*Marrying Kathy is the greatest accomplishment of my life because it gave me a lifetime with her, three amazing kids, and nine incredible grandkids. For five decades, my family has sacrificed to give me the gift of service. They're my world. And I owe it to them to focus on doing all the things we enjoy and love doing together.*

*It's why, Wisconsin, I'm announcing that I will not be running for a third term.*

*I'm so humbled to be your governor. This is the best job I've ever had. And folks, we are not done yet.*

*There is, as always, much work to do. And, Wisconsin, I'll be working just as hard as I have for the last six years to keep doing the right thing and deliver for you.*

*So, let's get back to work. Forward, for you and for Wisconsin, always.*

On September 23rd, County Supervisor Jack Eckblad joined County Executive Crowley to present a citation to the Wisconsin Muslim Civic Foundation in honor of Muslim Heritage Month.

The citation honors Wisconsin's "vibrant Muslim community that plays an essential role in forming and fundamentally enriching the unique character of our state and nation." And acknowledges that "while Muslims make substantial contributions to virtually every aspect of society, including business, academia, law, healthcare, the military, and more, we acknowledge that the history and contributions of Muslim Americans in our country are often neglected or defaced by prejudice, discrimination, xenophobia, and islamophobia."

Wisconsin Muslim Civic Foundation Executive Director Fauzia Qureshi and Treasurer Sheila Badwan were present to accept the County Board Citation and Proclamation from the County Executive.



**Milwaukee County Board Reaffirms Commitment to Restoration of Mitchell Park Domes**

On Friday, the Milwaukee County Board passed (15-2) legislation to authorize up to \$30 million in capital funding to implement the Domes Reimagined Plan, a follow-up to a budget amendment the board initiated last year. The investment is contingent on future approvals of lease and development

agreements with the Milwaukee Domes Alliance, the nonprofit partner leading the "Domes Reimagined" project.

"The neighbors of Mitchell Park deserve welcoming green spaces, and the Domes have long been a part of that landscape as well as a landmark feature of the community," said County Board Chairwoman Marcelia Nicholson.

"This Domes Reimagined

project is a transformational vision that reflects the values of our community."

The proposal is a step towards funding plans to restore the Show, Desert, and Tropical Domes in phases while introducing new educational and community spaces.

With the implementation of Domes Reimagined, the project is anticipated to save Milwaukee County an estimated \$770,000 annually in

operational costs.

The project would be funded through a public-private partnership, with Milwaukee County's investment leveraging additional private and philanthropic contributions.

"This is giving Milwaukeeans the progress they deserve," said County Supervisor Juan Miguel Martinez, the lead author of this legislation, who represents (continued on page 4)

# Lead testing clears all MPS schools that were previously relocated

**MPS's Brown Street Academy Is the Latest to Be Cleared of Lead Risks by the Milwaukee Health Department**

Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) Superintendent Brenda Cassellius today announced that testing by the City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD)

has cleared Brown Street Academy, after renovation and painting addressed lead risks at the school.

To date, MHD has declared nine schools cleared of lead dangers; all of the schools temporarily relocated in the 2024-25 school year now have been cleared.

"This is an important milestone in our work to clear our schools of lead dangers," Dr. Cassellius said.

"Our students, families and staff navigated the disruptions caused by building relocations last year with great patience and resilience.

"I'm grateful to them for their partnership through this challenge.

"I'm also pleased that the students and staff of Brown Street Academy, and all of these impacted schools, will be able to start the school year back in their own buildings."

The Brown Street Academy building, at 2029 N. 20th St., will be ready to welcome students and staff back on Tuesday, September 2, the first day of 2025-26 school year.

Brown Street students and staff were temporarily relocated to Andrew S. Douglas Middle School in May to allow MPS and contracted crews to perform renovation work, stabilize surfaces with paint, and clean the building thoroughly.

The relocation was precautionary; no Brown Street students were identified as having elevated blood lead levels from the school.

Milwaukee Public Schools is continuing to perform lead-cleanup work at district buildings this summer. The district is working toward eliminating all lead dangers from schools built before 1978 by the end of this calendar year.

"Our community has fought to revitalize Mitchell Park for years, and the reimagining and preservation of the Domes is a huge part of that.

We will continue to take progressive action toward keeping that promise. We are building something self-sustaining

that brings people into the cultural heart of one of our beloved neighborhoods."

The Domes Reimagined project supports the County's strategic priorities, including racial and health equity, fiscal sustainability, and inclusive community investment.

The proposal sets the stage for Milwaukee County to begin formalizing its financial role in the project.

The file legislation will now be considered for adoption by County Executive Crowley.

Final lease and development agreements will be considered in upcoming County Board cycles.
