

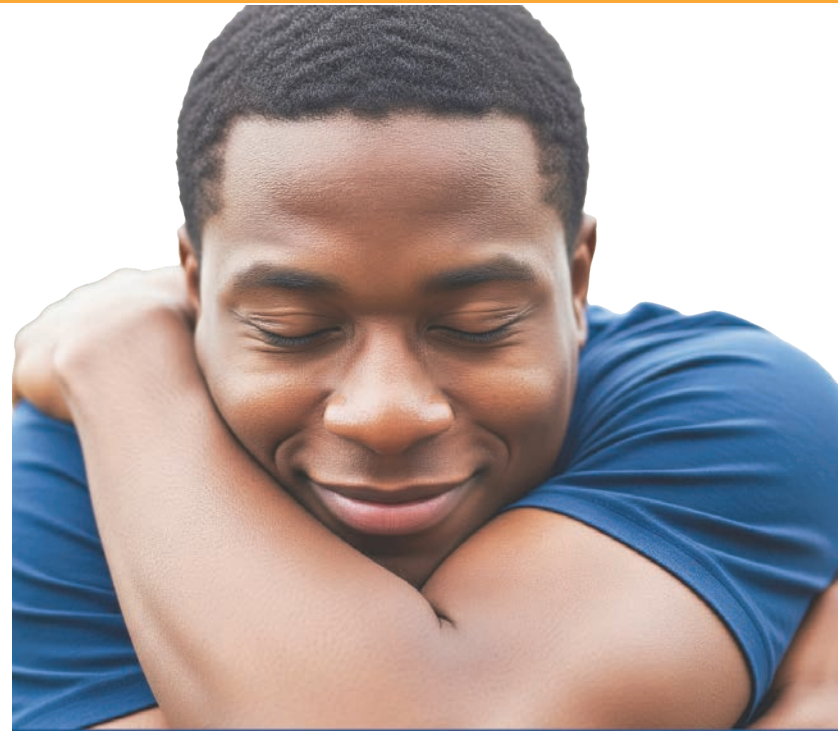

## THE UNSPOKEN BURDEN OF BLACK MEN: HEALING FATHER WOUNDS

Father wounds are an unfortunate reality for many, and the impact can be particularly complex for Black men. The absence or emotional unavailability of a father figure can leave deep scars, affecting relationships, self-esteem, and overall well-being.

This article aims to explore the unique challenges Black men face in healing father wounds and offer pathways toward recovery and growth.

### The Unspoken Burden: Father Wounds in the Black Community

For Black men, father wounds are often compounded by systemic issues such as racial discrimination, economic hardship, and the legacy of slavery, which have historically disrupted Black family structures.

The "strong Black man" stereotype can also make it difficult to acknowledge vulnerability and seek help, leading to a silent struggle with emotional pain.

### The absence of a father can manifest in various ways:

**Difficulty with emotional expression:** Suppressing emotions can lead to anger issues, depression, and anxiety.

**Relationship struggles:** Trust issues, fear of abandonment, and difficulty forming healthy attachments are common.

**Identity confusion:** Without a father figure, Black men may struggle with their sense of self and their place in the world.

**Intergenerational trauma:** Unresolved father wounds can be passed down through generations, perpetuating a cycle of pain.

In the billion-dollar business of sports, there's no image more quietly threatening to the system than a strong, involved Black father.

We see it time and time again. Lavar Ball is called arrogant. Deion Sanders is called selfish. Richard Williams was labeled crazy long before the world knew the names Venus and Serena.

LeBron James is somehow criticized for supporting his son Bronny too publicly.

Earl Woods was portrayed as a controlling figure even as he raised one of the greatest

golfers the world has ever seen.

Cecil Newton Sr. faced public scrutiny simply for advocating for his son, Cam.

The blueprint is clear: when a Black father stands at the center of his child's success — guiding, protecting, pushing back against exploitation — the media paints him as a problem.

As an egomaniac.

As someone "getting in the way."

Why?

Because strong Black fathers disrupt the narrative.

The system isn't just invested in the talent of Black athletes — it's invested in controlling them.

A young Black athlete without guidance is

 easier to manipulate. Easier to underpay. Easier to pit against others. Easier to brand, profit from, and discard when convenient.  
 A strong Black father changes the terms of the deal.  
 He demands better contracts.  
 He questions coaching decisions.  
 He protects his child's mental health over the franchise's bottom line.  
 He reminds the world that his son or daughter is not just an asset — but a human being with a family, dreams,

and dignity.  
 And that's where the real fear lies.  
 The image of a united Black family — not fractured, not absent, not broken — challenges deeply rooted stereotypes that American society has long relied on to justify inequity.  
 A strong Black man standing beside his child and saying "No, you won't exploit them" is seen not as an act of love, but as an act of rebellion.  
 It's easier to villainize the father than to admit that the system is designed to exploit athletes while they're young,

impressionable, and isolated.  
 It's easier to mock than to confront the truth:  
 That Black families who stick together, support each other, and advocate fiercely for their own are an unstoppable force — not a threat.  
 When Deion Sanders tells his sons they are kings, not commodities, it unsettles the old order.  
 When Richard Williams insists his daughters are bigger than tennis, it rewrites the rules.  
 When Lavar Ball dreams out loud for his sons, it terrifies a system that prefers

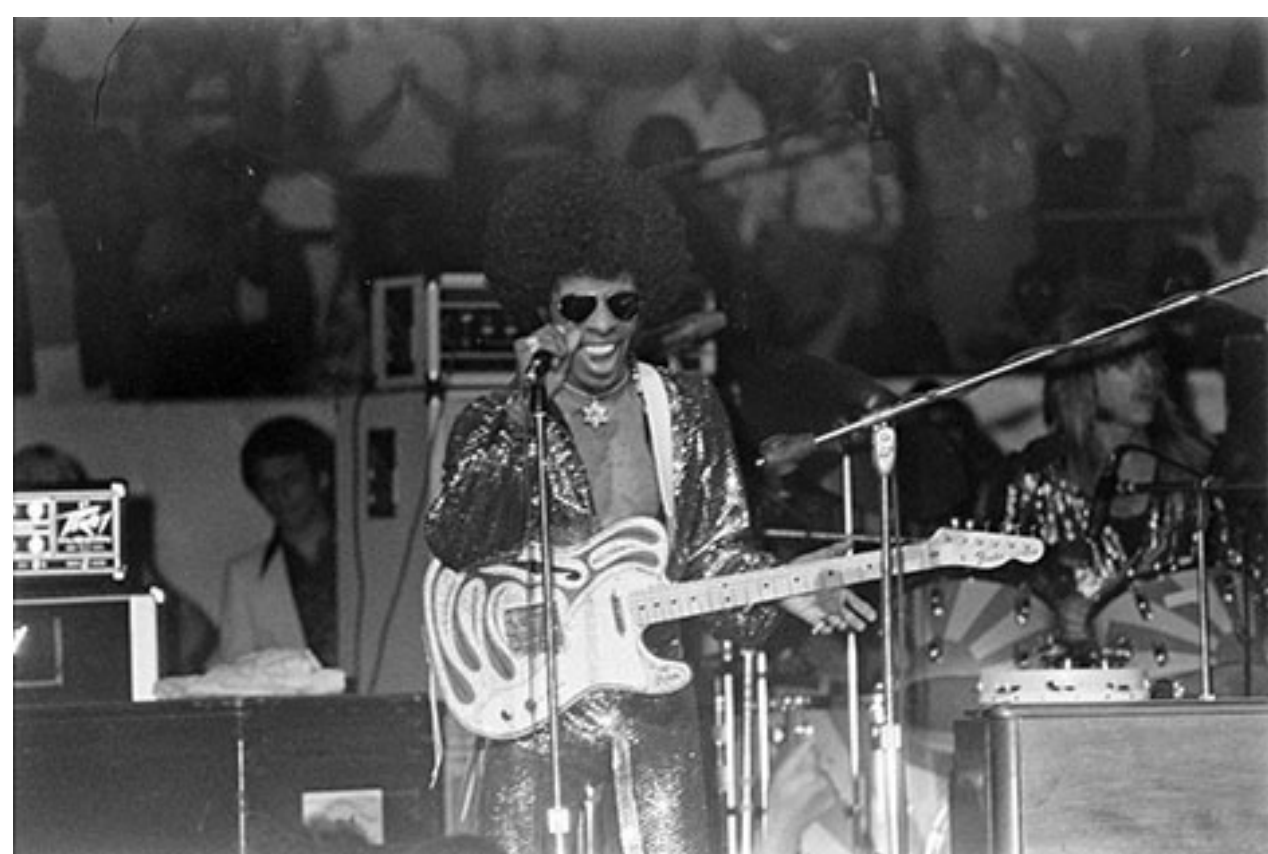
Black athletes to be grateful and quiet.  
 But let's be clear:  
 It's not their confidence that threatens the sports industry.  
 It's their love.  
 It's their refusal to let their children be used up and tossed aside.  
 It's their audacity to believe they deserve a seat at the table — and to pull up a chair without asking permission.  
 Black fathers in sports aren't villains.  
 They're architects.  
 They're protectors.  
 They are the shield be-

tween billion-dollar industries and the children they would otherwise consume.

# SLY STONE, MUSIC VISIONARY AND SLY AND THE FAMILY STONE FRONTMAN, PASSES AWAY AT 82

The world of music has lost a pioneer.  
 Sly Stone, the mastermind behind the groundbreaking Sly and the Family Stone, passed away at the age of 82 after a prolonged battle with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and other health issues.  
 Known for pushing the boundaries of funk, soul, and rock, Sly's legacy extends far beyond his chart-

topping hits.  
 Sly and the Family Stone redefined music in the late '60s and early '70s with their vibrant fusion of genres.  
 Their music blended the energy of rock, the groove of funk, and the soul of R&B, all while championing messages of unity and hope.  
 Hits like "Dance to the Music," "Everyday People," and "Thank You (Falettinme Be Mice Elf Agin)" became anthems of solidarity, challenging socioeconomic and

**Forgiveness (for Self**

This includes forgiving your father, if possible, and more importantly, forgiving yourself for any perceived shortcomings or ways you've coped with the pain.

**Build Your Own Legacy:** Focus on creating the kind of fatherhood you wish you had experienced. If you are a father, strive to be present, emotionally available, and a positive role model for your children.

If you're not a father, channel your healing into mentor-

ing, community involvement, or building strong, healthy relationships.

**Embrace Self-Care:** Prioritize your mental, emotional, and physical well-being. This includes exercise, mindfulness, creative expression, and spending time in nature.

Healing father wounds is a profound act of self-love and liberation. It's an opportunity to break cycles of pain and build a future rooted in strength, authenticity, and emotional well-being.

### Ananda Lewis

## Remembered for Power, Purpose, and Grace

Tributes have continued to pour in for Ananda Lewis, the former MTV VJ and host of BET's Teen Summit, one day after her death at the age of 52. Donnie Simpson, the legendary BET host and radio DJ, shared his heartbreak.

"I just found out that Ananda Lewis has died and I'm absolutely brokenhearted," Simpson said. "She had tremendous success at MTV and with her own talk show, but she worked with us at BET before all that.

She was only 52 and such a lovely woman, who loved her young son so much."

Actress Holly Robinson Peete paid her respects on X, writing, "Rest well, beautiful Ananda." DJ Syndicated Sam added, "Ananda Lewis, you are forever an icon. Sending love to her family & friends in this season of bereavement."

Known for her powerful presence on television, Lewis brought intellect, compassion, and charisma to every platform she graced.

A native of San Diego, California, she began making an impact as early as 13 when she volunteered with Head Start while attending the San Diego School of Creative and Performing Arts.

She studied theater, vocal music, photography, and dance from the fourth grade through high school.

After graduating, Lewis attended Howard University in Washington, D.C., where she earned a degree in history, graduating cum laude in 1995.

She spent her college years deeply engaged in youth activism, including volunteering with Youth at Risk and working with the Youth Leadership and Development Institute to train young people in leadership, conflict resolution, and parenting.

Her commitment to empowering youth ultimately led her to television. With the encouragement of teenagers she mentored, Lewis auditioned for BET's Teen Summit and became its host.

Her on-screen chemistry with co-host DaJour and her earnest engagement with issues affecting young people helped the show earn an NAACP Image Award in 1997 and a nomination for a Cable ACE Award in 1996.

In 1997, Lewis made the leap to MTV. While the move meant leaving a show that was deeply personal, she recognized the opportunity to reach broader audiences. "I saw MTV not only as access to the masses but also as an opportunity to be more of the woman I am," Lewis said.

She went on to host The Ananda Lewis Show, a daytime talk show that debuted in 2001 and further solidified her place as a voice of insight and authenticity in media.

Throughout her career, she remained focused on empowerment and advocacy, often working to uplift others even when the spotlight was no longer on her.

Lewis is survived by her son, who is a constant source of love and pride.
