Noted community minister, Rev. Dr. Trinette McCray dies at 71

Rev. Dr. Trinette Vernell McCray, 71, peacefully passed away on Ascension Day, May 29. A Milwaukee native, McCray was a trailblazing minister, educator, and advocate whose life was marked by faith, service, and justice.

Rev. Dr. McCray earned her B.A. from UW-Oshkosh and a Master's in Religious Education from the Morehouse School of Religion, where she was ordained in 1981.

She later received a Doctor of Ministry from Northern Baptist Theological Seminary and an honorary Doctor of Divinity in 2021. Influenced by Black liberation and womanist theology, she was a pioneer in both church and academic spaces.

She made history as the first clergywoman President of American Baptist Churches USA (2000-2001) and served in numerous national and local leadership roles. Her ministry extended to education, social justice, and public theology through her work at Cardinal Stritch University and the Urban Center-Milwaukee. An author, vocalist, and spiritual leader, she wrote **Vital Spirit, Vital Service**.

A cancer survivor of 11 years, she used her journey to minister to others, becoming a Certified Cancer Care Ministry Trainer. She was also a proud member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, and a cherished aunt, godmother, and mentor to many.

She is preceded in death by her parents, James and Ruth McCray, and her brother, Arnold. She is survived by her sister Linda A. Brantley, nieces, nephews, extended family, and a devoted circle of friends and mentees.

Her legacy is summed up in her words: "Ministry is life and ministry is service."

We give thanks for the remarkable life of Rev. Dr. Trinette V. McCray.

County Executive Crowley, Chairwoman Nicholson Accept Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Culture of Health Prize Award

Milwaukee County Executive David Crowley and Milwaukee County Board Chairwoman Marcelia Nicholson recently accepted the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Culture of Health Prize, a prestigious national honor recognizing communities at the forefront of advancing health, opportunity, and equity for all.

Milwaukee County was one of nine communities across the country who received the recognition this year.

The \$250,000 award celebrates the County's ambitious vision to become the healthiest county in Wisconsin and acknowledges its focus on racial equity as a strategy to improve health outcomes.

"Our community's recognition as a Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Culture of Health Prize recip-

ient is a powerful reminder that the work we're doing matters. It's delivering results and making a real difference for residents, families, and children across Milwaukee County," said County Executive Crowley. "Through partnerships with national philanthropic leaders like the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, we're deepening our commitment to addressing systemic disparities and driving meaningful, lasting change. Milwaukee County

is honored to accept this award on behalf of every resident working toward a more equitable, healthier future for our community."

"This award is a profound honor and a testament to what is possible when we center health, equity, and justice in all that we do," said Chairwoman Nicholson.

MILWAUKEEANS SAY FINANCIAL UNCERTAINTY HARMING THEIR PHYSICAL, MENTAL WELLBEING

According to Northwestern Mutual 2025 Planning & Progress Study, finances are fueling depression, anxiety, sleepless nights and relationship issues —often exceeding national averages

Financial uncertainty is having a significant impact on the wellbeing of Milwaukeeans.

From sleep quality and mental health to personal relationships and job performance, money is weighing heavily on their minds and their bodies.

These are some of the latest findings from Northwestern Mutual's 2025 Planning & Progress Study, the company's proprietary research series that explores the attitudes, behaviors, and perspectives of Milwaukee-area residents across a broad set of issues impacting their long-term financial security.

Feelings and emotions about money are showing up in their day-to-day lives in many ways:

• **Depression and anxiety:** More than

three in four (76%) in Milwaukee say that financial uncertainty has made them feel depressed and anxious, more than the national average of 69%.

• **Sleepless nights:** Meanwhile, nearly two in three (65%) Milwaukeeans say money worries have kept them up at night, exceeding the national average of 63%.

• **Anxiety creating issues:** Nearly two-thirds of those in Milwaukee who are married or living with their partner (65%) say that financial uncertainty has impacted their relationship with their spouse or partner, more than the national average of 57%.

• **Sidetracking social events and job performance:** More than half (57%) in Milwaukee say their financial concerns have caused them to miss out on a social event, higher than the national average of 55%.

Meanwhile, more than half (51%) say their worries about money have affected

Age-Friendly Communities Initiatives: Continued partnership as part of the AARP Network of Age-Friendly Communities.

Milwaukee Parks Foundation: Administering fiscal agent administrative fee.

Alderwoman Coggs said she is looking forward to the young men and women being ready and eager to be a part of the project again, and is hopeful that donors will

once again step up and provide the support that helps generate the positive reward for the work the young people complete.

"We Got This provides each participant with a landscaping or cleanup assignment in their neighborhood and a small amount of money is paid to each for their work," Alderwoman Coggs said.

"We are so grateful for the initiative, which over the years has given many youth the opportunity to build a good work ethic and has kept many on a positive path."

Motivated by concern for neighborhood boys surrounded by drugs, violence and a degree of hopelessness, community mentor and leader Andre Lee Ellis started We Got This in the summer of 2014 with the support of countless community stakeholders.

Last year, young people gave more than 3,000 hours of service to their community through the Saturday morning program, planting and beauti-

fying formerly vacant lots. We Got This provided \$30,000 to youth for their hard work making the neighborhood a better place to grow up.

This year, there's even more capacity to support and reward young people for their contributions.

A \$20 donation provides work for one young person on one Saturday, and a \$240 donation supports one youth for the entire summer.

their job performance, exceeding the national average of 49%.

• **Feeling sick:** More than four in 10 (42%) in Milwaukee say that financial worries have made them feel physically ill, higher than the national average of 40%.

“Individuals in our community have made it clear that financial uncertainty is affecting their everyday responsibilities and lives,” said Matthew Grube, Managing Director of Northwestern Mutual – Mequon District Office. “Financial insecurity can weigh you down, leaving you disconnected from the parts of your life that

matter the most.”

Finances outrank physical health and mental health as greatest weakness

As part of the study, Milwaukeeans were asked to describe how “strong” or “weak” they feel about various aspects of their personal lives.

More than half (53%) in Milwaukee label their finances as “weak” – a sum that significantly outpaced shaky feelings about their mental health (32%), physical health (28%), friendships (28%), their relationships with family (26%) or job stability (22%).

“The survey revealed that over

half of all Milwaukeeans lack confidence in their financial situation – an issue that our community and financial industry need to address,” said Grube.

“Working with a trusted financial professional can significantly boost financial confidence levels, offering a clear plan and actionable steps that can help individuals feel more secure and prepared for the future.”

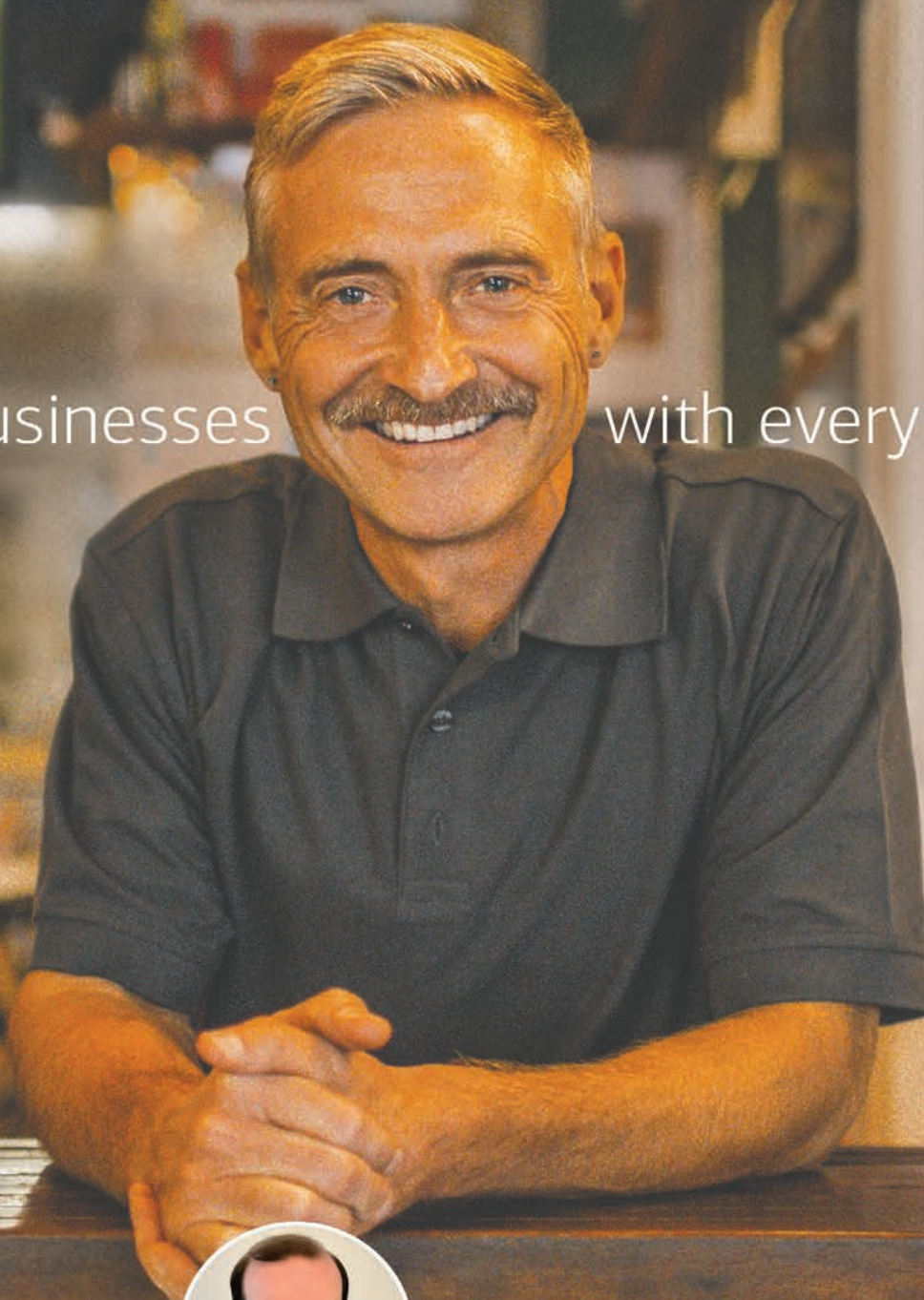
