Top Ladies of Distinction Host 61st Founders' Day!

Women from the Chicago Chapters and the Milwaukee Chapter were inducted into Top Ladies of Distinction, Inc. before the Founders' Day Luncheon.

Founders' Day Luncheon Chairman Lady Yolanda S. Wilson of Milwaukee Chapter presided over the luncheon.

The Founders' Day processional of Honorees and Officer were introduced by Lady Monica Payne of Milwaukee Chapter.

Lady Erica Harris Day, 1st vice president of Milwaukee chapter, read a proclamation by Milwaukee's Mayor Cavalier Johnson. Rededication to TLOD was



presided over by the National Area III Director Lady Vynessa Alexander. The luncheon speaker was Lady Cherise Easley of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, Past Top Teens of America National President. She is the National Senior Citizens chair.

NAACP Won't Invite President To Nat'l Convention For 1st Time In 116-Year History... And We All Know Why

For more than a century — 115 years to be exact — the person who holds the office of president of the United States has been invited to the NAACP's national convention.

That tradition has been put on pause for the first time, as President Donald Trump has been disinvented to the proverbial cookout due largely to his second administration's aversion to all things related to Black people and civil rights.

According to the Associated Press, NAACP President Der-

rick Johnson announced during a press conference Monday that Trump won't be in attendance at the convention, which will take place next month in Charlotte, North Carolina.

"This has nothing to do with political party," Johnson said. "Our mission is to advance civil rights, and the current president has made clear that his mission is to eliminate civil rights."

Johnson is not wrong. In the last few months alone, Trump has made housing discrimination easier by signing an executive order to eliminate the federal government's use of "disparate impact" data that shows racist renters and mort-

gage lenders disproportionately harm Black people; he signed a similar order discouraging school administrators from using "disparate impact" data to

address racial disparities in disciplinary actions taken against students, labeling it a DEI practice; his Department of Education launched an investigation into Chicago Public Schools over its "Black Students Suc-

cess" program; his Justice Department ended a wastewater settlement for a mostly Black Alabama town, falsely calling it "environmental justice as viewed through a distorting, DEI lens," simply because environmental racism was addressed in the reaching of the settlement; he announced the restoration of names given to military bases to honor the Confederacy, and Trump's DOJ has upended police reform initiatives by withdrawing consent decrees, and ending Biden-era police-accountability agreements with Minneapolis and Louisville, Ky., that came as a result of extensive investigations following the police killings of Floyd and Breonna Taylor.

From Trump's propaganda-laced war against DEI to the Jan. 6 instigators' hypocritical hate for Black Lives Matter, Trump has made it abundantly clear that he's not interested in

withholding federal money for schools that did not end their DEI programs, one of multiple lawsuits it filed against the Trump administration.

Anyway, Trump has to be feeling a little lonely at this point. Fresh off his public breakup with Elon Musk, he witnessed the largest mass protest against a single president unfold across all 50 states while his birthday military parade, which he tried to sell as a celebration of the U.S. Army's 250th anniversary parade, was sparsely attended compared to what was expected (and we know how defensive he gets about his crowd sizes).

Nineteen states have also sued him over his anti-DEI agenda, and he's been sued by 12 state attorney generals over his disastrous tariff strategy.

On top of all that, Trump's approval ratings continue to plummet after he achieved the lowest 100-day mark approval

rating of any president in history.

Maybe the man is just a bad person who is bad at his job — and that's why he has no friends outside of his MAGA cult.

Survey: Most biz execs feel DEI is necessary to avoid law suits! Article by Joe Jurado, courtesy of newsone.com

Since taking office in January, President Trump has made eliminating diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) in all facets of American life one of his key goals. While he's been relatively successful in getting colleges and universities to bend the knee, it's been a more complicated situation when it comes to American businesses. A recent survey has potentially revealed the reason for that, as many business leaders believe removing DEI initiatives opens them up to legal risk.

According to Fortune, a joint survey of 1,000 C-suite executives revealed that 83 percent believe DEI initiatives are necessary for their company's well-being. Another 68 percent believed removing them would open them up to potential discrimination lawsuits. The survey also interviewed 2,500 employees and found that 76 percent of respondents would stay at a company that maintained its DEI initiatives, and 43 percent would leave a company if they pulled back. The survey was conducted by Catalyst, a non-profit focused on women's inclusion in the workplace, and NYU School of Law's Meltzer Center for Diversity, Inclusion, and Belonging.

"Opting out of DEI is not a neutral act—it's a choice with consequences," Christina Joseph, project director of the Advancing DEI Initiative at the Meltzer Center, told Fortune. "That's because these programs help root out harmful policies that especially affect marginalized groups. This report reminds us that without those safeguards, organizations face more, not less, legal exposure."

This survey only proves what we've already seen: the average person either supports or, at the very least, isn't actively opposed to DEI initiatives. In fact, another recent poll shows that companies that keep their DEI initiatives are viewed more favorably by the public. The only people upset about DEI are people who can't compete on an even playing field, or keeping it a buck, are just straight up racist.

To some degree, it makes sense why we're seeing universities withdraw from their DEI initiatives. Many of them depend on federal funds to survive, so while they may not necessarily agree with the pullback, they don't really have a choice. Especially considering that the Department of Education (DOE) has been explicitly weaponized to go after any university it believes is trying to provide equitable opportunities for Black, brown, and LGBTQ students.

To be clear, I'm not advocating or being an apologist for these moves; I simply understand why they're happening.

Conversely, it doesn't make much sense for businesses to engage in this pullback as they don't depend on federal funds, and it's unclear what, if any, legal action the Trump administration could take against a company for continuing DEI initiatives. Apple announced that they would continue their DEI initiatives, and all the president did was angrily post about it on Truth Social.

I'm not a legal scholar, but thankfully, Catalyst's poll also included corporate lawyers. A vast majority, 88 percent to be precise, believed that DEI initiatives were essential to avoiding legal risk. So

it seems like companies have more to lose by pulling back from DEI than continuing forward.

We've seen the opposing approach to DEI initiatives play out in the marketplace this year. Target has been the, uh, target of several boycotts this year as a result of withdrawing from their DEI initiatives as soon as they thought it was politically expedient. This has resulted in foot traffic being down in the stores and the company reporting a drop in first-quarter sales. Target's woes are so pronounced that several companies have started listing consumer boycotts as a potential financial risk in investor reports.

On the other end of the equation is Costco, which has stood firm on its commitments to DEI and actually beat its sales expectations for the first quarter. Whether it comes to employees, executives, lawyers, or consumers, it appears the majority are in agreement: DEI works for everybody.

Now, if only someone could get that message through to the weirdos running the country right now.
