreds of "gifts of comfort" to kids and families receiving treatment at Children's.

Initiated a program that gives area students real-world exposure to potential career opportunities at some Fresh Coast Jazz Festival sponsor companies.

"So, in our workshops, we talk through the reality of things as they are now — that if you're going to get a job, you must go online and that you need to get a professional email."

**Training behind bars, reducing recidivism**

Those who have spent time in jail and detention centers face many of the same learning challenges as her students in recovery centers, Hays said.

One thing she's learned over the years is that helping those who are or have been incarcerated gain skills that make them more employable directly reduces recidivism.

"I've heard from a few after they've gotten out of jail," she said. "There's hope because they understand that by learning some internet skills and résumé building, they have a chance at getting a job. They just need someone to believe in them and help them."

Hays says bringing the DST program into jails or detention

centers also helps the workers and administrators who keep them running. Mostly because they're often understaffed and really need support.

"The workshop participants can use the certificates they earn in the Digital Skills Training program to help with their probation," Hays said.

"In fact, parole officers and rehab centers often require parolees to take life skills classes, and these certificates show they're learning those essential skills. So, the program can help people once they're released. It's a win-win for everyone."

**Spreading the word, helping more people**

So far, Hays and her team, who are contractors for CN, have hosted 445 workshops training 6,297 people across five states — Alabama, Georgia, Illinois, Kentucky, and Ohio.

While she also teaches classes at more traditional facilities or job fairs, Hays said her heart is focused on those who are most often overlooked.

"I love doing this work," she said. "I had drug addiction in my own family with cousins, so I've seen how it can devastate a family as a whole."

"Being able to play some small part to help that person get back to a normal life is really touching and meaningful for me."

Hays added that other states and organizations could benefit from bringing the DST training program to their area.

"The population that needs this is growing," she said. "The positive impact of these digital skills workshops is incredible."

"You think, 'That's just an addict,' but that addict has children and a family, and a lot of people are affected by what's happening. Any time we can help that person, then that means we can help all the people that person associates with and the community as a whole."

# Trump's Economic Chaos is Driving up Costs for Wisconsinites

Donald Trump promised Americans he would lower prices, but just months into 2025, the economic chaos he's created has sent costs soaring as the stock market plummets, fueling fears of global recession.

Trump's tariffs are an attack on American families, with studies showing that households will suffer a loss of \$3,800 on average.

Here's how the economic chaos Trump is causing is affecting Wisconsinites.

Trump's tariffs will raise costs for Wisconsinites on everything from food to consumer goods to electricity bills.

Trump's tariffs will increase food costs by increasing transportation costs and fertilizer costs, as the majority of U.S. fertilizer is imported from Canada.

Economists predict that low-income households will bear the brunt of higher costs from tariffs, setting them back even further as large retailers like Target, Walmart, and Best Buy plan to increase their prices to compensate for higher costs.

Trump's tariffs will raise electricity costs by increasing the price of steel and aluminum needed for energy infrastructure like pipelines and transformers, which will likely lead utility companies to raise their rates for customers.

Since Trump took office, gas prices across the U.S. have risen by an average of 3.27%, or 10 cents/gallon.

Since Trump has taken office, gas prices in Wisconsin have risen by 6.58%. On January 19, 2025, gas prices in Wisconsin were \$2.932/gallon, and on April 1, 2025, gas prices were \$3.125/gallon.

As he sends costs skyrocketing, Trump laid off the entire staff of a critical federal program that helps low-income Americans pay their heating and cooling bills.

In fiscal year 2023, Wisconsin received more than \$164 million in LIHEAP funding, which served 189,941 households.

That includes 186,017 households receiving heating assistance with reported average benefits of \$696 per household, and 25,050 households receiving year-round crisis assistance with reported average benefits of \$701.

In FY2024, Wisconsin's LIHEAP received \$111,304,914 in LIHEAP funding.

If Trump really cared about bringing back American manufacturing, he would be investing in clean energy. Instead, Wisconsinites are paying the price for the economic chaos Trump is creating—at the pump, at the grocery store, and on their utility bills.

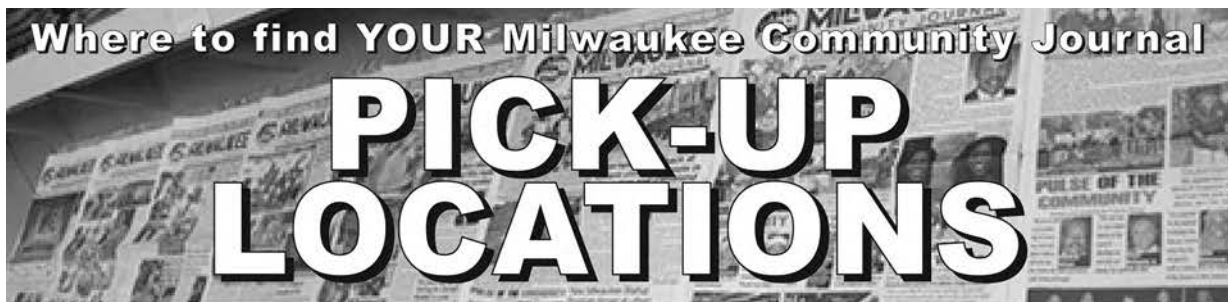

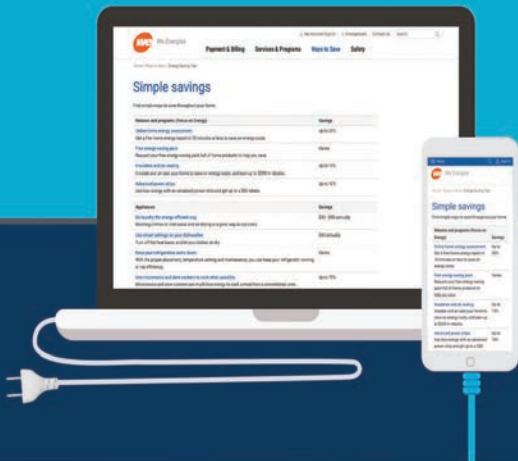
