Black male educators create powerful change at MKE school

Milwaukee Academy of Science has doubled its number of Black male educators, creating a powerful impact on students' lives and future aspirations.

Inside the halls of Milwaukee Academy of Science (MAS), a quiet revolution is underway. The school has doubled the number of Black male educators, and students are feeling the positive effects of this representation in their classrooms.

"You see somebody who grew up in the same area as you, same problems and struggles—if they can get through it, you can

Milwaukee's own Hip Hop superstar, Speech, grew up writing about teenage music and big entertainer dreams.

He sweated circulating MCJ newspapers door to door throughout the Central City asking his 'bros' to join him as they went door to door throwing the newspaper upon the porches with his daddy, Robert Thomas, driving the truck and watching every kid.

Most of Speech's 'besties' were children he knew who attended Summer Fun day camps sponsored by the Northside YMC A, or billiard players at the old Ebony Que.

Speech is a poppa himself to two (albeit grown) children today; thinking about the years, how quickly the time has flown—yet how challenging the times are today!

ABOUT THE ALBUM: Released on Independence Day, 'Adult Contemporary Hip Hop' is both a celebration and a challenge — reflecting on freedom, self-determination, and the contradictions still woven into Black American life.

Dedicated to the late Twan Mack, the album takes its title from a mantra he lived by — and transforms it into a bold, grown, and deeply soulful statement.

This marks the fourth consecutive Arrested Development project co-executive produced by Speech and UK boom-bap specialist Configa, continuing a creative partnership that has helped shape the group's modern resurgence.

This time, the album features very few outside influences — the focus being on the AD family: Frontman Speech, 1Love, Tasha LaRae, and Fareedah, with extended kin Ke'Andra and Bee Taylor. Music production is led by Speech and Configa, with additional contributions from MRK SX and Ben Marc.

The album was engineered by Speech, Configa, and JJ Boogie, capturing a cohesive, soulful sound rooted in classic hip-hop aesthetics. Cover artwork was done by Maria Pokrovskaya.

(continued from cover page) too," said Jason Reeves, a recent MAS graduate.

Reeves says the mentorship he received from Black male educators inspired him to begin exploring options to become a teacher himself.

"So we have someone to look up to as we're trying to get to the path we wanna make it to," Reeves said.

This growing representation is creating powerful change both inside and outside the classroom, with school leaders focusing on more than just filling positions—they're inspiring futures.

"We all know, often times kids don't get exposed to certain careers—so having a Black male teacher tells every Black male in that classroom, 'I too can be a teacher,'" said Tony McHenry, MAS CEO.

The push stems from a partnership with Profound Gentlemen, helping MAS retain educators of color. It also sparked a Men of Color Affinity Group, where teachers find support and community.

"Anyone who identifies as a male teacher of color—we come together on a monthly basis to talk, be true, be raw. It's not about being who the job calls you to be," said Orlando Verdecia, Assistant Principal.

For MAS teacher Brandon Watkins, this work hits home on a personal level.

"I see some of the trauma

they've been through... I see resistance toward male authority figures... I see a lot," Watkins said.

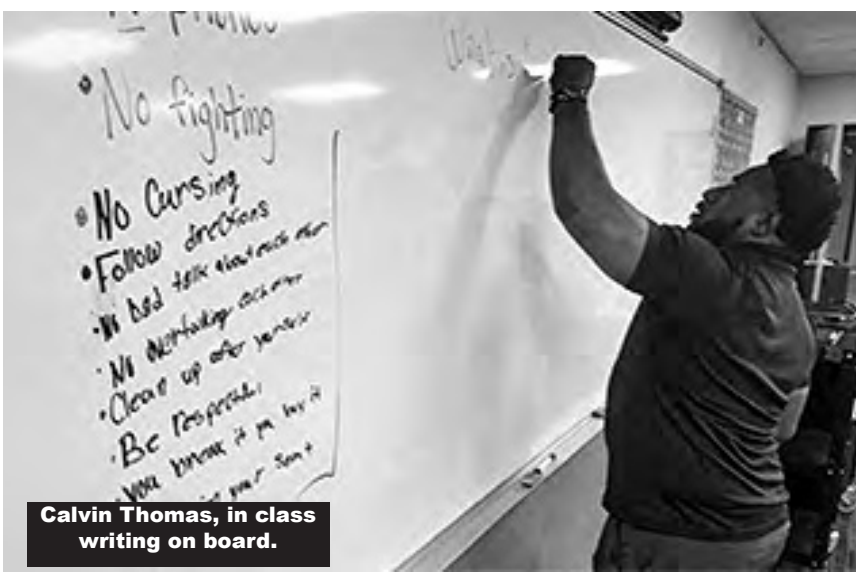

It's more than just good optics—it's about building a future. MAS hopes efforts like this will continue to attract more talent that represents their student population.

When asked how the community can help with their mission, McHenry emphasized the importance of spreading awareness.

"Spread the word about the need for high-quality teachers. Whether they're Black, white, or brown, they deserve the support to have a tremendous impact on young people—and enjoy the work they're doing," McHenry said.

MAS leaders say they're ac-

tively recruiting for the next school year and looking to bring in even more Black male educators.

Because for them, it's not just about staffing—it's about changing the game for stu-

dents like Jason.

"They helped me stay on the right track—a lot," Reeves said.

At 18,000 square feet, the new Martin Luther King library is the third largest branch in the Milwaukee

Public Library system, offering expanded resources and reimagined spaces for all ages.

The design emphasizes community engagement, creative exploration, and environmental sustainability, with several key features:

A fully equipped maker-space, including 3D printing, podcasting equipment, and other up-to-date technology to support creativity, innovation, and digital literacy.

A large community room designed to host neighbor-

hood meetings, programs, and cultural events, reinforcing the library's role as a civic gathering space.

Green building features, including solar panels, geothermal heating and cooling, and infrastructure for future electric vehicle charging stations.

'Time to recruit some churches': Experts blast new rules on pulpit politics

The Internal Revenue Service promulgated a set of new rules on Monday that allow churches to endorse and donate to political candidates, The New York Times reported on Monday.

The new rules were created at a time when religion had slowly become a staple in American politics. President Donald Trump has surrounded himself with religious figures to appeal to his Evangelical base, including hiring a spiritual advisor for the White House. They could also play a part in the 2026 midterm elections.

"It basically tells churches of all denominations and sects that you're free to support candidates from the pulpit," Lloyd Hitoshi Mayer, a law professor at the University of Notre Dame, told the NYT. "It also says to all candidates and parties, 'Hey, time to recruit some churches.'"
