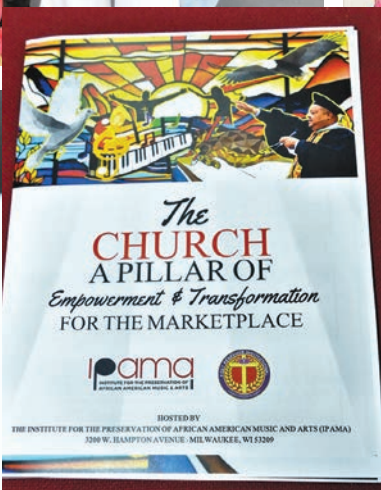

Republicans quietly roll back OBAMACARE!

Here's what enrollees should know!

Now that Trump's "big, beautiful bill" has passed, there are rule changes that will likely roll back the progress among the uninsured. Millions of Americans enrolled in Obamacare will likely see a difference when re-enrollment becomes available again.

While Republicans are not as loud about their efforts to repeal the Affordable Care Act, it doesn't mean Americans will not notice significant changes.

Now that Trump's "big, beautiful bill" has passed, there are rule changes that will likely roll back the progress among the uninsured.

As CNN reported, the new rules will make it harder to enroll and renew coverage under the Affordable Care Act because verification requirements have increased, out-of-pocket costs for enrolled individuals could also increase, and legal immigrants who qualified for federal subsidies are now banned.

These rules alone could impact close to 2 million people who could lose ObamaCare under the new rules and provisions outlined in Trump's bill package.

"As CNN reported, the new rules will make it harder to enroll and renew coverage under the Affordable Care Act because verification requirements have increased, out-of-pocket costs for enrolled individuals could also increase, and legal immigrants who qualified for federal subsidies are now banned."

Another provision that will shrink coverage is requiring low-income adults to work, volunteer, or engage in other activities for at least 80 hours a month.

The losses are expected

to be felt the most in at least seven GOP-led states, including Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, and Texas.

What's driving some anxiety is that the enhanced federal premium subsidies that former President Joe Biden and congressional Democrats approved back in 2021 are expected to end this year.

The Congressional Budget Office forecasts that more than 2 million people will be uninsured by 2034, with the Affordable Care Act provisions in the law.

"It's a radical weakening of what the marketplaces will be able to deliver in the next few years," Jennifer Sullivan, director of health coverage access at the left-leaning Center on Budget and Policy Priorities, told CNN.

through Dec. 15, and also requires states to end open enrollment on the exchanges by Dec. 31.

The technical changes mean that the annual costs for coverage will go up mainly because there is a reduction in premium subsidies. Insurance companies can raise out-of-pocket costs when people receive care.

According to KFF, the latest data from 2023 indicates that approximately 1.7 million Black Americans were enrolled in health insurance plans through the Affordable Care Act Marketplace (HealthCare.gov).

This represents a significant increase in enrollment for this population, with a 95% rise in Marketplace enrollment among Black Americans from 2020 to 2023.

The open enrollment period on the federal healthcare.gov has been shortened to November 1

Black people, along with other racial and ethnic minorities, would likely be disproportionately affected by the rollbacks of Obamacare.

Vida Cross

Vida Cross Awarded Fulbright Canada Research Chair Fall 2025

Vida Cross, a writer, educator, and native Chicagoan who calls Milwaukee, Wisconsin home, has been awarded the Fulbright Canada Research Chair.

Her residency will be supported in partnership with the University of Windsor's Office of Vice President-Research and Innovation, the Office of the Vice President-Academic/Provost, and the Leddy Library.

Ms. Cross plans to develop creative works based on the history of people who crossed the Detroit River to escape slavery and live in Windsor, Ontario during the 1800s.

Shanthi Johnson, the Vice President of Research and Innovation at the University of Windsor, writes, "Her project, The Charles Family, a research-based creative endeavor... aligns deeply with our region's history and the strong collection held in the Archives and Special Collections at Leddy Library."

In 2016, focusing on the artwork of Archibald J. Motley Jr., Vida Cross, a Cave Canem fellow, authored the book of poems, *Bronzeville at Night: 1949*.

She received her BA in English-writing and History from Knox College, her MA in English from Iowa State University, her MFA in filmmaking from The School of the Art Institute of Chicago, and she earned an MFA in Writing (MFAW) from The School of the Art Institute of Chicago.

She has taught at Iowa State University, Loyola University, Northern Illinois University, and currently at Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC).

At MATC, she is the chairperson of the Creative Writing Committee, where she has actively developed creative writ-

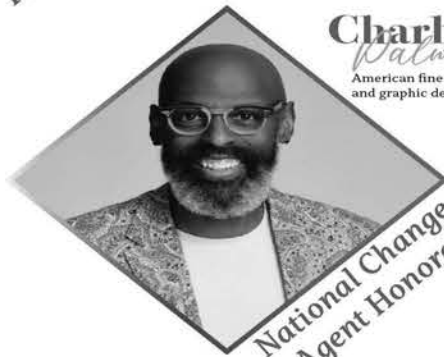

BLACK PUBLIC MEDIA FIGHTS BACK AGAINST ERASURE

National nonprofit launches fund drive to fuel the future of Black stories

NEW YORK — In response to the ripping away of \$1.8 million from its annual budget by the federal government, Black Public Media (BPM) has launched the Black Stories Production Fund. The organization seeks to raise \$9 million over the next two years and welcomes large contributions from foundations and corporations as well as gifts from individual donors as small as \$5. The first year of the campaign aims to reach 1.8 million donors.

“As we build the production fund, we will also work with our public media partners to rebuild a better, more responsive and representative public media system,” said Leslie Fields-Cruz, executive director of BPM, a Harlem-based national nonprofit. “The future of public media should never again be subject to the whims of politics. Our mission of supporting independent voices who create work in service to the advancement of our nation, and Black people everywhere, is too important.”

Since 1979, BPM has distributed more than \$17 million in support to films like Ailey (2021), Can You Bring It: Bill T. Jones and D-Man in the Waters (2023), Daughters of the Dust (1991), I Am Not Your Negro (2018), Max Roach: The Drum Also Waltzes (2023), Mr. Soul (2018) and When Claude Got Shot (2022). BPM grantees have gone on to great acclaim, earning Emmys, Peabodys, Telly and Anthem Awards as well as an Oscar nomination.

The group has helped nurture the careers of nationally recognized filmmakers including Julie Dash, Michèle Stephenson, Stanley Nelson and Sam Pollard. BPM has brought the work of these makers and others to public media and beyond.

Among its audience favorites are the signature series AfroPoP: The Ultimate Cultural Exchange, which is now in its 17th season; AfroPoP Digital Shorts, which premieres new shorts online bimonthly; and the children’s podcast, Keyshawn Solves it, which attracted Common Sense Media accolades in 2023.

With the rise of emerging media, BPM has trained creative technologists on virtual reality (VR), augmented reality (AR) and a slew of other new technologies, while providing emerging media artists access to equipment, funding and opportunity.

ing curriculum in the English Department, and she is the former chairperson of the Faculty Mentoring Committee where she helped to institute the program and develop faculty mentoring curriculum.

In order to conduct research in Windsor, sadly Vida Cross leaves her position as the chairperson of the Wisconsin Poet Laureate Commission.
