Black female WWII unit 'Six Triple Eight' gets Congressional Gold Medal

The "Six Triple Eight," the only Black, all-female unit that served in Europe during World War II, has been awarded a Congressional Gold Medal.

On Tuesday (April 29), the 668th Central Postal Directory Battalion, commonly known as the "Six Triple Eight," received the Congressional Gold Medal at the United States Capitol, ABC News reports.

Speaker Mike Johnson (R) presented Congress' highest civilian honor to the family of the unit commander, Lt. Col. Charity Adams Earley. More than 300 descendants and family members of the Six Triple Eight unit attended the ceremony.

"This remarkable story has brightly captured imaginations, it has now inspired books and movies, stirred the consciousness of millions of Americans, who are just now hearing and sharing this incredible story," Johnson said.

During their service in the 1940s, the 855-member battalion handled a backlog of roughly 17 million pieces of mail in three months before serving in France and returning to the U.S.

The medal comes after years of advocacy for the overlooked battalion, which paved the way for Black women in the military. During the Biden administration, Congress voted unanimously to award the Six Triple Eight with the honor.

During his speech at Tuesday's ceremony, House Democratic Leader Hakeem Jeffries highlighted the importance of the bipartisan celebration in the wake of today's political climate.

"We gather here today to salute these mighty veterans. We salute the ingenuity with which they sprang into battle," Jeffries said. "We salute the barriers that they broke in the system designed to push them aside. We salute their trailblazing spirit and the road that they paved for others."



With Wisconsin student homelessness at new high, state superintendent urges reinstatement of critical support withdrawn by feds

New report shows student homelessness increased 9.1 percent across state

MADISON — State Superintendent Dr. Jill Underly today called on the U.S. Department of Education to reinstate vital funding that supports Wisconsin students experiencing homelessness.

Her message follows a new Wisconsin Policy Forum report showing student homelessness has reached an all-time high – with 20,195 students identified as homeless during the 2023-24 school

year, a 9.1 percent increase from the previous year.

The surge in student homelessness comes as Wisconsin faces a loss of approximately \$500,000 in federal funding used to provide essential support services to students experiencing homelessness.

“Every student deserves more than a desk in a classroom — they deserve the safety of a home

“When the federal government withdraws critical support to homeless students during a growing crisis, we’re failing our most vulnerable children.

“I urge the U.S. Department of Education to approve our extension request so we can continue providing the essential services these students and families rely on — they cannot afford to wait.”

In March, USDE Secretary Linda McMahon informed states that the USDE was revoking previously approved extensions for pandemic-era funding, including an extension that Wisconsin had to provide statewide support to students experiencing homelessness.

Students experiencing homelessness are not recovering academically from the pandemic as fast as their peers, according to data, and this funding is an important part of Wisconsin’s plan to address the issue.

The DPI, in partnership with the Wisconsin Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, had been leveraging American Rescue Plan – Homeless Children and Youth Administrative Funds to provide wraparound services to homeless students, including case management and family support.

The DPI has formally requested another extension from the USDE but has yet to receive a response.

Why sitting down – and getting back up – might be the most important health test you do today

If you or someone you love finds it difficult to stand up from the toilet without using your hands, it might seem like a small issue. But in health and ageing, this movement – known as the “sit-to-stand” – can be a red flag. It’s one of the strongest indicators of frailty, a condition that can threaten independence and quality of life.

Frailty increases the risk of falls, hospital stays, slower recovery from illness, and early death. It’s more than just about being thin or weak – it’s about reduced muscle mass, strength and energy – and it’s one of the main reasons older adults lose the ability to live on their own.

This loss of muscle strength and function isn’t just about growing old. It often begins as early as your 30s and accelerates after 60. The good news? It’s not inevitable. Frailty can be prevented – and even reversed – with simple, targeted changes in diet and physical activity.

Surprisingly, carrying a bit of extra weight in older age can be beneficial.

Studies suggest that being in the “overweight” BMI range is often linked to better outcomes than being underweight – as long as you’re carrying muscle, not just fat.

What matters most is body composition – the ratio of muscle to fat. Lean muscle supports mobility, balance and resilience during illness or injury. In contrast, excess visceral fat (around the internal organs) increases the risk of disease.

Muscle is made of protein and, as we age, our bodies become less efficient at using it. That means older adults need to eat more protein than younger people – not less. Aim for 1 to 1.2 grams of protein per kilogram of body weight per day. For a 70kg person, that’s around 70–85 grams daily, ideally spread across all meals.

Good protein sources include:

- Eggs, milk, cheese and yoghurt
- Chicken, turkey, beef and oily fish

- Lentils, beans, tofu and soy products
- Nuts, seeds, and whole grains

Also, don't forget total calorie intake. If you're undereating overall – especially during illness – your body will break down muscle to compensate, even if protein intake is adequate.

Move it or lose it

Muscle only stays if you use it – the “move it or lose it” mantra applies here.

Regular strength training is one of the best things you can do to stay independent and strong.

Aim for two to three sessions per week focused on strength. You don't need a gym – body-

weight exercises at home count too.

Effective strength activities include:

- Sit-to-stand repetitions from a chair
- Functional movements like stair climbing, gardening, or carrying groceries
- Squats, lunges and push-ups
- Using resistance bands or light weights

Walking, swimming and cycling are great for cardiovascular and joint health, but they aren't enough on their own to maintain muscle mass. Challenge your muscles regularly – even in small ways.

Things to watch out for:

- Struggling to stand up from

low chairs or the toilet

- Clothes feeling looser around the thighs or arms
- Feeling weaker carrying bags or household items
- Avoiding stairs or certain movements you used to do easily

Catching these signs early can help you act before it affects your independence.

Here are five things you can do for healthy ageing

Prioritise protein: include it in every meal. Think eggs for breakfast, beans at lunch, and fish or chicken for dinner.

Strength train weekly: find something you enjoy and can stick with – gardening, resistance bands, or a local class.

Don't fear healthy weight gain: especially if you've recently lost weight unintentionally. Focus on building muscle, not fat.

Stay active daily: every movement counts – walking, stretching, or lifting household objects.

Monitor your function: the sit-to-stand test is a simple way to track your strength. If it's getting harder, take action.

We can't stop ageing, but we can age well.

That means making muscle health a priority – not just for appearance, but for independence, dignity and quality of life.

So, whether you're thinking about your future or supporting an older loved one, remember this: building and maintaining

muscle is one of the most powerful tools we have for healthy ageing.

With the right habits, you can protect your strength, mobility and independence.

And next time you sit down – think about how easily you get back up.
